# Vinterdrøm

## MATERIALS

### Unicorn Solid

4 (5) 5 (5) 6 skeins color Lavender (11)

### Soft Alpaca Lace

4 (5) 5 (5) 6 skeins color Hydrangea Purple (24)

Circular needles 4½ mm, 40 cm

Circular needles 4½ mm, 80 cm

Stitch markers

Stitch holder

## YARN QUALITY

 **Unicorn Solid**, Hobbii

75% merino wool, 25% polyamide

100 g = 400 m

 **Soft Alpaca Lace**, Hobbii

100% alpaca

50 g = 400 m

## GAUGE

10 x 10 cm = 19 sts x 24 r on needles 4½ mm

## ABBREVIATIONS

r – right

l – left

yo – yarn over

st – stitch

sm – stitch marker

k – knit

p – purl

tog – together

M1R – make one right

M1L – make one left

## SIZE

XS (S) M (L) XL

## MEASUREMENTS

Length: 93 (94) 95 (96) 97 cm

Bust circumference: 94 (99) 105 (111) 118 cm

## PATTERN INFORMATION

An elegant and timeless knee-length dress with puff sleeves, knitted in stockinette stitch from top to bottom.

The dress is worked with 2 threads held together;

1 thread Unicorn Solid together with 1 thread Soft Alpaca Lace, or 1 thread Kid silk, if you prefer mohair.

There are simple techniques used to form the fine details, with a little experience and good patience this dress can be knitted by the vast majority.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Weave in all loose ends and lightly steam the garment.

The I-cord-edge at the bottom of the dress should be steam-blocked to prevent it from rolling upwards.

## YOKE

Cast on 78 (78) 82 (86) 90 sts on your 4,5 mm circular needles.

Place a sm between the first and last stitch on your needles = mid back and the beginning of the round.

Knit stockinette stitch in rounds for 3 cm.

On the next round you will knit the cast-on edge down, like this:

Knit 1 st from the needle tog with a stitch from the cast-on edge, or sew the edge down at the end if you find this difficult.

On the next round the work is divided into shoulders, front piece and back piece, using 4 sm.

Knit 15 (15) 16 (17) 18 sts over half the back piece, place a sm, knit 9 sts, place a sm, knit 30 (30) 32 (34) 36 sts, place a sm, knit 9 sts, place a sm, knit 15 (15) 16 (17) 18 sts over the last half of the back piece.

You are now at the beginning of the round and from here on you will do increases on the front- and back piece on every round.

The increases are made as follows

1. Knit over half the back piece to the first sm, M1R, move the sm over to the right needle, knit the shoulder stitches, move the sm over to the right needle, M1L, knit the front piece, M1R, move the sm over to the right needle, knit the shoulder stitches, move the sm over to the right needle, M1L, knit over the last half of the back piece.
2. Repeat the first round 10 times in total.

You now have 50 (50) 52 (54) 56 sts for each part of the front- and back piece.

On the next round you will make the puff sleeves, like this:

### **PUFF SLEEVES**

1. Knit over half the back piece, move the sm over to the right needle, yo, \*k 1, yo\* to the next sm, move the sm to the right needle, knit over the front piece, move the sm to the right needle, yo, \*k 1, yo\* to the next sm, move the sm to the right needle, knit over the last half of the back piece.
2. Knit 1 round, without increases. The yo is worked twisted knitwise.

Step 1 and 2 is worked 2 times in total.  
= 39 sts per sleeve.

Continue knitting the yoke in stockinette stitch with increases on every other round - first for the sleeves and then for the yoke.

### **Increasing the sleeves**

1. Knit to the first sm, move the sm to the right needle, M1L, knit to the next sm, M1R, move the sm to the right needle, knit over the front piece, move the sm to the right needle, M1L, knit to the sm, M1R, move the sm to the right needle.
2. Knit 1 round
3. Work rounds 1-2 11 (12) 14 (16) 18 times in total. You now have 61 (63) 67 (71) 75 sts per sleeve.

Now you will increase for the yoke. Work like this:

### **Increases for the yoke**

1. Knit to the first sm, M1R, move the sm to the right needle, knit over the sleeve, move the sm to the right needle, M1L, knit over the front piece to the next sm, M1R, move the sm to the right needle, knit over the sleeve, move the sm to the right needle, M1L
2. Knit 1 round
3. Work row 1-2 19 (21) 23 (25) 27 times in total. You now have 176 (184) 196 (208) 220 sts for the yoke, not counting the sleeves

On the next round, you put the sleeves on a stitch holder or piece of scrap yarn.

Knit to the first sm (remove the sm), put the sleeve stitches on a thread, cast on 2 sts under the arm using loop cast-on, (remove the sm) knit over the front piece sts to the sm (remove the sm), put the sleeve sts on a thread, cast on 2 sts under the arm using loop cast-on, (remove the sm), knit to the sm mid back (the beginning of the round)

You should now have 180 (188) 200 (212) 224 sts for the body.

Knit in rounds in stockinette stitch until the body measures approx. 12 cm measured from under the sleeve.

You are now at the beginning of the round and the blouse is to be knitted longer in the back using german short rounds.

Turn 4 times in total on each side of the marker, like this:

1. K 10, turn, work a turning stitch

2. P 10 past the sm mid back, turn, work a turning stitch
3. K 10 past the previous turning stitch, turn, work a turning stitch
4. P 10 past the previous turning stitch, turn, work a turning stitch
5. K 10 past the previous turning stitch, turn, work a turning stitch
6. P 10 past the previous turning stitch, turn, work a turning stitch
7. K 10 past the previous turning stitch, turn, work a turning stitch
8. P 10 past the previous turning stitch, turn, work a turning stitch
9. Knit 1 whole round to the sm

## SKIRT

Now you will do increases for the skirt. This is done using yarn over. The yo's are worked twisted knitwise on the next round, to prevent holes. This is done as follows:

\*K 2, yo\* repeat from \* to \* to the end of the round.

Knit one round, but the yo's are worked twisted knitwise.

Continue knitting in rounds in stockinette stitch until the whole work measures 93 (94) 95 (96) 97 cm, or desired length, the length is measured mid front, under the turned hem in the neck.

Bind off with a thin i-cord.

\*K1, 2 sts twisted knitwise together\* move the sts back to the left needle, and repeat until all sts are bound off. Stitch together the last 2 sts with the beginning of the round to have a seamless edge around the dress.

## SLEEVES

Put the 61 (63) 67 (71) 75 sts for the sleeve on 4,5 mm needles and pick up 3 sts under the arm. You now have 64 (66) 70 (74) 78 sts on your needles and the round starts under the arm.

Knit in rounds in stockinette stitch until the sleeve measures 40 cm or desired length, measured from under the arm.

Now you will make the end of the sleeve, first you bind off sts so that the sleeve is slightly scrunched up, before increasing to a small frill. The frill is approx. 4-5 cm.

Do like this:

Work 1 round \*K2tog\*

Work 1 round \*K 3, K2tog\*

Knit 5 rounds

Work 1 round \*K 1, yo\*

Knit 1 round (yo's are worked twisted knitwise)

Work 1 round \*K 3, yo\*

Knit 1 round (yo's are worked twisted knitwise)

Knit 1 round

Purl 1 round

Cast off \*K 2 twisted knitwise together, move sts back to the left needle\* until all stitches are bound off.
