



KNITTING PATTERN

Pumpkin Bear

MATERIALS

Honey Bunny

- 1 skein of color 118 – **Yarn A**
- 1 skein of color 124 – **Yarn B**
- 1 skein of color 31 – **Yarn C**
- 1 skein of color 111 – **Yarn D**

Straight needle 6 mm (US 10)
Darning needle
Stuffing

YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii
100% Polyester
100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 10 sts x 18 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit
P = Purl
St(s) = Stitch(es)
C/on = Cast on
C/off = Cast off
Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back
of the same stitch with the yarn at the back
of the work
K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together
P2tog = Purl the next two stitches together

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 36 cm / 14.17" with the hat

PATTERN INFORMATION

Adorable cuddly pumpkin bear great to add to your Halloween decor.

The bear is knitted flat in 6 individual pieces stuffed and sewn together. The hat and the pumpkin are knitted separately, stuffed, and fixed to the bear.

Pattern



BEAR

Head

C/on 10 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (Kf&b, K2) x 3, Kf&b (14 sts)

Row 2 – P row

Row 3 – (Kf&b, K1) x 7 (21 sts)

Row 4 – P row

Row 5 – (Kf&b) x 21 (42 sts)

Row 6 – P row

Row 7 – K row

Row 8 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 6 times

Row 22 – (K2, K2tog) x 10, K2 (32 sts)

Row 23 – P row

Row 24 – (K1, K2tog) x 10, K2 (22 sts)

Row 25 – P row

Row 26 – (K2tog) x 11 (11 sts)

Thread through all the 11 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Body

C/on 16 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (Kf&b, K2) x 5, K1 (21 sts)

Row 2 – P row

Row 3 – (Kf&b, K1) x 10, K1 (31 sts)

Row 4 – P row

Row 5 – K row

Row 6 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 13 times

Next row – (K1, K2tog) x 10, K1 (21 sts)

Next row – P row

Next row – (K2tog) x 10, K1 (11 sts)

Next row – P row

Next row – (K2tog) x 5, K1 (6 sts)

Thread through all the 6 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Arm (make 2)

C/on 12 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – P row

Repeat the first 2 rows 9 times

Next row – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (10 sts)

Next row – P2tog, P to the last 2 sts, P2tog (8 sts)

Next row – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (6 sts)

C/off all the 6 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Foot (make 2)

C/on 10 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – P row

Repeat the first 2 rows twice

Next row – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b (12 sts)

Next row – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times (18 sts)

Next row – (K2tog, K2) x 4, K2 (14 sts)

Next row – P row

Next row – (K2tog) x 7 (7 sts)

C/off all the 7 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

HAT

C/on 80 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – P row

Repeat the first 2 rows once

Row 5 – P row (on the right side)

Row 6 – P row

Row 7 – (K3, K2tog) x 16 (64 sts)

Row 8 – P row

Row 9 – K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 2 times

Row 14 – P row

Row 15 – (K2, K2tog) x 16 (48 sts)

Row 16 – P row

Row 17 – (K1, K2tog) x 16 (32 sts)

Row 18 – P row

Row 19 – K row

Row 20 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times

Row 27 – (K2tog) x 16 (16 sts)

Row 28 – P row

Row 29 – K row

Row 30 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 2 times

Row 35 – (K2tog) x 8 (8 sts)

Row 36 – P row

Row 37 – K row

Row 38 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times

Row 45 – (K2tog) x 4 (4 sts)

Row 46 – P row

Row 47 – K row

Repeat the last 2 rows once

Thread through all the 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

PUMPKIN

C/on 12 sts with yarn C

Row 1 – P row

Row 2 – (Kf&b) x 12 (24 sts)

Row 3 – P row

Row 4 – K row

Row 5 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 5 times

Next row – (K2tog) x 12 (12 sts)

Next row – (P2tog) x 6 (6 sts)

Thread through all the 6 sts, cut the yarn leave a long tail to sew and shape the pumpkin and make secure

STALK

C/on 3 sts with yarn D

Create an Icord as follow:

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – Move all your sts back on the left needle, K row

Repeat these 2 rows until your piece measure 5 cm / 1.97"

C/off all the 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

VINE

The long one

C/on 20 sts with yarn D

C/off all the 20 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

The short one

C/on 15 sts with yarn D

C/off all the 15 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

HEAD - Join the edges and stuff generously, then close the opening. Embroidered the eyes and the nose with yarn B.

BODY - Join the seams at the back and stuff as you go then close the opening. Then sew the head to the body.

ARMS - Join the seams along the arms, start stuffing as you go and close the opening. Add the arms to the side of the body.

LEGS - Join the seams along the legs but inside out to show a different stitch, start stuffing as you go and close the opening. Add the legs at the bottom front of the body.

HAT - Join the seams along the hat. Stuff only the bottom part of the hat at the top of the head and sew the hat in place around the crown of the head.

PUMPKIN - Join the seams along the back, start stuffing as you go and close the opening. With the long tail thread through the centre of the pumpkin 4 times (to create a cross) pull to give it a shape then secure it into place.
Add the stalk and the two vines at the top centre of the pumpkin.
Sew the pumpkin to the bear between the two arms.

Weave in all other ends
