# Pineapple Feather 

## Sweater

## MATERIALS

(4), $6,7,8,9,10,11,13$ skeins of Friends Kid Silk, color Cornflower (83)

Crochet hook 4 mm (G6)
A needle and thread

## YARN QUALITY

(60) Friends Kid Silk, Hobbii

72\% Mohair, 25\% Silk, 3\% Wool,
25 g (0.9 oz) = $200 \mathrm{~m}(218 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

1 pineapple $=5 \mathrm{~cm}$ width $\times 6 \mathrm{~cm}$ length
(2" width $\times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ length)

## ABBREVIATIONS

sl st = slip stitch
ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet

## SIZE

(S), M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL

## MEASUREMENTS

## INFO AND TIPS

## How to find your size

Measure the fullest part of your chest and divide your measurement by 2 , chain according to the table. The number of chain stitches is a multiple of $15+5$.

| Size | Number of <br> chains | Width |

| S | 95 chs | $41 \mathrm{~cm} / 16^{\prime \prime}$ |
| M | 110 chs | $46 \mathrm{~cm} / 18^{\prime \prime}$ |
| L | 125 chs | $51 \mathrm{~cm} / 20^{\prime \prime}$ |
| XL | 140 chs | $56 \mathrm{~cm} / 22^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $2 X L$ | 155 chs | $61 \mathrm{~cm} / 24^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $3 X L$ | 170 chs | $66 \mathrm{~cm} / 26^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $4 X L$ | 200 chs | $71 \mathrm{~cm} / 28^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $5 X L$ | $76 \mathrm{~cm} / 30^{\prime \prime}$ |  |

## MAIN PATTERN

Row 1: Ch 95 (110, 125, 140, 155, 170, 185, 200), sc in the sixth ch from the hook, ch 3, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 4, skip next 3 chs, dc in next ch, ch 4, skip next 3 chs, sc in next ch * ch 3, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 3, skip next 2 chs, sc in next ch, ch 3, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 4, skip next 3 chs, dc in next ch, ch 4, skip next 3 chs, sc in next ch **, rep from * to ** to the last 4 chs, ch 3, skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch 1, dc in the last ch

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in the first ch-space, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 4, dc in next dc, ch 1 , dc in same dc, ch 4, * sc in next ch-3 space, (ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space) twice, ch 4, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in same dc, ch 4 **, rep from * to ** to the last two ch-3 spaces, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3 , sc in the last ch space

Row 3: Ch 4, turn, sc in the first ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in next ch 1 space, (ch 1, dc in same space) 4 times, * (ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space) twice, ch 3, dc in next ch-1 space, (ch 1, dc in same space) 4 times **, rep from * to ** to the end of the row, ch 3, sc in the last ch-3 space, ch $1, \mathrm{dc}$ in the last sc

Row 4: Ch 7, turn, skip next sc and ch-3 space, sc in next ch-1 space, (ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space) three times, * ch 4, dc in the second ch-3 space, ch 4, sc in next ch-1 space, (ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space) three times **, rep from * to ** to the end of the row, ch 4, dc in the last ch space

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), dc in the first dc, ch 4, sc in next ch-3 space, (ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space) twice, ch 4, * dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in same dc, ch 4, sc in next ch-3 space, (ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space) twice, ch 4 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the row, skip next 4 chs, 2 dc in the fifth ch

Row 6: Ch 4, turn, dc in the first dc, ch 1, dc in same dc, (ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space) twice, * ch 3 , dc in next ch-1 space, (ch 1, dc in same space) four times, (ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space) twice **, rep from * to ** to the end of the row, ch 3, dc in the last dc, (ch 1, dc in the same dc) twice

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, sc in the 1st ch-1 space, ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 4, dc in the second ch-3 space, ch 4, * sc in next ch-1 space, (ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space) three times, ch 4, dc in the second ch-3 space, ch 4 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the row, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 3 , sc in the last ch space, ch 1 , dc in the last ch space

Repeat Row 2-7 8 times (S), 9 times (M), 10 times (L), 11 times (XL), 12 times ( 2 XL ), 13 times (3XL), 14 times ( 4 XL ), 15 times ( 5 XL ) or until you reach the desired length. After that, finish with Row 2. You will need 2 of these parts - a front and a back panel

## SLEEVES

Chain according to the table and repeat the main pattern 7 times ( $\mathrm{S}, \mathrm{M}, \mathrm{L}, \mathrm{XL}$ ), 8 times ( 2 XL , $3 X L, 4 X L, 5 X L$ ) or until you reach the desired length.

| Size | Number of chains | Width |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| S | 65 chains | $31 \mathrm{~cm} / 13^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ |
| M | 80 chains | $36 \mathrm{~cm} / 14^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ |
| L | 95 chains | $41 \mathrm{~cm} / 17^{1 / 4^{\prime}}$ |
| XL | 110 chains | $46 \mathrm{~cm} / 1^{\prime \prime}$ |
| 2 XL | 125 chains | $51 \mathrm{~cm} / 0^{\prime \prime}$ |


| $3 X L$ | 140 chains | $56 \mathrm{~cm} / 22^{\prime \prime}$ |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| $4 X L$ | 155 chains | $61 \mathrm{~cm} / 24^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $5 X L$ | 170 chains | $66 \mathrm{~cm} / 26^{\prime \prime}$ |

## CUFFS

You'll need 4 cuffs - 2 wrist cuffs and 2 front and back cuffs of the body part

Row 1: foundation sc, 10 sts

Row 2: ch-1 (doesn't count as a stitch), turn, sc in each sc in the back loop only (10 sc)

Repeat Row 2 until you reach the desired length, the length of each cuff should be $80 \%$ of the width of the sleeve and the bottom part.

Sew 4 cuffs to the sweater, after that make shoulders seams, sides seams and sleeves seams. Don't forget about armhole spaces and space for a future turtleneck. The width of armholes depends on the width of the sleeve.

NOTE: all the seams are made with a needle and corresponding color thread from the wrong side.

## TURTLENECK

Connect the yarn to the neck and start crocheting rounds of ch-3 spaces. Fasten off. I crocheted 20 rounds ( 12 cm or 5").
