MATERIALS

Friends Kid Silk

1 (1) 1 skein of each color:

Boysenberry (57)

Dune (07)

Ochre (13)

Mustard (28)

Rosewood (37)

Dark Magenta (48)

Dusty Rose (52)

Purple Rain (70)

Olive (109)

Sage (114)

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 6), 4.5 mm (US 7)

Circular needles 4 mm (US 6)

Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii

72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool

25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 23 sts x 30 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

st/s = stitch/es

k = knit

p = purl

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 58 (63) 67 cm / 22.8" (24.8") 26.3"

Length: 47 (52) 57 cm / 18.5" (20.4") 22.4"

Sleeves: 39 (43) 46 cm / 15.3" (16.9") 18.1"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Soft and lightweight colorful sweater inspired by the 80s.

Thanks to its loose cut, it goes perfectly with pants as well as with a dress.

The color changes are made with intarsia technique following two different charts.

The colors can be combined in endless ways to create just the look you want for your sweater.

INFO AND TIPS

When changing the colors, remember to cross the strands on the wrong side and stretch enough to avoid holes. The front and back are knitted separately. All parts of the sweater are knitted back and forth in stockinette stitch.

The parts are sewed together in the end

Stitches used in the pattern:

rib stitch: knit 2, purl 2

stockinette stitch: knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side

BODY

Front piece

With 4 mm needles CO 134 (144) 154 sts with color 28.

Work 12 (14) 20 rows in rib stitch (k 2, p 2)

Change to 4.5 mm needles and start to work in a stockinette stitch according to the chart below, working the bevels in every second row.

To form the neckline, BO the middle 16 sts (all sizes), then, on both sides, in every other row BO: 4, 3, 2, 1, 1 st/s.

BO sts on the shoulders.

Back piece

Work it through just like the front piece.

SLEEVES

Make both sleeves the same way.

With 4 mm needles CO 48 (54) 60 sts with color 28. Work 12 (14) 18 rows in rib stitch

Change to 4.5 mm needles and start to work in stockinette stitch according to the chart below.



The sleeve diagram shows the starting number of sts, to make the sleeve wider **INCREASE ON BOTH SIDES 1 ST IN EVERY 6th ROW.**

BO all sts.

FINISHING

Sew the front and back of the sweater together on the shoulders with mattress stitches.

With circular needles 4mm, pick up sts around the formed head opening, and work 10 rows in rib stitch.

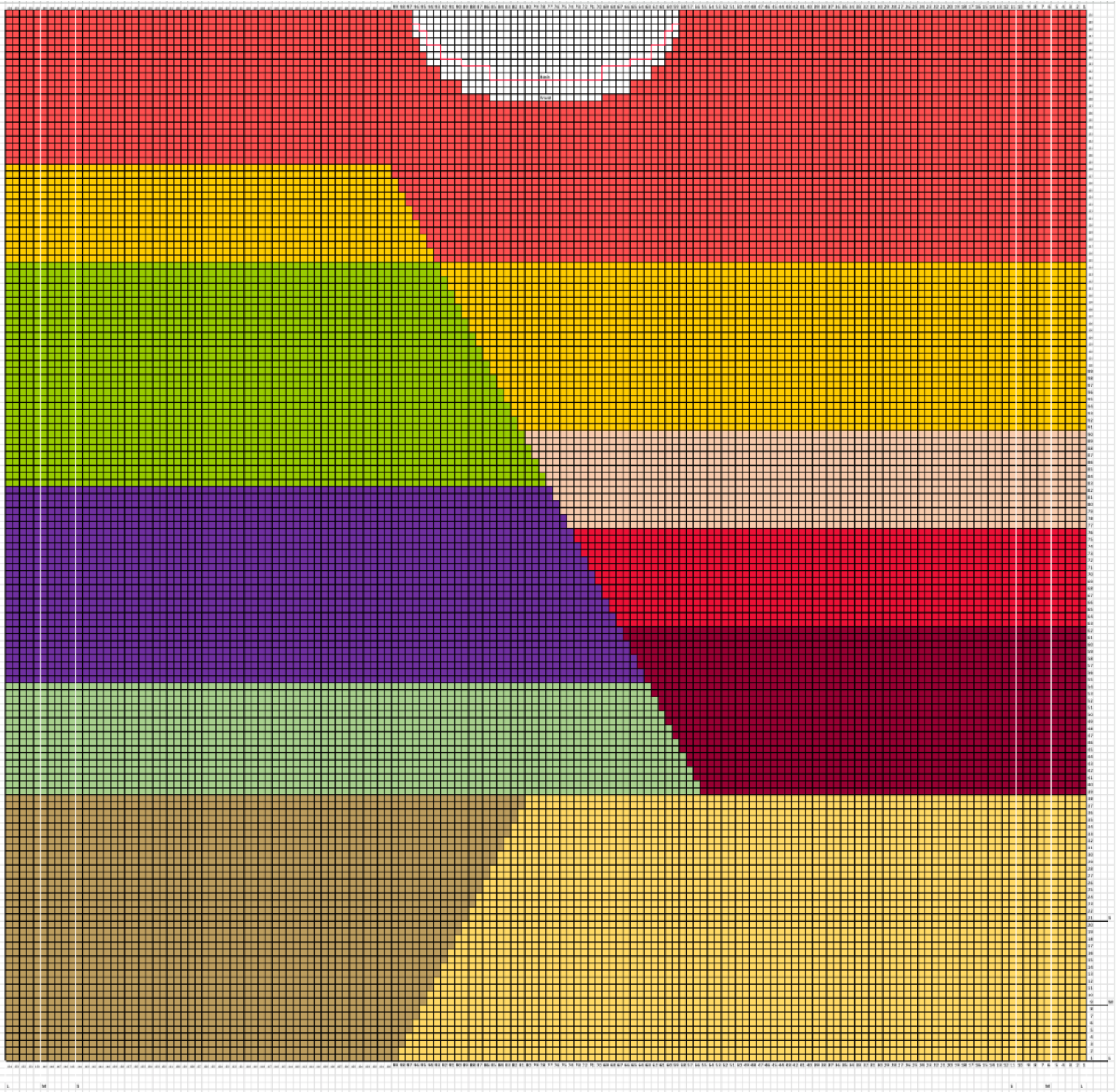
Sew the sleeves flat to the shoulders, and then sew the sides of the sweater and of the sleeves with mattress stitch.

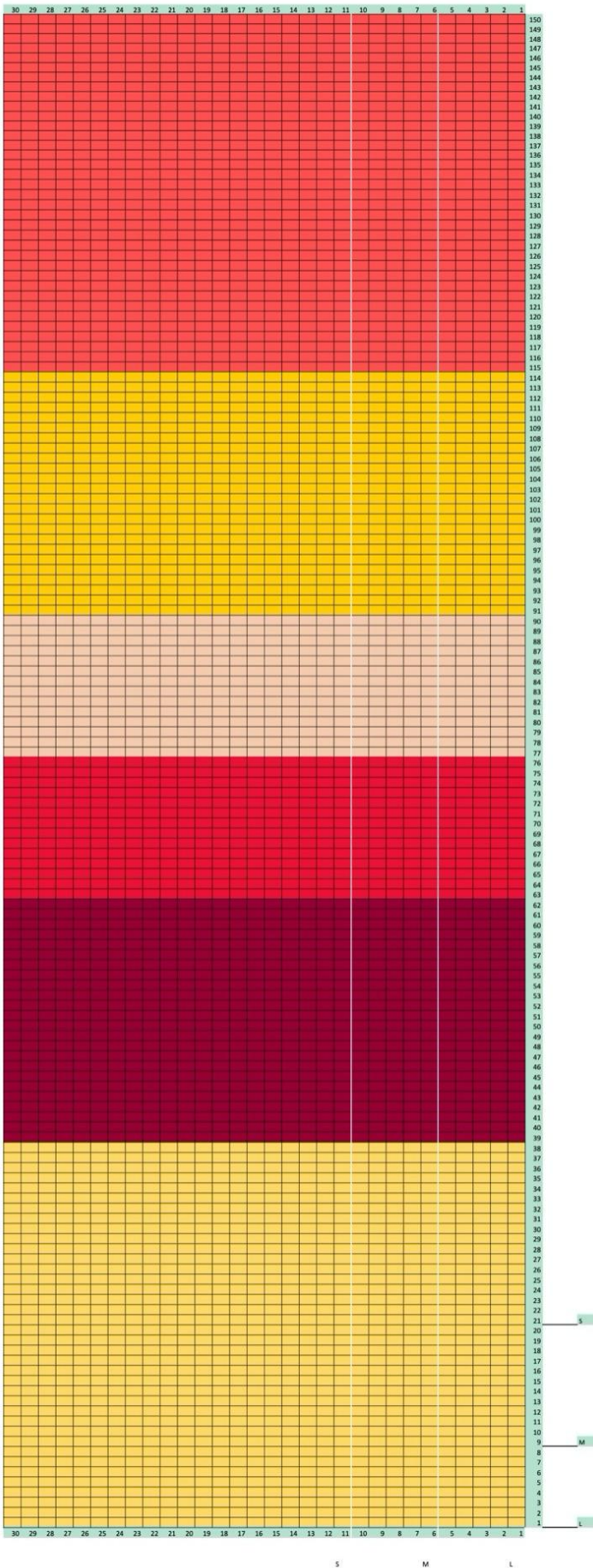

CHART

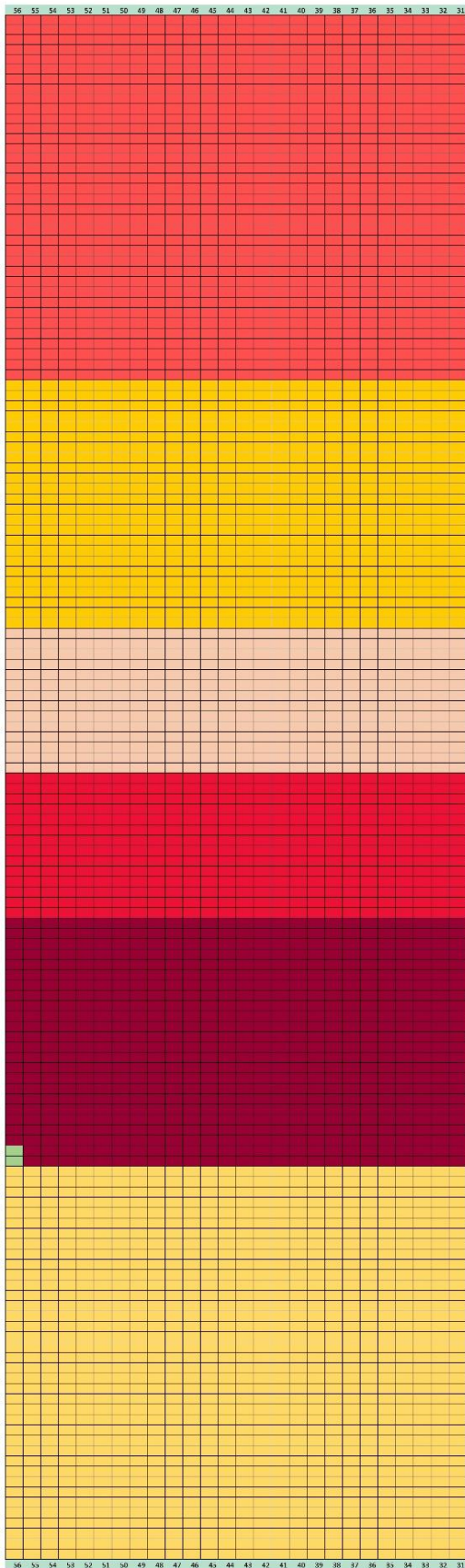
The chart is here shown in its full size. To be able to read it better it is also added in 5 separate parts on the following sides.

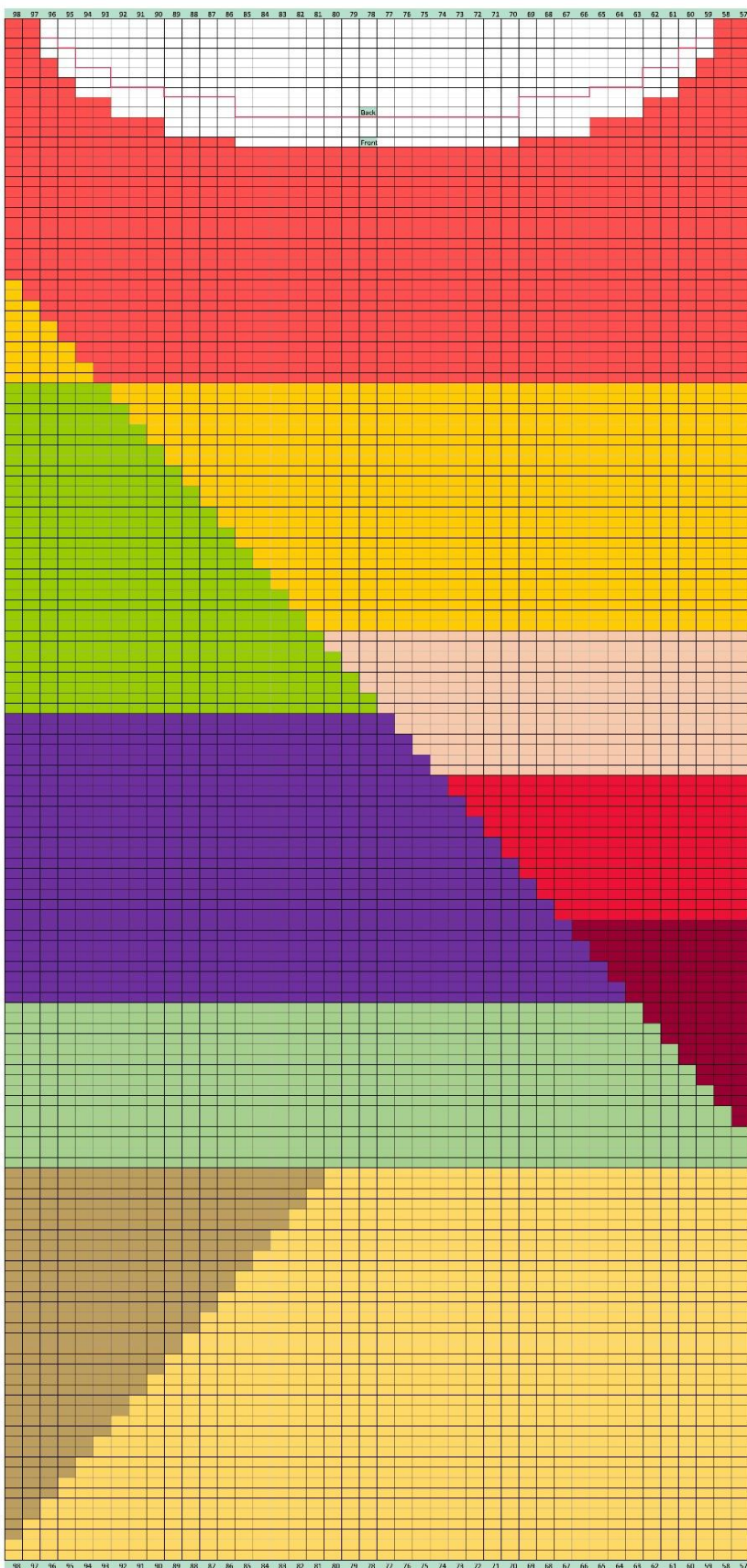

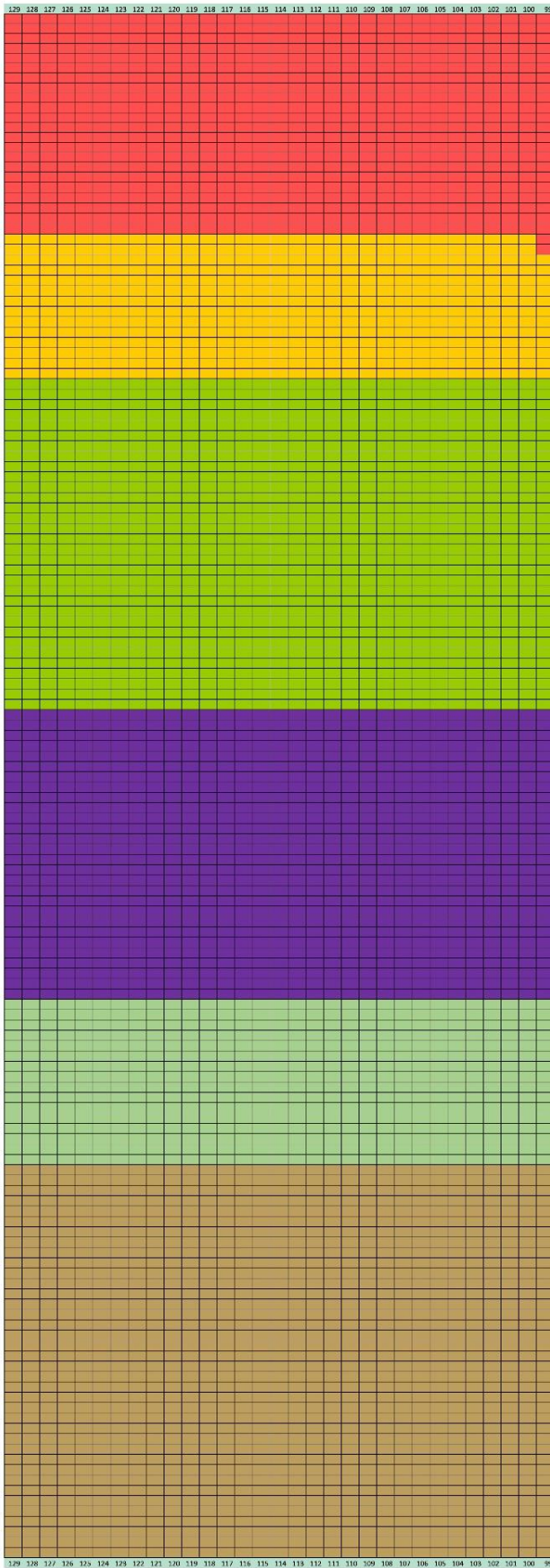


CHART SLEEVE
