MATERIALS

1 skein of Ribbon col 45
1 skein of Ribbon col 18
1 skein of Ribbon col 19

Estimated yardage per size:

S: approx. 120 g of Ribbon col 45
M: approx. 130 g of Ribbon col 18
L: approx. 130 g of Ribbon col 19

Bag bottom/ basket bottom / plywood
18 x 8 (22 x 10) 25 x 12 cm
Crochet hook 6 mm

YARN QUALITY

 **Ribbon**, Hobbii

100% cotton
250 g = 125 m

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm = approx. 8 sts x 7 rounds
in pattern

ABBREVIATIONS

sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
ch: chain

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 18 x 8 (22 x 10) 25 x 12 cm
Height: 12 (11) 10 cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

Neat set of 3 baskets with oval bottoms. The baskets are worked around in pattern. The pattern comes with a guide with pictures and is suitable for intermediate crocheters.

TIPS AND INFO

Start by working sc into the holes of the wooden bottom. See instructions for the required number of stitches for each basket.

Then continue in pattern, joining each round with a sl st.

Weave in yarn tail from cast-on before the basket becomes too high. Secure with a knot to keep from unraveling.

BASKET

With yarn behind the wooden bottom, pull up a loop in one hole, yarn over and pull through = 1. stitch. Work into the holes of the bottom like this (remembering that the 1. st has already been worked):

Work 2 sc in each hole = 60 (76) 90 sts.

Sl st to join.

Continue in pattern – see guide with pictures on page 4-5

*Ch 3, pull up a loop in 2. Ch from hook, pull up a loop in 3. Ch from hook, pull up a loop in the same stitch as where you made your sl st (= 4 loops on hook), pull up a loop in next st, pull up a loop in next st (= 6 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through.

(ch 1, pull up a loop in 1. Ch from hook, pull up a loop in the bar to the left, pull up a loop in the stitch just made (= 4 loops on hook), pull up a loop in next st, pull up a loop in next st (=6 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through) until end of round = 30 (38) 45 stars.

Sl st in 3. Ch of the first star to join*.

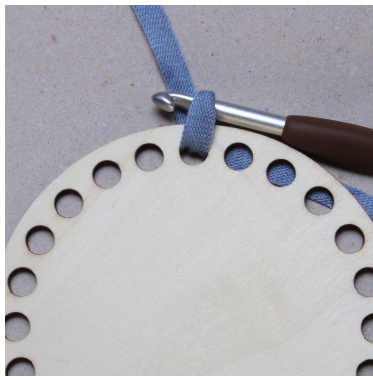
Repeat from * to * until work is 12 (11) 10 cm tall.

Sl st in 3. Ch of the first star to join.

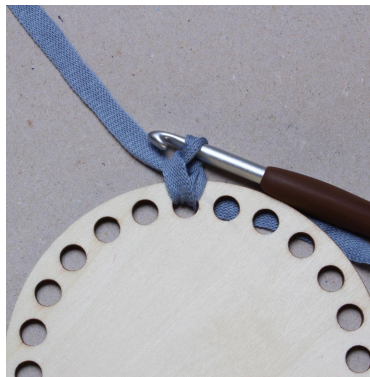
Weave in ends.

2. Ch 1



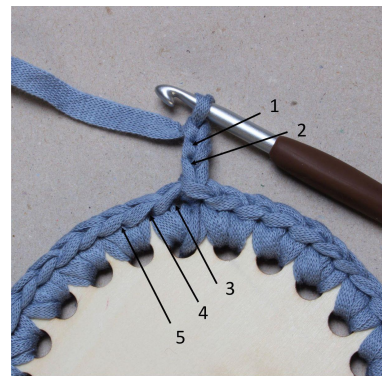
3. Work 2 sc in each hole



4. Sl st to join



5. Ch 3



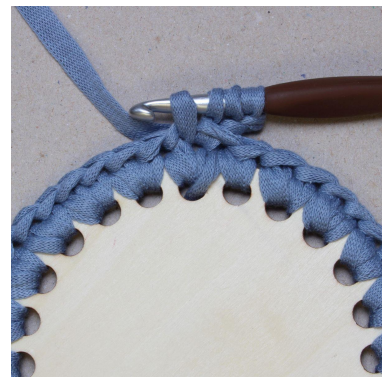
6. Pull up a loop in these stitches:



7. - pull up a loop (1) = 2 loops



8. - pull up a loop (2) = 3 loops



9. - pull up a loop (3) = 4 loops



10.- pull up a loop (4) = 5 loops



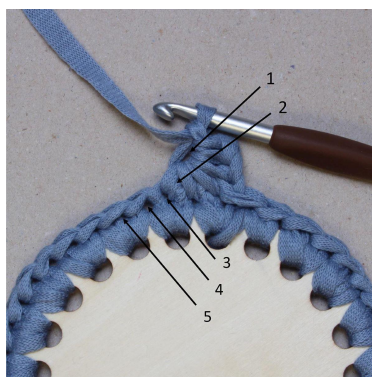
11.- pull up a loop (5) = 6 loops



12. Yarn over and pull through



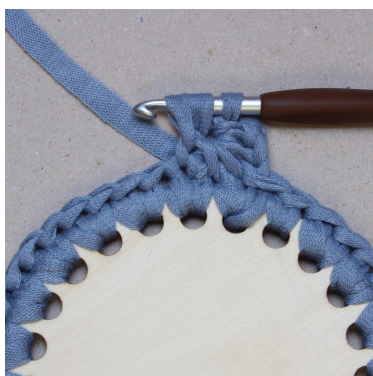
13. Ch 1



14. Pull up a loop in these sts:



15. - pull up a loop (1) = 2 loops



16. - pull up a loop (2) = 3 loops



17. - pull up a loop (3) = 4 loops



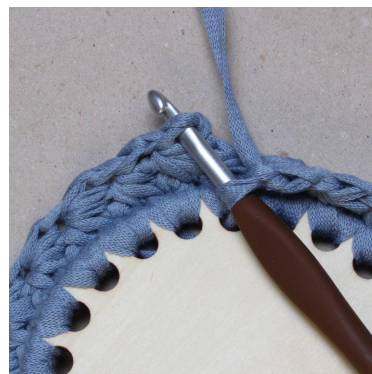
18. - pull up a loop (4) = 5 loops



19. - pull up a loop (5) = 6 loops



20. Yarn over and pull through. Repeat from image 13 until end of round



21. Join round by working into this stitch



22. work 1 sl st



23. Ch 3 and work pattern as image 7-22



Continue until you have the desired number of rounds.
