MATERIALS


1 skein of Kind Feather, Dusty Green (19)
1 skein of Peacock, Chocolate Brown (11)

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G/6)

Yarn needle
Stitch markers
Scissors

YARN QUALITY

 **Kind Feather**, Hobbii
100% Acrylic
100 g (3.5 oz) = 235 m (257 yds)

 **Peacock**, Hobbii
100% Polyester
50 g (1.8 oz) = 27 m (30 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 18 sts x 17 rows

st = stitch
sc = single crochet

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Ordesa mittens will keep your hands warm in cold weather. Each mitten is built by crocheting the hand shape and adding the ribbing. The design is inspired by the different colours and textures found in Ordesa National Park in the Pyrenees.

Pattern



INFO AND TIPS

Each Ordesa mitten consists of one panel crocheted in two sections. The panel is seamed on one side, the thumb and the top (finger tips) to get the mitten shape. Then, the fur ribbing is added along the wrist.

The main panel in each mitten is mainly crocheted with half double crochet slip stitch on the back loop only. The texture part in the centre of the back consists of 5 rows:

- Rows 1, 2, 4 and 5 are a combination of half double crochet and single crochet.
- Row 3 is a combination of berry stitch and single crochet.

Half double crochet slip stitch back loop only

hdc sl st blo = Yarn over, go through the back loop of next stitch, yarn over and pull through the stitch, now pull the yarn through the last two loops of the hook (without doing a yarn over).

The berry stitch

Yarn over, insert the hook into the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through one loop on the hook. Yarn over, insert the hook into the same stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through the five loops on the hook.

The rows in the ribbing are crocheted using double crochet.

Gauge

The gauge is 10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 18 sts x 17 rows.

To test your gauge, crochet a swatch of 20 stitches x 20 rows.

Ch 21

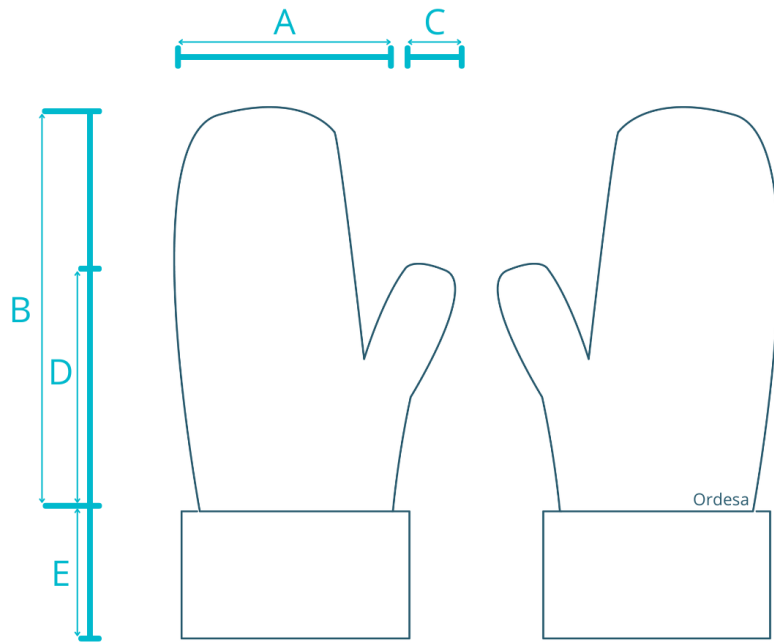
Row 1: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 19 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: 19 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Repeat row 2 until row 20. Fasten off.

Measure a 10 cm / 4" square in the centre of the swatch. You should have 18 sts x 17 rows.

LEFT MITTEN / SIZES XS (S)

Crochet back and forth. This piece includes 2 sections: back and thumb and palm. The thumb is seamed after crocheting the first section. One side and the top of the mitten is seamed at the end of the second section. Use stitch markers as described in the instructions.

Back and thumb



With Kind Feather, ch 30 (34)

Row 1: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 28 (32) hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: 29 (33) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn. Place two stitch markers in both the first and second sts in the row. These sts will not be crocheted in until rows 5 and 7.

Row 3: 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 4: 26 (30) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 5: 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 6: 3 hdc sl st blo, [1 sc, 1 hdc] 12 (14) times, 1 sc. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 7: [1 sc, 1 hdc] 12 (14) times, 1 sc, 3 hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the first st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 8: 4 hdc sl st blo, 1 sc, [1 berry st, 1 sc] 12 (14) times. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st in the row. This st will not be crocheted in until row 13.

Row 9: [1 sc, 1 hdc] 12 (14) times, 1 sc, 3 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 10: 3 hdc sl st blo, [1 sc, 1 hdc] 12 (14) times, 1 sc. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st in the row. This st will not be crocheted in until row 13.

Row 11: 25 (29) hdc sl st, 2 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 12: 26 (30) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 13: 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the first st in row 10 and the first st in row 8 and 2 hdc sl st in those sts. Ch 1 and turn.

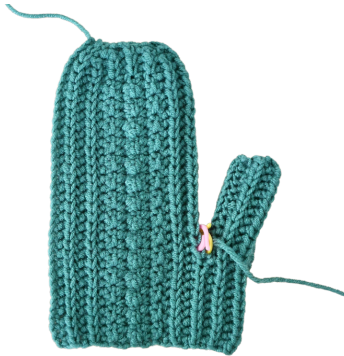
Row 14: 28 (32) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in stitch number 19 (23).

Row 15: 10 hdc sl st blo. Ch 13 and turn.

Row 16: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 11 hdc sl st, 9 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 17: 21 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Repeat row 17 until row 25.



In row 25, do not ch 1 at the end and fasten off, leaving a long thread to sew.

Place a stitch marker in the 10th stitch in row 25.

Fold the thumb so that row 25 matches with row 16. Join the 12 upper stitches in row 25 to the 12 stitches in row 16- those are the ones that were done on the chain. Use a yarn needle and invisible stitch.

Palm



Remove the stitch marker placed in stitch number 19 (23) in row 14. Insert your hook in that stitch.

Row 1: 18 (22) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: 19 (23) hdc sl st blo. Remove the marker placed in stitch number 10 in row 25. Join with 2 sl sts into the next 2 sts. Ch 1 and turn. Place two stitch markers in both the first and second sts in the row. These sts will not be crocheted in until rows 5 and 7.

Row 3: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 17 (21) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 4: 19 (23) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 25. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 5: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 19 (23) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 6: 22 (26) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 25. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 7: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 22 (26) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the first st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 8: 25 (29) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 25. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st in the row. This st will not be crocheted in until row 13.

Row 9: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 24 (28) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

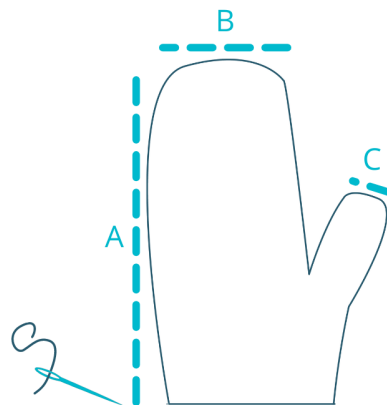
Row 10: 26 (30) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 25. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st in the row. This st will not be crocheted in until row 13.

Row 11: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 25 (29) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 12: 26 (30) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 13: 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the first st in row 10 and the first st in row 8 and 2 hdc sl st in those sts. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 14: 28 (32) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Fasten off, leaving a long strand to sew.



Fold the mitten, leaving the texture stitches outside. Close the mitten joining the last crocheted row to the first one (A). Use the crochet hook and sl st blo: insert your hook in the back loop of the first st in both rows, work a slip st; continue working sl st blo along the seam. Fasten off. Join the top of the mittens in the fingertips (B). Finally, join the thumb tip (C). Use a yarn needle and sew using an invisible stitch for B and C.

RIGHT MITTEN / SIZES XS (S)

Palm and thumb



Ch 30 (34)

Row 1: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 28 (32) hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: 28 (32) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place two stitch markers in both the first and second sts of the row. These sts will not be crocheted in until rows 5 and 7.

Row 3: 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 4: 26 (30) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 5: 2 dec hdc sl st, 23 (27) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 2 and hdc sl st in that st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 6: 25 (29) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 7: 2 dec hdc sl st, 22 (26) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the first st in row 2 and hdc sl st in that st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 8: 24 (28) hdc st sl blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st of the row. This st will not be crocheted in until row 13.

Row 9: 2 dec hdc sl st, 20 (24) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 10: 21 (25) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st of the row. This st will not be crocheted in until row 13.

Row 11: 2 dec hdc sl st, 17 (21) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 12: 18 (22) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 13: 2 dec hdc sl st, 15 (19) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch markers of the first st in row 8 and the first st in row 10 and 2 hdc sl st in those sts. Ch 1 and turn.

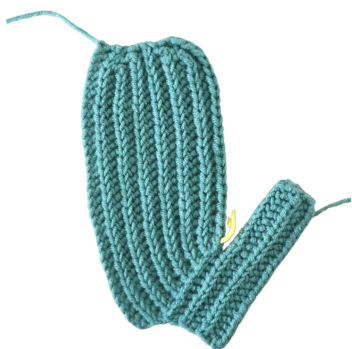
Row 14: 18 (22) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Sl st in the bottom of each row until row 4, which makes a total of 10 sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st of the row.

Row 15: 10 hdc sl st blo. Ch 13 and turn.

Row 16: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 11 hdc sl st, 9 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 17: 21 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Repeat row 17 until row 25.



In row 25, do not ch 1 at the end and fasten off, leaving a long strand to sew.

Place a stitch marker in st number 10 in row 25.

Fold the thumb so that row 25 matches with row 16. Join the 12 upper stitches in row 25 to the 12 stitches in row 16- those are the ones that were done on the chain. Use a yarn needle and invisible stitch.

Back



Remove the stitch marker in the first st in row 14. Insert your hook in that st.

Row 1: (19) 23 hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker placed in st number 10 in row 25 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. Continue crocheting into sts of row 25. 8 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place two stitch markers in both the first and second sts in the row. These sts will not be crocheted in until rows 4 and 6.

Row 2: (27) 31 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 3: (26) 30 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 4: (27) 31 hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker placed in the second st in row 1 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 5: 3 hdc sl st blo, [1 sc, 1 hdc] 12 (14) times, 1 sc. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 6: [1 sc, 1 hdc] 12 (14) times, 1 sc, 3 hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker placed in the first st in row 1 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 7: 4 hdc sl st blo, 1 sc, [1 berry st, 1 sc] 12 (14) times. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st in the row. This st will not be crocheted in until row 12.

Row 8: [1 sc, 1 hdc] 12 (14) times, 1 sc, 3 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 9: 3 hdc sl st blo, [1 sc, 1 hdc] 12 (14) times, 1 sc. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st in the row. This st will not be crocheted in until row 12.

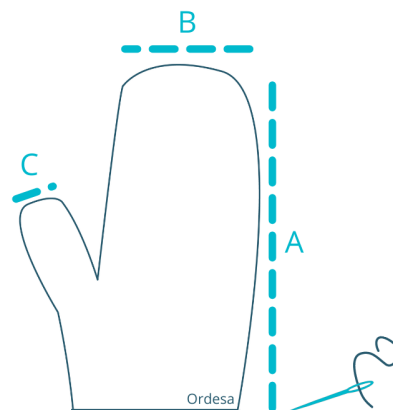
Row 10: 25 (29) hdc sl st, 2 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 11: 26 (30) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 12: 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch markers in the first sts in rows 7 and 9 and 2 hdc sl st in those sts. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 13: 28 (32) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 14: 29 (33) hdc sl st blo. Fasten off, do not cut the yarn.



Fold the mitten, leaving the texture stitches outside. Close the mitten joining the last crocheted row to the first one (A). Use the crochet hook and sl st blo: insert your hook in the back loop of the first st in both rows, work a slip st; continue working sl st blo along the seam. Fasten off. Join the top of the mittens in the fingertips (B). Finally, join the thumb tip (C). Use a yarn needle and sew using an invisible stitch for B and C.

LEFT MITTEN / SIZES M (L)

Crochet back and forth. This piece includes 2 sections: back and thumb and palm. The thumb is seamed after crocheting the first section. One side and the top of the mitten is seamed at the end of the second section. Use stitch markers as described in the instructions.

Back and thumb



Ch 38 (42)

Row 1: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 36 (40) hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: 37 (41) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn. Place two stitch markers in the second and fourth sts in the row. These sts (from first to fourth) will not be crocheted in until rows 5 and 7.

Row 3: 33 (37) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 4: 32 (36) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 5: 33 (37) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the fourth st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 6: 34 (38) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 7: 35 (39) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 8: 6 hdc sl st blo, [1 sc, 1 hdc] 15 (17) times, 1 sc. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 9: [1 sc, 1 hdc] 15 (17) times, 1 sc, 6 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 10: 6 hdc sl st blo, 1 sc, [1 berry st, 1 sc] 15 (17) times. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the second st in the row. These (the first and second) sts will not be crocheted in until row 15.

Row 11: [1 sc, 1 hdc] 15 (17) times, 1 sc, 4 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 12: 4 hdc sl st blo, [1 sc, 1 hdc] 15 (17) times, 1 sc. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the second st in the row. These (the first and second) sts will not be crocheted in until row 15.

Row 13: 31 (35) hdc sl st, 2 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 14: 32 (36) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 15: 33 (37) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 12 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Now remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 10 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 16: 36 (40) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in st number 23 (27).

Row 17: 14 hdc sl st blo. Ch 15 (17) and turn.

Row 18: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 13 (15) hdc sl st, 13 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 19: 27 (29) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Repeat row 19 until row 29.



In row 29, do not ch 1 at the end and fasten off, leaving a long thread to sew.

Place a stitch marker in the 14th st in row 29.

Fold the thumb so that row 29 matches with row 18. Join the 14 (16) upper stitches in row 29 to the 14 (16) stitches in row 18- those are the ones that were done on the chain. Use a yarn needle and invisible stitch.

Palm



Remove the stitch marker placed in st number 23 (27) in row 16. Insert your hook in that st.

Row 1: 23 (27) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: 23 (27) hdc sl st blo. Remove the marker placed in st number 14 in row 29. Join with 2 sl sts into the next 2 sts. Ch 1 and turn. Place two stitch markers in the second and fourth sts in the row. These sts (from first to fourth) will not be crocheted in until rows 5 and 7.

Row 3: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 19 (23) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 4: 21 (25) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 29. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 5: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 21 (25) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the fourth st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 6: 25 (29) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 29. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 7: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 25 (29) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 8: 29 (33) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 29. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 9: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 29 (33) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 10: 31 (35) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 29. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the second st in the row. These (the first and second) sts will not be crocheted in until row 15.

Row 11: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 29 (33) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

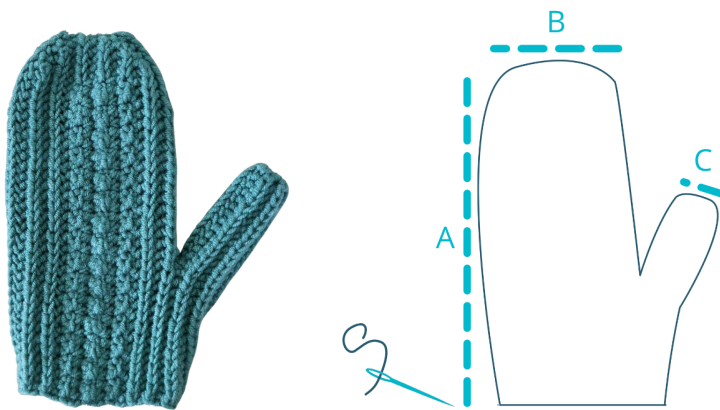
Row 12: 31 (35) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 29. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the second st in the row. These (the first and second) sts will not be crocheted in until row 15.

Row 13: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 29 (33) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 14: 31 (35) hdc sl st blo. Join with 2 sl sts into the following 2 sts in row 29. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 15: 2 hdc sl st blo in the 2 sl sts, 31 (35) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 12 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Now remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 10 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 16: 36 (40) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Fasten off, leaving a long strand to sew.



Fold the mitten, leaving the texture stitches outside. Close the mitten joining the last crocheted row to the first one (A). Join the top of the mittens in the fingertips (B). Finally, join the thumb tip (C). Use a yarn needle and sew using an invisible stitch.

RIGHT MITTEN / SIZES M (L)

Crochet back and forth. This piece includes 2 sections: palm and thumb and back. The thumb is seamed after crocheting the first section. One side and the top of the mitten is seamed at the end of the second section. Use stitch markers as described in the instructions.

Palm and thumb



Ch 38 (42)

Row 1: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 36 (40) hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: 36 (40) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place two stitch markers in the second and fourth sts in the row. These sts (from first to fourth) will not be crocheted in until rows 5 and 7.

Row 3: 2 dec hdc sl st, 29 (33) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 4: 30 (34) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 5: 2 dec hdc sl st, 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the fourth st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 6: 30 (34) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 7: 2 dec hdc sl st, 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 2 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 8: 30 (34) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 9: 2 dec hdc sl st, 27 (31) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 10: 28 (32) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the second st in the row. These (the first and second) sts will not be crocheted in until row 15.

Row 11: 2 dec hdc sl st, 23 (27) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 12: 24 (28) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the second st in the row. These (the first and second) sts will not be crocheted in until row 15.

Row 13: 2 dec hdc sl st, 19 (23) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 14: 20 (24) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 15: 2 dec hdc sl st, 17 (21) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 12 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Now remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 10 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

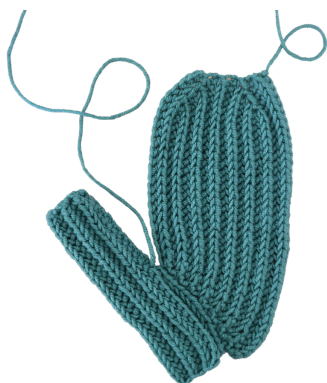
Row 16: 22 (26) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Sl st in the bottom of each row until row 2, which makes a total of 14 sl sts. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the first st of the row.

Row 17: 14 hdc sl st blo. Ch 15 (17) and turn.

Row 18: 1 hdc sl st in the second ch, 13 (15) hdc sl st, 13 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 19: 27 (29) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Repeat row 19 until row 29.



In row 29, do not ch 1 at the end and fasten off, leaving a long strand to sew.

Place a stitch marker in the 14th st in row 29.

Fold the thumb so that row 29 matches with row 18. Join the 14 (16) upper stitches in row 29 to the 14 (16) stitches in row 18- those are the ones that were done on the chain. Use a yarn needle and invisible stitch.

Back



Remove the stitch marker in the first st in row 16. Insert your hook in that st.

Row 1: 23 (27) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker placed in st number 14 in row 29 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. Continue crocheting into sts of row 29: 12 hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place two stitch markers in both the second and fourth sts in the row. These sts (from first to fourth) will not be crocheted in until rows 4 and 6.

Row 2: 33 (37) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 3: 32 (36) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 4: 33 (37) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the fourth st in row 1 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 5: 4 hdc sl st blo, [1 sc, 1 hdc] 15 (17) times, 1 sc. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 6: [1 sc, 1 hdc] 15 (17) times, 1 sc, 4 hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker placed in the second st in row 1 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 7: 6 hdc sl st blo, 1 sc, [1 berry st, 1 sc] 15 (17) times. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 8: [1 sc, 1 hdc] 15 (17) times, 1 sc, 6 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 9: 6 hdc sl st blo, [1 sc, 1 hdc] 15 (17) times, 1 sc. Ch 1 and turn. Place a stitch marker in the second st in the row. These sts (the first and second) will not be crocheted in until row 14.

Row 10: 31 (35) hdc sl st, 4 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 11: 34 (38) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn. Place a st marker in the second st in the row. These sts (the first and second) will not be crocheted in until row 14.

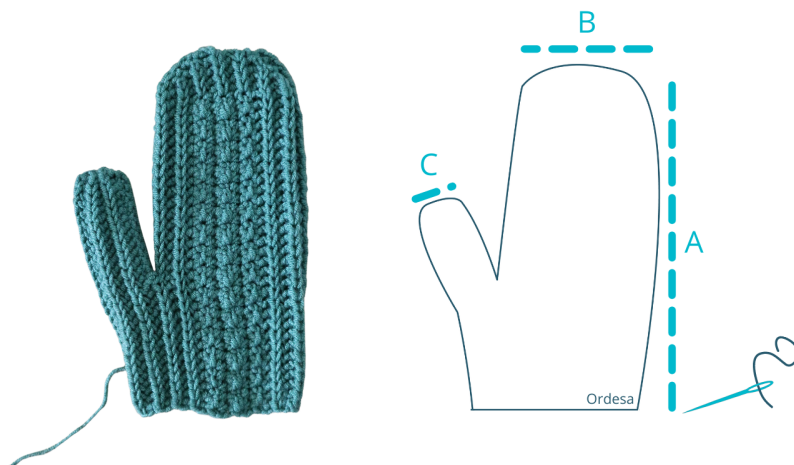
Row 12: 33 (37) hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 13: 32 (36) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 14: 33 (37) hdc sl st blo. Remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 11 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Now remove the stitch marker of the second st in row 9 and 1 hdc sl st in that st. 1 hdc sl st blo. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 15: 36 (40) hdc sl st blo, 1 hdc sl st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 16: 37 (41) hdc sl st blo. Fasten off, do not cut the yarn.



Fold the mitten, leaving the texture stitches outside. Close the mitten joining the last crocheted row to the first one (A). Use the crochet hook and sl st blo: insert your hook in the back loop of the first st in both rows, work a slip st; continue working sl st blo along the seam. Fasten off.

Join the top of the mittens in the fingertips (B). Finally, join the thumb tip (C). Use a yarn needle and sew using an invisible stitch for B and C.

RIBBING



Use Kind Feather yarn. Join the yarn on one side of the wrist line.

Row 1: sc evenly (do 1 sc in each row) around the wrist until you get back to the first st. Sl st in the first st. This makes a total of 30 sts (XS/S) 32 sts (M/L)

Row 2:

- Size XS: ch 2, [1 sc, 1 dec sc] 10 times. 1dc.
- Size S: ch 2, [4 sc, 1 dec sc] 5 times. 1dc.
- Size M/L: ch 2, [2 sc, 1 dec sc] 8 times. 1dc.

Change into Peacock yarn. Join the yarn on the last st made with Kind Feather yarn.

Row 3: ch 3, 20 (25) 24 (24) dc. Join with sl st in the first dc.

Repeat row 3 x 5 times (or as long as you want the cuff). Make 1 dc in the first 3 ch. Fasten off.

Repeat this procedure on the other mitten.
