



KNITTING PATTERN

Hooded Cat

Cape

MATERIALS

3/3/4 skeins of Peacock color 14 – **Yarn A**
1/1/1 skein of Peacock color 07 – **Yarn B**

Circular needle 9 mm (US 13)
Straight needle 6 mm (US 10)
5 Stitch markers
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Peacock**, Hobbii
100% Polyester
100 g (3.5 oz) = 65 m (71 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 9 sts x 11 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit
P = Purl
St(s) = Stitch(es)
C/on = Cast on
C/off = Cast off
PM = Place marker
M = Marker
SM = Slide marker
RM = Remove marker
Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work
K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

SIZE

Child / S / M

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 42/53/57 cm / 16.54"/20.87/22.44"
Width - shoulder to shoulder: 44/56/67 cm / 17.32/22.05/26.38"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Fabulous hooded cat cape you can make for Halloween or you can wear on a cold winter day.

The first part of the hood is knitted flat then joined in the round at the chin level. The ears are knitted separately and added at the end. It is a quick project made on big needles. The pattern is suitable for the intermediate levelled knitter.

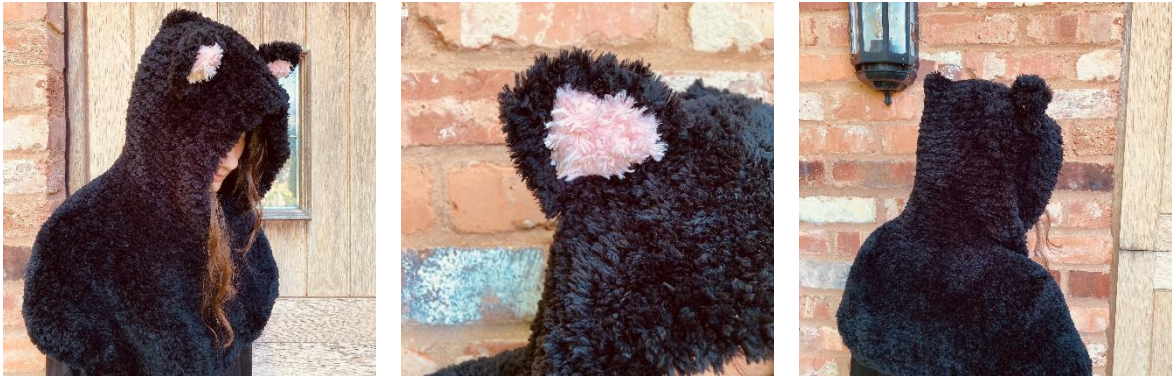

Pattern



HOOD

C/on 45/50/60 sts on 9 mm (US 13) with yarn A, leave a long tail to sew the top of the head later.

Do not join in the round now but work this part flat

Row 1: – K row

Repeat the first row 30/38/46 times

We will now join in the round, make sure not to twist your work and PM to mark the beginning of your round (If you can have this marker looking different of the other 4)

Next round: – K6/7/9, PM, K8/9/11, PM, K17/18/20, PM, K8/9/11, PM, K6/7/9

Next round: – (K to 1 st before the M, Kf&b, SM, Kf&b) x 4, K to the end of the round

Next round: – K row and SM

Repeat the last 2 rounds 4/6/8 times (85/106/132 sts)

Next round: – K row and RM

Repeat the last round 9 times

Next round: – (K2, P2) repeat to the last 1/2/0 sts, K1/K2/K0

Repeat the last round 3/4/5 times

C/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

OUTSIDE EARS (MAKE 2)

C/on 10 sts on 9 mm (US 13) with yarn A

Do not join in the round, work the ears flat

Row 1: – K row

Row 2: – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog

Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 4 sts

Next row: – (K2tog) x 2

Next row: – K row

Next row: – K2tog

C/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

INNER EARS (MAKE 2)

C/on 8 sts on 6 mm (US 10) with yarn B

Do not join in the round work the ears flat

Row 1: – K row

Row 2: – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog

Repeat the last 2 rows once more

Next row: – K row

Next row: – (K2tog) x 2

Next row: – K2tog

C/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Sew the top of the head with your c/on tail.

Attach the inner ears to the outside parts and place each one to the top of the hood on each side.

Weave in all ends
