Sun

Applique

Design: Libère tes mailles | Hobbii Design

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein color sunflower (24)

1 skein color Tomato (40)

Crochet 2.5 mm / US C/2

Scissors

Darning needle

Scrap yarn black to make the face

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100 % cotton

50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

st(s) = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

blo = back loop only

mr = magic ring

... = repeat instructions between asterisks as many times as instructed

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Little sun: diameter 1,5" (3 cm)

Diameter with rays 2,5" (6,5 cm)

Big sun: diameter: 1,8" (4,5 cm)

Diameter with rays: 3,5" (9 cm)

PATTERN INFORMATION

This sun will brighten up your accessories and garments. It's also an awesome little project to use your leftovers of yarn. Sun is available in two sizes.

You can use appliques in many ways. You can crochet and sew them wherever you want to bring some joy. Have fun matching different appliques to create your own landscape or life scene. And sew them on your blankets, cushions, bags, scarf, hat, you can make a garland... the possibilities are endless. For children you can use them as a toy, add a scratch behind the applique and provide a support and they will have fun changing the decor all day long.

INFO AND TIPS

Ch1 doesn't count as 1 st so sl st to join in the first st.

The last round is work in the back loop only.

Each piece is finished with an invisible join, some pictures and explanations are available to show you how to do it.

If you planned to sew your appliques on a crocheted or knitted support don't forget to leave a long tail to sew them on your project. If you planned to sew them on another support weave in ends and use sewing thread in the same color as the applique.

LITTLE SUN

With color sunflower (24)

Make a magic ring

Round 1: Ch1 (doesn't count as a st), 7 sc in mr. Join with sl st in first st. (7 sts)

Round 2: Ch1, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in each st around. Join with sl st in first st. (14 sts)

Round 3: Ch1, 1 sc in the same st, *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in the next st* Repeat from * to * until 1 st left. 2 sc in last st. Join with sl st in first st. (21 sts)

Round 4: Ch1, 2 sc in same st, *1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st* Repeat from * to * until 2 sts left. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts. Join with sl st in first st. (28 sts) (Image 1)

Round 5: *Ch6, sl st in the 2nd st from the hook, 1 sc in next 4 sts, sl st blo in next 2 sts. Ch3, sl st in the 2nd st from the hook, 1 sc in next st, sl st blo in next 2 st.* Repeat from * to * 6 more times. Repeat from * to ** one last time, 1 sl st blo in the last st. Make an invisible join and weave in ends. (see how to make an invisible join at the end of the pattern) (7 big rays, 7 little rays, 28 sl sts)

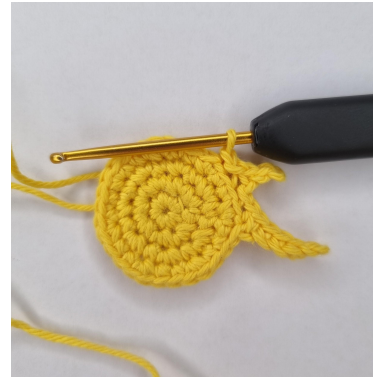

BIG SUN

With color sunflower (24)

Make a magic ring

Round 1: Ch1 (doesn't count as a st), 6 sc in mr. Join with sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 2: Ch1, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in each st around. Join with sl st in first st. (12 sts)

Round 3: Ch1, 1 sc in the same st, *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in the next st* Repeat from * to * until 1 st left. 2 sc in last st. Join with sl st in first st. (18 sts)

Round 4: Ch1, 2 sc in same st, *1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next sts* Repeat from * to * until 2 sts left. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts. Join with sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Round 5: Ch1, 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in next 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* Repeat from * to * until 1 st left. 2 sc in last st. Join with sl st in first st. (30 sts)

Round 6: Ch1, 2 sc in same st, *1 sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next sts* Repeat from * to * until 4 sts left. Work 1 sc in the next 4 sts. Join with sl st in first st. (36 sts)

Round 7: *Ch8, sl st in the 2nd st from the hook, 1 sc in next 6 sts. 1 sl st blo in next 2 sts. Ch4, sl st in the 2nd st from the hook, 1 sc in next 2 sts, sl st blo in next 2 st.* Repeat from * to * 8 more times. Make an invisible join and weave in ends. (9 big rays, 9 little rays, 36 sl sts)

(you can refer at images 1 to 3 to see the process, the number of sts is different but the technique is the same)

BOW

With color Tomato (40)

Round 1: Ch3, work in the last ch, 1 hdc, ch2. Sl st in the same st. Ch2, 1 hdc, ch2, sl st in the same st. Fasten off and leave a long tail to finish the bow.

With the yarn tail, wrap tight the center of the bow to give it the right shape.

With the black yarn and the needle, embroider the face. Place the bow where you want and sew it.



How to make an invisible join

Cut the yarn and pull the yarn through the last st. Insert your crochet in the first st, from back to front (Image 1) and pull the yarn through. Then insert the crochet into the last st from back to front BUT in the back loop only (Image 2) and pull through the yarn. Your join will be invisible and you will have a neat finish and weave in ends. (Image 3)
