MATERIALS

9 (10) 11 (12) 13 skeins of Portobello
col. Purple Rain 70

Circular needle 4.5 mm (US 6), 80 cm
(31.5")

Circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4), 60 cm
(23.6")

Circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4), 40 cm
(15.75") or Double pointed needles 3.5 mm
(US 4)

Stitch markers

Darning needle

Stitch wire

YARN QUALITY

 **Portobello**, Hobbii

60% Cotton, 28% Acrylic, 12% Wool

50 g (1.75 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 18 sts x 28 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = purl

M1R = make 1 right

M1L = make 1 left

CO = cast on

BO = bind of

SSK = slip as if to knit, slip as if to knit, knit
the slipped stitches together through the
back loop

K2tog = knit 2 together

SIZE

S (M) L (XL) 2XL

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 54 (58) 63 (66) 71cm / 21" (22.8") 24.8"
(26") 28"

Circumference: 115 (126) 135 (146) 155 cm /
45" (49.6") 53" (57.5") 61"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Mayla is a beautiful and soft top-down raglan
knitted with Hobbii Portobello. The fit is short
and boxy with balloon sleeves. The neck is
shaped with German short rows and
rib-edges are done in twisted ribbing.
Suitable for the intermediate knitter.

INFORMATION AND TIPS

This sweater can easily be fitted to your measurements. Try it on while knitting to find the length on the body and sleeves that suit you the best. If adding extra length remember to buy extra yarn.

If you prefer a high neck, just leave the neck unfolded, and you have a beautiful high neck.

If you prefer wide sleeves, skip the decrease rounds on the sleeves and go straight to the ribbing.

SWEATER

Neck

Cast on 98 stitches on circular needle 3,5 mm (US 4), 40 cm. Place a stitch marker at the beginning of the round and knit 15 cm (6") of twisted ribbing.

With the right side facing you, fold the cast on to the inside and knit the stitches from the needle together with the stitches from the cast on.

Raglan

With a circular needle 4.5 mm (US 6) 80 cm (31.5"). Knit with magic loop technique as long as it is necessary.

Place stitch markers: knit 11 (back, left side), place a stitch marker, knit 8 (raglan sts), place a stitch marker, knit 11 (left sleeve), place a stitch marker, knit 8 (raglan sts), place a stitch marker, knit 22 (front), place a stitch marker, knit 8 (raglan sts), place a stitch marker, knit 11 (right sleeve), place a stitch marker, knit 8 (raglan sts), place a stitch marker, knit 11 sts (back, right side).

Short Rows

- Knit to the first marker, M1R, slip marker, knit 8, slip marker, M1L, knit to the next marker, M1R, slip marker, knit 8, slip marker, M1L, knit 2, turn with GSR

- Purl to the beginning of the round
- Purl to marker, M1L, slip M, purl 8, slip marker, M1R, purl to marker, M1L, slip marker, purl 8, slip marker, M1R, purl 2, turn with GSR
- Knit to the beginning of the round
- Repeat these rows until you have made 3 turns on each side. Always work all the stitches until you reach the GSR + 2 stitches! Make sure to work the double stitch right.

Continue working in the round while doing raglan increases:

Round 1: knit to marker, M1R, slip marker, knit 8, slip marker, M1L, knit to marker, M1R, slip marker, knit 8, slip marker, M1L, knit to marker, M1R, slip marker, knit 8, slip marker, M1L, knit to marker, M1R, slip marker, knit 8, slip marker, M1L, knit to the beginning of the round

Round 2: Knit all stitches

Repeat these two rounds a total of 30 (35) 39 (44) 48 times = 338 (378) 410 (450) 482 stitches on the needle.

Separate for the sleeves

Knit to marker, put the 71 (81) 89 (99) 107 sleeve stitches on a stitch wire, cast on 6 new stitches under the sleeve, knit to marker, put the 71 (81) 89 (99) 107 sleeve stitches on a stitch wire, cast on 6 new stitches under the sleeve, knit to the beginning of the round.

= 208 (228) 244 (264) 280 sts on the body

Body

Knit until the body measures 20 (20) 21 (21) 24 cm (or desired length) from the cast on under the arms.

Change to 3.5mm needles and knit 5 cm (2") of twisted ribbing. Bind off all stitches.

Sleeves

Place the sleeve stitches back on the needle and pick up 6 stitches under the sleeve. The beginning of the row is in the middle of the picked up stitches.

You should have 77 (87) 95 (105) 113 stitches on the needle.

Knit until the sleeve measures 34 (35) 36 (36) 36 cm (or desired length)

Decrease round(s)

Size S

Round 1: k2 *k1, k2tog*, repeat *-* until end of round = 52 sts on the needle

Size M

Round 1: *k1, k2tog*, repeat *-* until end of round = 58 sts on the needle

Size L

Round 1: k2 *k1, k2tog*, repeat *-* until end of round = 64 sts on the needle

Size XL

Round 1: *k3, k2tog*, repeat *-* until end of round

Round 2: k4, *k2, k2tog*, repeat *-* until end of round = 64 sts on the needle

Size 2XL

Round 1: k1 *k2, k2tog*, repeat *-* until end of round

Round 2: k1 *k2, k2tog*, repeat *-* until end of round = 64 sts on the needle

Cuffs

Work 5 cm (2") of twisted ribbing (needle 3.5 (US 4)) and bind off all of the stitches.

Repeat for the second sleeve.
