MATERIALS

(3), 4, 5, 6 skeins of Honey Bunny, color Beige (05)

(2), 3, 4, 5 skeins of Honey Bunny, color Nougat (09)

(2), 3, 4, 5 skeins of Honey Bunny, color Caramel (14)

(2), 3, 4, 5 skeins of Honey Bunny, color Cool Blue (78)

(2), 3, 4, 5 skeins of Honey Bunny, color Aqua (91)

(2), 3, 4, 5 skeins of Honey Bunny, color Turquoise (94)

Crochet hook 7 mm Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Honey Bunny, Hobbii 100% Polyester 100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

10 dc x 9 rows (dc and sc rows) = 10×10 cm (4 in)

ABBREVIATIONS

sl st = slip stitch ch = chain sc = single crochet dc = double crochet

SIZE

(S-M), L- XL, 2XL- 3XL, 4XL- 5XL

MEASUREMENTS

Width: (53 cm / 21"), 59 cm / 23 ¼", 65 cm / 25 ½", 71 cm / 28"

Length: (75 cm / 29 ½"), 80 cm / 31 ½", 85 cm / 33 ½", 90 cm / 35 ½"

Sleeve Length: (40 cm / 15 ¾"), 40 cm / 15 ¾",

43 cm / 17", 46 / 18"

INFO AND TIPS

All the seams are made by slip stitches from the wrong side. All dc rows are right side rows, all sc rows are wrong side rows.

How to find your size

Size	Number of dc sts	Width
S-M	125 dc	53 cm / 21"
L-XL	135 dc	59 cm / 23 ¼"
2XL-3XL	145 dc	65 cm / 25 ½"
4XL-5XL	155 dc	71 cm / 28"

LEFT PANEL (FRONT-BACK PART)

Row 1 (col. 09): Foundation dc row. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc

Row 2 (col. 09): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc Row 3 (col. 94): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc Row 4 (col. 94): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc Row 5 (col. 14): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc Row 6 (col. 14): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc Row 7 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc Row 8 (col. 05): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc Row 9 (col. 78): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc



Row 10 (col. 78): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc Row 11 (col. 09): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc Row 12 (col. 09): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc Row 13 (col. 94): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc Row 14 (col. 94): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc

BACK

NOTE: All dc rows are right side rows, all sc rows are wrong side rows.

Connect col. 14 to the 63rd (68th, 73rd, 78th) sc

Row 1 (col. 14): Ch 2, dc in each sc. 63 (68, 73, 78) dc

Row 2 (col. 14): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc cut the yarn. 63 (68, 73, 78) sc

Row 3 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2,, dc in each sc. 63 (68, 73, 78) dc

Row 4 (col. 05): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 63 (68, 73, 78) sc

Row 5 (col. 78): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 63 (68, 73, 78) dc

Row 6 (col. 78): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 63 (68, 73, 78) sc

Row 7 (col. 09): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 63 (68, 73, 78) dc

Row 8 (col. 09): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 63 (68, 73, 78) sc

Row 9 (col. 94): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 63 (68, 73, 78) dc

Row 10 (col. 94): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 63 (68, 73, 78) sc

Row 11 (col. 14): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 63 (68, 73, 78) dc

Row 13 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 63 (68, 73, 78) dc

Row 14 (col. 05): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 63 (68, 73, 78) sc

Row 15 (col. 78): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, turn, dc in each sc. 63 (68, 73, 78) dc






RIGHT PANEL (FRONT-BACK PART)

Row 1 (col. 09): Crochet a foundation dc row - 62 (67, 72, 77) dc, proceed to work with dc across 63 (68, 73, 78) sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc.

The place of connecting fasten this way:



Row 2 (col. 09): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc Row 3 (col. 94): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc Row 4 (col. 94): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc Row 5 (col. 14): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc Row 6 (col. 14): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc



Row 7 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc

Row 8 (col. 05): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc

Row 9 (col. 78): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc

Row 10 (col. 78): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc

Row 11 (col. 09): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc

Row 12 (col. 09): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc

Row 13 (col. 94): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 125 (135, 145, 155) dc

Row 14 (col. 94): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 125 (135, 145, 155) sc

S-M finish off.

L-XL proceed to joining

Row 15 (col. 14): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 135 (145, 155) dc

Row 16 (col. 14): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 135 (145, 155) sc

L-XL finish off.

2XL-3XL proceed to joining

Row 17 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 145, (155) dc

Row 18 (col. 05): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 145, (155) sc

2XL-3XL finish off.

4XL-5XL proceed to joining

Row 9 (col. 78): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 155 dc **Row 10 (col. 78):** Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn.155 sc

4XL-5XL finish off.

For L-5XL sizes, let's go back to the first row of the left panel. We are going to add additional rows to this side. Connect col. 78 to the last sc of the back part and start crocheting:

L-XL

Row 1 (col. 78): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 135 (145, 155) dc **Row 2 (col. 78):** Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 135 (145, 155) sc



L-XL finish off.

2XL-3XL proceed to joining

Row 3 (col. 09): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 145 (155) dc

Row 4 (col. 09): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 145 (155) sc

2XL-3XL finish off.

4XL-5XL proceed to joining

Row 5 (col. 94): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 2, dc in each sc. 155 dc

Row 6 (col. 94): Ch 1 (turning chain), turn, sc in each dc, cut the yarn. 155 sc

4XL-5XL finish off.

SLEEVES

Make side seams with slip stitches from the wrong side of the cardi. Don't forget the armholes. Armhole - 42 (50, 58, 66) sc

Start working in turning rounds. All dc rounds are right side rounds, all sc rounds are wrong side rounds. I won't specify a color of yarn because it is different for each size. Please follow the previous color sequence (09 -> 94 -> 14 -> 05 -> 78 -> 09 -> 94)

Round 1 (right side): Connect yarn to the armhole, ch 2, dc in each sc around, join with sl st to top of ch 2. 42 (50, 58, 66) dc

Round 2 (wrong side): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc around, join with sl st to the first ch, cut the yarn. 42 (50, 58, 66) sc

Round 3 (right side): Change the color of the yarn, ch 2, dc in each sc around, join with sl st to top of ch 2. 42 (50, 58, 66) dc

Round 4 (wrong side): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc around, join with sl st to the first ch, cut the yarn. 42 (50, 58, 66) sc

Repeat Round 3-4 13 times (S-XL), 15 times (2XL-3XL), 17 times (4XL-5XL) repeat the same steps for the second sleeve.

HOOD

Square pattern:

With col. 05, ch 5, sl st in the first ch



Round 1 (col. 05): Ch 3, 3 dc into the circle, ch 2, * 4 dc into the circle, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3, cut the yarn

Round 2 (col. 91): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3, dc in same space, ch 2, 2 dc in same space, dc in next 4 dc, * 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 2 dc in same space, dc in next 4 dc **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3, cut the yarn

Round 3 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3, dc in same space, ch 2, 2 dc in same space, dc in next 8 dc, * 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 2 dc in same space, dc in next 8 dc **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3, cut the yarn

Round 4 (col. 91): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3, dc in same space, ch 2, 2 dc in same space, dc in next 12 dc, * 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 2 dc in same space, dc in next 12 dc **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3, cut the yarn

Round 5 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3, dc in same space, ch 2, 2 dc in same space, dc in next 16 dc, * 2 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 2 dc in same space, dc in next 16 dc **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3, cut the yarn

NOTE: All the seams are made by slip stitches from the wrong side.

Crochet 4 squares. Join three squares in the row, the fourth square connects to the middle square, the right and the left sides of the fourth squares connect to the bottom of the left and the right squares to form a hood. Crochet a row of dc across the bottom of the hood and connect it to the cardi - one square goes to the back part, the left and the right squares go to the left and the right sides.





BOTTOM BORDER

NOTE: All dc rows are right side rows, all sc rows are wrong side rows.



Connect col. 05 to the bottom of the cardi

Row 1 (col. 05): Ch 3, work with dc across the bottom

Row 2 (col. 05): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to the end of the row, cut the yarn

Row 3 (col. 91): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 3, dc in each sc to the end of the row

Row 4 (col. 91): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to the end of the row, cut the yarn

Row 5 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 3, dc in each sc to the end of the row

Row 6 (col. 05): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to the end of the row, cut the yarn

Row 7 (col. 91): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 3, dc in each sc to the end of the row

Row 8 (col. 91): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to the end of the row, cut the yarn

FRONT BORDER

NOTE: All dc rounds are right side rounds, all sc rounds are wrong side rounds.

Connect col. 91 to the bottom of the right side of the cardi and start working across the right side, the hood and the left side

Row 1 (col. 91): Ch 3, work with dc across the front part

Row 2 (col. 91): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to the end of the row, cut the yarn

Row 3 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 3, dc in each sc to the end of the row

Row 4 (col. 05): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to the end of the row, cut the yarn

Row 5 (col. 91): Connect the yarn to the last sc, ch 3, dc in each sc to the end of the row

Row 6 (col. 91): Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to the end of the row, cut the yarn

BELT

Chain 150 stitches, sc in the second chain from the hook, sc in each ch to the end of the row. Single crochet two more rows. Length - 165 cm (65")
