Tutti Frutti Strawberry

Vest

MATERIALS

Friends Extra Fine Merino

4 (4) 5 skeins of color Buckthorn (29)
1 skein of color Cranberry (42)
1 skein of color Sage (114)

Knitting needles 3.5 mm (US 4), 4 mm (US 6)
Circular needles 3.5 mm (US 4)
Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Extra Fine Merino**, Hobbii
100% Wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 26 sts x 36 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es
k = knit
p = purl
CO = Cast On
BO = Bind Off

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 49 (52) 56 cm / 19.2" (20.4") 22"
Length: 51 (56) 61 cm / 20" (22") 24"

Add color and fun to your outfit with this juicy vest!

It is perfect for spring as well as for cooler summer evenings.

The vest is easy to make, but you should have the basics of knitting intarsia patterns.

INFO AND TIPS

The vest consists of two parts, front and back, sewn together at the end.

The strands should always be crossed on the wrong side and stretched enough to avoid holes.

Stitches used in the pattern:

- rib stitch: knit 2, purl 2
- stockinette stitch: knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side

BODY

FRONT PIECE

On the knitting needles 3.5 mm, CO 128 (134) 146 sts with yarn in color 29.

Work 14 rows in rib stitch.

Change to 4 mm needles, and work 15 rows in stockinette stitch.

In the next row, start to insert the first strawberry pattern following the chart below.

Note: Embroider the small green seeds on the strawberry in the end.

Work:

29 (32) 38 sts with color **29**,

2 sts with color **42**,

32 sts with color **29**,

2 sts with color **42**,

32 sts with color **29**,

2 sts with color **42**,

and **29 (32) 38** sts with color **29**.

Continue with the strawberries pattern for 19 more rows, making sure to introduce color 114 according to the chart.

After finishing the strawberries, work with the background color 20 more rows.

In the next row, start to insert the second strawberry pattern.

Work:

46 (49) 55 sts in color **29**,

2 sts in color **42**,

32 sts in **29**,

2 sts in **42**,

46 (49) 55 sts in 29.

After finishing the strawberries pattern, work with the background color 20 more rows.

In the next row, start inserting the strawberries pattern again, like the first one.

After finishing the strawberries pattern, work with the background color 20 more rows.

In the next row, start inserting the strawberries pattern again, like the second one.

After finishing the strawberries pattern, work with the background color 2 (10) 16 more rows.

In the next row, start working the neckline, BO the middle 38 (40) 40 sts, then, on both sides, in every other row BO: 4, 3, 2, 1 st/s. After finishing the neckline, work the remaining sts on the shoulders through 4 (12) 24 more rows. BO the remaining sts. Fasten off.

BACK PIECE

Work it through just like the front piece.

FINISHING

Sew shoulders with mattress stitch on the wrong side.

On the circular needles 3.5 mm pick up sts around the formed head opening, and work 8 (12) 12 rows in rib stitch.

On the circular needles 3.5 pick up 160 sts around the armhole and work 2 k rows. Fasten off.

Repeat on the other side.

Sew the sides of the vest and weave all ends.

Using a needle and green yarn embroider the strawberry seeds.
