MATERIALS

1 skein of Kind Feather Colour 21
1 skein of Peacock Colour 07

Crochet hook 4mm
Scissors
Tapestry needle
Tape measure

YARN QUALITY

 **Kind Feather**, Hobbii
100% Akryl/Polyakryl
100 g = 235 m

 **Peacock**, Hobbii
100% Polyester
100 g = 65 m

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 15 dc sts and 10 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
st = stitch
sl st = slip stitch
dc = double crochet
fpdc/bpdc = front post double
crochet/back post double crochet
fo = fasten off
ws = wrong side
rs = right side

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 70cm / 27.5 inches
Height: 15cm / 6 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

This crocheted snood will keep you warm and snuggly. The soft fluffy hearts feel dreamy and look gorgeous too.
Skill-level: intermediate

INFO AND TIPS

This snood is made as a flat rectangle and then seamed together at the end. I recommend making a ball of yarn for each heart so you don't have to carry that yarn across each time!

Ch2 does not count as a st.

RIBBING

Row 1: Using Main Colour (Kind feather col 21) ch 113, then dc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch along, turn.

Row 2: Ch2, fpdc in the first st, bpdcc in the second st, alternate these until you reach the last 2 sts, fpdc in the second to last then dc in the last, turn. (112)

Row 3: Ch2, fpdc in the first st, bpdcc in the second st, alternate these until the end, dc in the last st, turn

Row 4: Ch2, dc in the first st, dc in each st until the end, turn

Row 5: Rep row 4

Start hearts here so have your Peacock yarn balls ready:

HEARTS (MC = main colour and H = heart colour)

All sts are DC

Row 6: Ch2, *6MC 3MC 2H 3MC* repeat * to * until you have 8 hearts, turn

Row 7: Ch2, *2MC 4H 2MC 6MC* repeat * to *, turn

Row 8: Ch2, *6MC 1MC 6H 1MC* repeat * to *, turn

Row 9: Ch2, *8H 6MC* repeat * to *, turn

Row 10: Ch2, *6MC 3H 2M 3H* repeat * to *, turn (you can cut your heart coloured yarn now)

Rows 11-13: Repeat Row 4

Row 14: Repeat Row 2

Row 15: Repeat Row 3, fo



Turn inside out and seam together by doing a sl st in each row end.

Weave in ends and turn the right way around.
