MATERIALS

6 (6) 7 (7) skeins of Sweet Tweed colour 04 6 (6) 7 (7) skeins of Sweet Tweed colour 08 6 (6) 7 (7) skeins of Friends Extra Fine Merino colour 88

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8)

Yarn needle Scissors

YARN QUALITY

Sweet Tweed, Hobbii 40% Acrylic, 21% Polyamide, 13% Mohair, 13% Wool, 9% Cotton, 4% Polyester 25 g = 165 m

Friends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii 100 % Wool 50 g = 165 m

GAUGE

ch = chain

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 17 sts x 9 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

sc = single crochet
hdc slst = half double crochet slip stitch
hdc slst blo= half double crochet slip stitch
in the back loop only
hdc = half double crochet

The Suliac cardigan will add colour and cosiness to your look. The cardigan is built by crocheting 3 body parts (two front pieces and a back piece) and two sleeves, joining them together and adding a border. The design is inspired by sunsets in the small town of Saint-Suliac in Brittany, France.

INFO AND TIPS

The Suliac cardigan consists of three different panels: two front pieces, a back piece and two sleeves. Once crocheted, the panels are joined together. Finally, a border is added around the sides of the front panels in the cardigan centre front and the neck in the back panel to give it a nice finish.

All the pieces and border are worked with three strands of yarn held together: one strand of Friends Extra Fine Merino and two strands of Sweet Tweed.

The cardigan is mostly crocheted using a repetition of herringbone half double crochet in the front loop and a chain. Each piece has an 8-stitches-wide ribbing that is crocheted at the beginning of odd rows and at the end of even rows. The ribbing in the front and back panels is done with 7 half double crochet slip stitches and one half double crochet, most of these are worked in the back loop (except for the half double crochet slip stitch in the bottom end of the piece).

The ribbing in the sleeves is worked with the short rows technique. This means that some stitches are left unworked in some rows and they will be crocheted in the following rows to create the shape. Slst2tog is used to avoid holes when crocheting a longer row over the short rows. This stitch allows a smooth blend in.

In all pieces, even rows start with ch 3, which count as 1 hhdc and 1 chain. Odd rows end with a hhdc flo, this stitch should be done in the second ch done at the beginning of the previous row, which counts as the first hhdc.

Instructions to make the stitches:

- Herringbone half double crochet: yarn over, insert the hook in the stitch, yarn over, pull
 up a loop and pull through the first loop in the hook. Yarn over, pull through two loops
 in the hook.
 - If the pattern says hhdc **flo**, it means that this stitch has to be done inserting the hook only in the **front** loop.



- Half double crochet slip stitch: yarn over, insert the hook in the stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop and directly pull through two loops on the hook.
 - o If the pattern says hdc slst **blo**, it means that this stitch has to be done inserting the hook only in the **back** loop. Youtube: https://youtu.be/bnpqmTed7hs
- Half double crochet: yarn over, insert the hook in the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through the three loops on the hook.
 - If the pattern says hdc **blo**, it means that this stitch has to be done inserting the hook only in the **back** loop.
- Slst2tog: insert the hook **in the turning chain** of the previous row, yarn over and pull up a loop. Insert the hook in the back loop in the next stitch (you will find this stitch in a longer previous row), yarn over and pull up a loop. Pull through two loops on the hook. Try to do this stitch loosely.

The design is inspired by sunsets in the small town of Saint-Suliac in Britain, France. Wearing this cardigan makes me travel to those last hours of the sun in the river Rance while eating a waffle with ice cream. Wear it to add some colour to your day and spice it up!

Gauge

The gauge is 10 cm x 10 cm $(4'' \times 4'') = 17$ sts x 9 rows.



To test your gauge, crochet a swatch of 21 stitches x 14 rows.

Ch 23

Row 1: 1 hhdc in the fifth ch. [Ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 9 times.


Row 2: Ch 3 and turn (count as 1 hhdc and 1 ch). 1 hhdc flo in the third st. [Ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 9 times.

Repeat row 2 until row 14. Fasten off.

Measure a 10 cm / 4" square in the centre of the swatch. You should have 17 sts x 9 rows.

FRONT PIECES



Crochet back and forth. Make two identical pieces: the right front panel and the left front panel.

Ch 126 (128) 128 (130)

Row 1: 1 hdc slst in the second ch from the hook, 6 hdc slst, 1 hdc. 1 hhdc, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc] 58 (59) 59 (60) times.

Row 2: ch 3 and turn (count as 1 hhdc and 1 ch). 1 hhdc flo in the third st, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 57 (58) 58 (60) times. 1 hdc blo, 6 hdc slst blo, 1 hdc slst.

Row 3: ch 1 and turn. 7 hdc slst blo, 1 hdc blo. 1 hhdc flo, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 58 (59) 59 (60) times.

Repeat rows 2-3 until row 24 (26) 28 (30). Note that the last row is an even row, so it must be worked as row 2. Fasten off.

BACK PIECE



Crochet back and forth.

Ch 126 (128) 128 (130)



Row 1: 1 hdc slst in the second ch from the hook, 6 hdc slst, 1 hdc. 1 hhdc, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc] 58 (59) 59 (60) times.

Row 2: ch 3 and turn (count as 1 hhdc and 1 ch). 1 hhdc flo in the third st, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 57 (58) 58 (60) times. 1 hdc blo, 6 hdc slst blo, 1 hdc slst.

Row 3: ch 1 and turn. 7 hdc slst blo, 1 hdc blo. 1 hhdc flo, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 58 (59) 59 (60) times.

Repeat rows 2-3 until row 56 (62) 66 (70). Note that the last row is an even row, so it must be worked as row 2. Fasten off.

SLEEVE



Crochet back and forth. Make two.

Ch 74 (74) 72 (68)

Row 1: 1 hdc slst in the second ch from the hook, 6 hdc slst, 1 hdc. 1 hhdc, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc] 32 (32) 31 (29) times.

Row 2: ch 3 and turn (count as 1 hhdc and 1 ch). 1 hhdc flo in the third st, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 31 (31) 30 (28) times. 1 hdc blo, 1 hdc slst blo. 6 sts are left unworked.

Row 3: ch 1 and turn. 1 hdc slst blo, 1 hdc blo. 1 hhdc, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 32 (32) 31 (29) times.


Row 4: ch 3 and turn (count as 1 hhdc and 1 ch). 1 hhdc flo in the third st, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 31 (31) 30 (28) times. 1 hdc blo, 1 hdc slst blo. *Continue working in the sts left unworked in row 2*. 1 slst2tog, 4 hdc slst blo, 1 hdc slst.

Row 5: ch 1 and turn. 7 hdc slst blo, 1 hdc blo. 1 hhdc, [ch 1 and skip 1 st, 1 hhdc flo] 32 (32) 31 (29) times.



Repeat rows 2-5 until row 40 (44) 48 (52). Note that you finish with a row 4. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLING




Use a yarn needle and only one strand of Hobbii Friends Merino Extra Fine- do not hold together the strands of Sweet Tweed for assembling. Sew using an invisible stitch.

Join the front and back panels on shoulders (A). Then, fold each sleeve and join them to both sides (B), leaving the open part downwards. Sew the open side of the sleeve (C). Finally, join the back and front panels on sides (D).



BORDER



Place the cardigan with the front panels facing you. Join the yarn on the inner side of the bottom left panel (A).

Row 1: Sc evenly around the seam: go up the left front panel, along the neckline in the back panel and go down the right front panel. Try to do three sc in every four sts: 3 sc, skip 1 st. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: sc in each st from the previous row. Fasten off.
