# Yarn Ball and Hook

## MATERIALS

### Amigo

1 skein of Light Gray Melange (A08)  
1 skein of Ecru (A02)  
1 skein of Sand (A03)  
1 skein of Dusty Green (A27)  
1 skein of Delicate Rose (A47)

3.5mm crochet hook  
Darning needle  
scissors  
Glue gun (optional)

## YARN QUALITY

 **Amigo**, Hobbii  
100% HB acrylic  
50 g (1.8 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

## ABBREVIATIONS

mc - magic circle  
st - stitch  
ch - chain  
ss - slip stitch  
sc - single crochet  
hdc - half double crochet  
dc - double crochet  
sc2tog - single crochet 2 stitches together  
hdc2tog - half double crochet 2 stitches together

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx. 13 cm (5.1") high and 16 cm (6.3") wide

Calling all crochet lovers! Here is a pattern for a cute little yarn ball and hook. Choose your favorite color for the yarn ball and spice up your old clothes with this adorable applique. You can adjust the size by using a larger or smaller hook.

# Pattern



## YARN BALL

(Make 2) Using col. A47

1. Ch16, hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook and each ch to the end (15) turn
2. Ch1, hdc in each st (15) turn
3. Ch1, 2hdc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, hdc in next 13sts, 2hdc in last st (17) turn
- 4-6. Ch1, hdc in each st (17) turn
7. Ch1, hdc2tog, hdc in 13sts, hdc2tog (15) turn
8. Ch1, hdc2tog, hdc in 11sts, hdc2tog (13) turn
9. Ch1, sc2tog, hdc in 2sts, dc in 5sts, hdc in 2sts, sc2tog,  
Fasten off leaving a long tail approx. 200 cm (79") to wrap round to create a ball of wool.

## YARN BAND

Using col. A02

1. Ch5, 2hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, hdc in next 2ch, 2hdc in last ch (6) turn
- 2-10. Ch1, hdc in each st (6) turn
11. Ch1, hdc2tog, hdc in 2sts, hdc2tog (4) fasten off

## HEART

Using col. A03 make a magic circle

Ch3, (2dc, 2hdc, 1dc, 2hdc, 2dc, ch2, ss) all in mc, fasten off

## CROCHET HOOK

Using col. A08

Ch35, sc in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> ch from the hook, ch1, ss in same ch as last sc, ss in next st, sc in remaining sts, fasten off

## LARGE FLOWER

Using col. A03

1. Ch25, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and each ch to the end (24) turn
2. Ch1, (5dc in next st, ss in next st) x5. (5hdc in next st, ss in next st) x4.  
(5sc in next st, ss in next st) x3, fasten off leaving 20 cm (7.8") tail for sewing

## FLOWER BUDS

(Make 3) Using col. A02 make a magic circle, ch1, 5sc in mc, ss to 1<sup>st</sup> sc, ch6, fasten off

## LEAVES

(Make 4) Using col. A27

Ch6, ss in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in next 2ch. 5hdc in last ch, now working along bottom of the chain, hdc in next 2ch, sc in next ch, ss to top of leaf, fasten off.

## ASSEMBLY

Sew in the tails if you are using a hot glue gun to join your pieces

Do not sew in the tails if you are sewing your pieces together

1. Wrap the tail of the yarn ball across the front and secure it in place at the back with a small stitch making sure to keep the piece flat. Continue to wrap the yarn across the front of the yarn ball, securing each wrap with a stitch at the back. I did approx. 12 wraps
2. Place the 2 sections of the yarn ball together and join with slip stitches
3. Lay the crochet hook across the yarn ball. You will be able to see the best place to slot the hook under the yarn wraps. Secure into position
4. Attach the heart to the yarn band then attach the yarn band across the centre of the yarn ball
5. Curl the flower into shape and secure with a couple of stitches at the back
6. Attach the leaves and flower buds to the flower as shown
7. Attach the flower to the yarn ball
