



CROCHET PATTERN

Celia

Wrap top

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design




MATERIALS

4 (4) 5 skeins of Friends Cotton 8/4 color Olive (109)

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G-6)
Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii
100% Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 16 sts x 10 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
inc = increase (2 sts in the same st)

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 40 (44) 48 cm / 15.7" (17.3") 18.8"
Length: 40 (40) 44 / 15.7" (15.7") 17.3" or as desired

PATTERN INFORMATION

Celia is a simple and cute wrap top for the warm Summer days, crocheted in Friends Cotton 8/4.

The top consists of three pieces crocheted together. It is made from top to bottom.

INFO AND TIPS

The top consists of three pieces crocheted together. It is made from top to bottom. You can change the top measurements by adding or deducting rows. However, keep in mind that the number of rows of the front and back have to be the same.

BODY

FRONT PIECE (make two)

Ch 17 (20) 23

Row 1: starting from the 3rd st from the hook, work dc to the end of the row, ch 2, turn = 16 (19) 22 sts.

Row 2-7 (2-10) 2-10: dc to the end of the row, ch 2, turn.

From now on you will start increasing every row. Remember to always increase on the same side.

Row 8 (11) 11: increase by working one st in the very first st with ch 2 coming out, dc to the end of the row, ch 2, turn.

Row 9 (12) 12: dc until you have 1 st left on the row, dc inc, ch 2, turn.

Repeat the rows 8-9 (11-12) 11-12 until you have a total of 36 (36) 40 rows = 45 (45) 52 sts.

Remember to finish on the neckline side to make a cord.

When you finish the row on the neckline side, do not cut the thread as you need to start making the cord.

Ch 100 (100) 115, and work hdc back to the beginning of the chain, join with sl st to the top of the dc.

Do not cut the yarn and start making the neckline edging.

Ch 1, *3 sc into the next row, sl st to the next row* repeat from * to * to the end.

Fasten off.

BACK PIECE

Ch 64 (70) 74.

Row 1: starting from the 3rd st from the hook, work dc to the end of the row, ch 2, turn.

Row 2-36 (2-36) 2-40: dc to the end of the row, ch 2, turn.

When you finish the last row, fasten off.

FINISHING

Crochet the shoulders together on the wrong side with sc.

Put the front and back pieces with the right sides facing each other and stitch them together working 2 sc into each row. Start from the bottom and work 15 rows up towards the armhole (or as many rows as you wish to have the body piece.)

Armhole edging

Attach the yarn to the Ch 1, *3 sc into the next row, sl st to the next row* repeat from * to * to the end.

Fasten off.

Bottom edging

Attach the thread with a sl st on the corner where the cord meets the body, ch 1, *hdc inc, hdc, sl st* repeat from * to * to the end.

Fasten off.

Weave in all the ends and you are done!
