MATERIALS

Friends Extra Fine Merino

1 skein of col. White 01
1 skein of col. Nougat 09
1 skein of col. Chocolate 12
1(1, 2, 2, 2) skein(s) of col. Cranberry 42
2(3, 3, 4, 4) skeins of col. Bottle Green 112
1 skein of colour Black 124

Crochet hook 3.5 mm
Tape Measure
Scissors
Darning Needle
Stitch Markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Extra Fine Merino**, Hobbii
100% Wool
50g (1.75 oz) = 165m (180 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 21 hdc x 17 rows

SIZES

12-18 months (2, 4, 6, 8) years

MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 55(58.5, 61.5, 67, 72)cm / 21.5(23, 24.5, 26.5, 28.5)"

Shoulder to Waist Length: 25.5(27.5, 30.5, 35, 40)cm / 10(10.75, 12, 13.75, 15.75)"

Sleeve Length: 21(23, 29, 31, 35) cm / 8.25(9, 11.5, 12.25, 13.75)"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This ultra cute reindeer jumper is worked from the bottom up, working the front and back panels first and then the sleeves are worked.

The reindeer is made using a graph so confidence in following charts is recommended.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
 slst = slip stitch
 st(s) = stitch(es)
 hdc = half double crochet
 dc = double crochet
 fp = front post
 bp = back post
 dec = decrease (two stitches together)
 PM = place stitch marker

BODY

FRONT PIECE

Using colour Bottle Green, ch 59(61, 65, 71, 77), includes turning ch,

Row 1: working in the back bumps of the chs, hdc in each st across, ch 1, turn

Row 2 to row 2(4, 6, 5, 9): hdc in each st across, ch 1, turn

Now you will follow the chart according to your size to make the reindeer pattern.

Each row starts and ends with an extra 16(17, 19, 18, 21) hdc which is not shown on the chart. If preferred, you can place a marker in the 17th(18th, 20th, 19th, 22nd) stitch from each side. When you reach the marked sts, they indicate the first and last st on the graph.

Row 1 of the chart starts at the bottom right-hand corner of the chart and this becomes the right side of the work.

Follow the chart reading it from right to left, then turn the piece and crochet back reading left to right. Although the chart is symmetrical, I find it easier to follow it in this way to help keep track of rows. Each box represents one half double crochet.

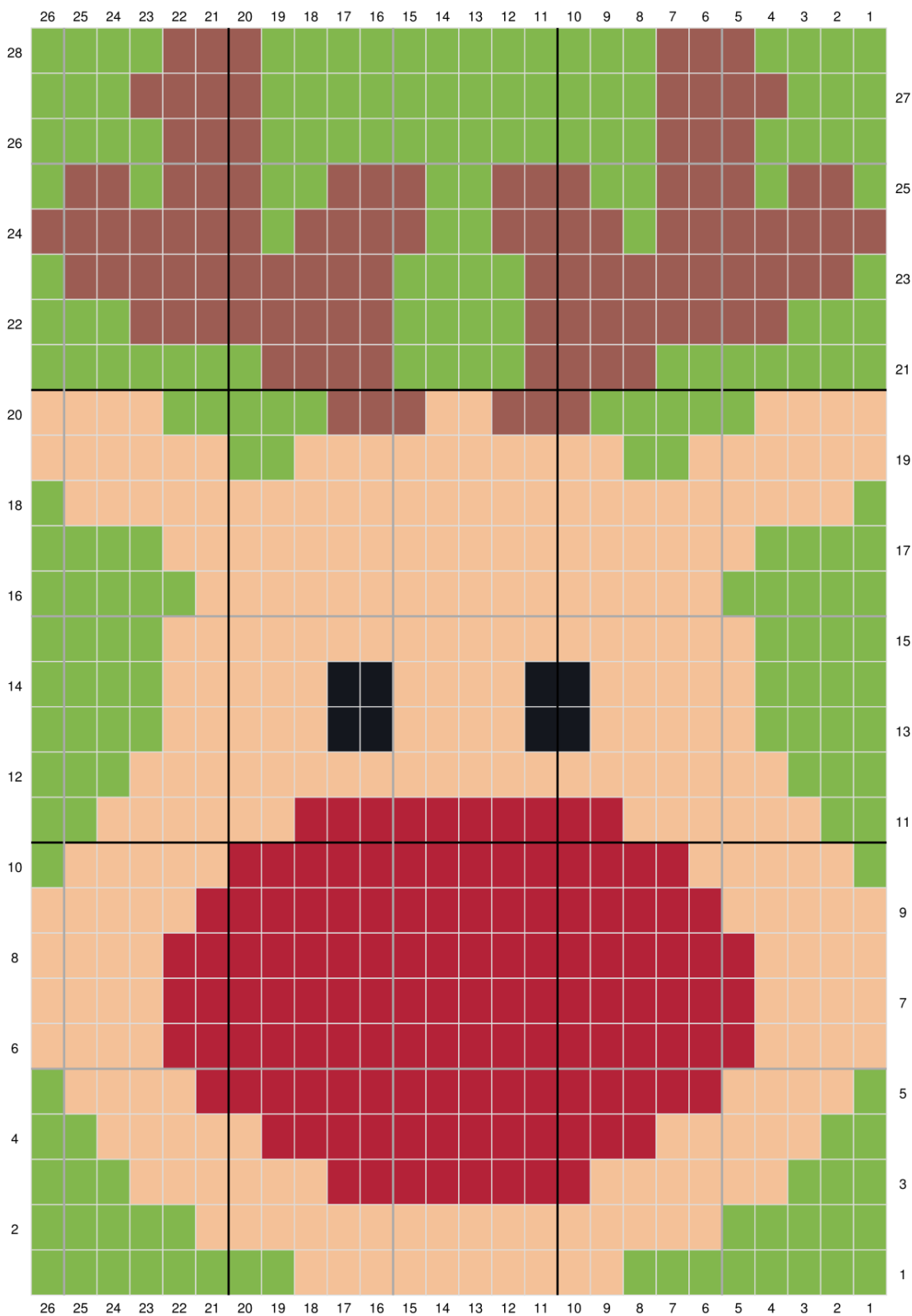


At the end of each row, you must ch 1, turn your work, and begin your next row, skipping the chain stitch you just made.

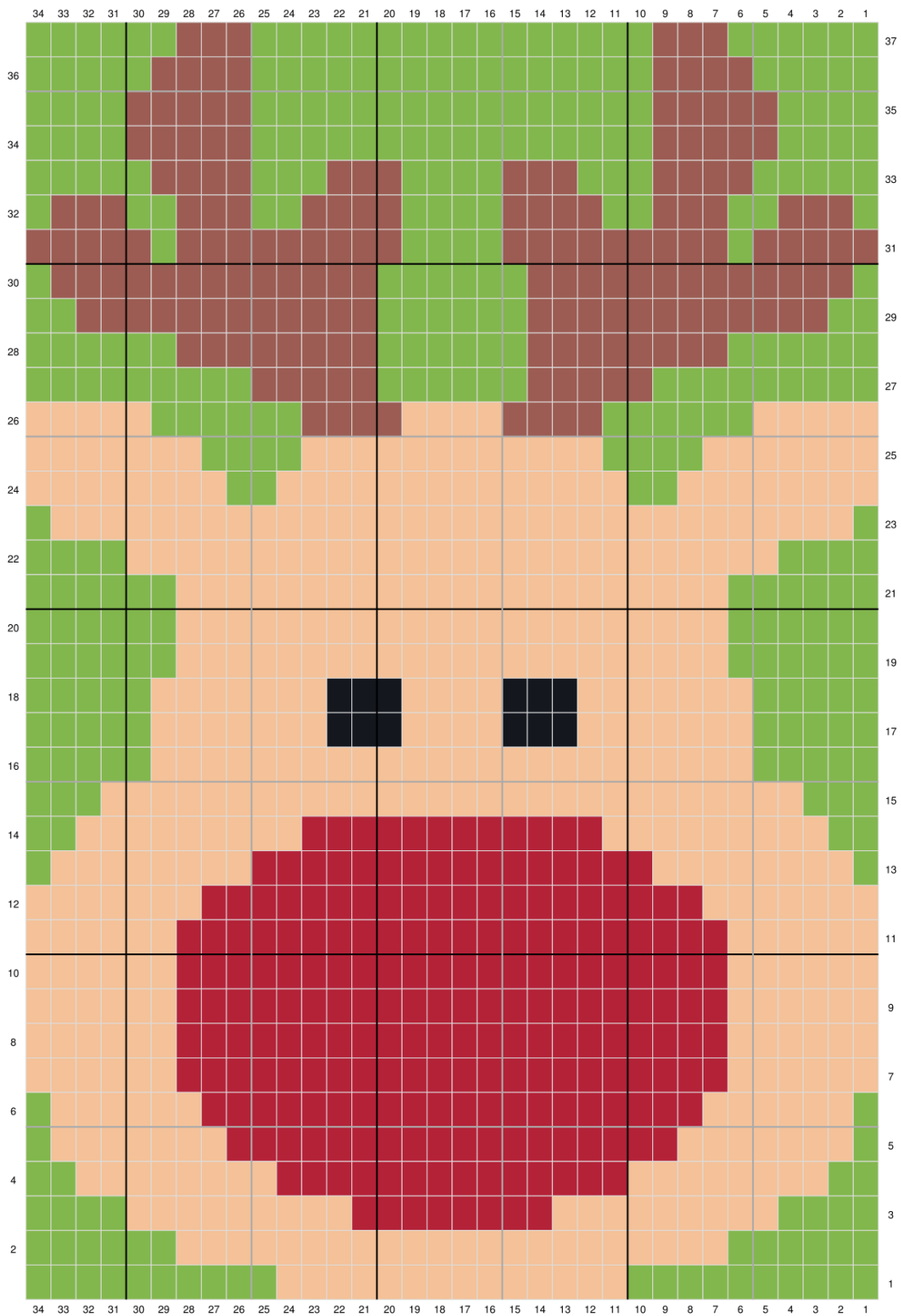
When the chart shows to change colour, complete the colour change on the last stitch of the previous colour by pulling the new colour through the remaining three loops of the hdc. Do not fasten off unless you see that colour is not used in that place on the next row.

When changing colours, drop the used colour on the WS of the work to keep it as neat as possible on the right side.

Size 12-18, 2 & 4



Size 6 & 8



Remainder of body before neck shaping

Row 1 to row 3(4, 6, 6, 9): hdc in each st across, ch 1, turn

Do not fasten off

Neck Shaping

Continue working in rows,

Row 1 to row 11(11, 12, 12, 13): hdc in the next 14(14, 15, 18, 20) sts, ch 1, turn
Fasten off and weave in ends.

Attach colour Bottle Green in the 14th(14th, 15th, 18th, 20th) st from the opposite edge.
Working towards the outside edge, ch 1, hdc in the next 14(14, 15, 18, 20) sts, ch 1, turn



Row 2 to row 11(11, 12, 12, 13): hdc in the next 14(14, 15, 18, 20) sts, ch 1, turn
Fasten off and weave in ends.

BACK PIECE

- For sizes 6 & 8 all even numbered rows are your right side
- For sizes 12- 18, 2 & 4 all odd numbered rows are your right side
- You may find it helpful to PM on the right side for reference

Using colour Bottle Green, ch 59(61, 65, 71, 77), includes turning ch,

Row 1: working in the back bumps of the chs, hdc in each st across, ch 1, turn

Row 2 to row 44(47, 52, 60, 68): hdc in each st across, ch 1, turn

SEAMING FRONT AND BACK PIECES

Shoulders:

Lay the front and back pieces wrong sides together, and using colour Bottle Green, use the mattress stitch to attach the pieces together. Shown by the dotted lines on the picture below.



Sides:

With the right side facing

Lay the front and back pieces wrong sides together, and attach st markers on both pieces each side in the 27th(29th, 32nd, 38th, 44th) row from the bottom edge.

Using colour Bottle Green, use the mattress stitch to attach the pieces together. Shown by the dotted lines on the picture below.



SLEEVES

- For the sleeves you will change colour every 3 rows, starting with Bottle Green, then Cranberry and then White. You do not have to fasten off the yarn each time, just carry the yarn up on the wrong side of the work. I suggest locking the yarn not being used in the first stitch of the next round.

Using Bottle Green and with the right side facing, attach yarn in the under arm seam,

Round 1: Ch 1, evenly place 36(38, 42, 46, 50) hdc around the arm opening. This should be 1 hdc for each row and an extra hdc in the seams, join to the first hdc with a slst, turn,

Round 2 to round 30(33, 43, 46, 53): hdc in each st around, join to the first hdc with a slst, ch 1, turn,

NOTE: if you are due to change colour, change to colour Cranberry

Round

31: *hdc 4, dec 1* repeat between ** 6 times [30]

34: *hdc 4, dec 1* repeat between ** 6 times, hdc 2 [32]

44: *hdc 2, dec 1* repeat between ** 10 times, hdc 2 [32]

47: hdc 2, *hdc 1, dec 1* repeat between ** 14 times, hdc 2 [32]

54: *hdc 1, dec 1* repeat between ** 16 times, hdc 2 [34]

Join to the first hdc with a slst, if you are not already using colour Cranberry, change to Cranberry now and fasten off all other colours, continue onto ribbing.

RIBBING FOR SLEEVES

Round 1: With the right side facing, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each st around, slst into the top of ch 3,

Round 2-6: ch 1 (does not count as a st), *fpdc 1, bpdcc 1* repeat between ** around, slst to the first st,

Fasten off and weave in ends.

NECK

With the right side facing and using colour Bottle Green, attach yarn in the first unused stitch on the back piece at the neck line, ch 1,

Round 1: *hdc 1 in the next 30(32, 34, 34, 36) sts, hdc 11(11, 12, 12, 13) evenly along the side* repeat between ** twice, slst to first st, change colour to Cranberry,

Round 2: ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each st around, slst into the top of ch 3,

Round 3-5: ch 1 (does not count as a st), *fpdc 1, bpdcc 1* repeat between ** around, slst to the first st,

Fasten off and weave in ends.



BOTTOM RIBBING

With the right side facing and using colour Bottle Green, attach yarn in the first unused stitch on the back piece at the bottom, ch 1,

Round 1: *hdc 1 in the next 58(60, 64, 70, 76) sts, hdc 1 in the seam* repeat between ** twice, slst to first st, change colour to Cranberry,

Round 2: ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each st around, slst into the top of ch 3,

Round 3: ch 1 (does not count as a st), fpdc 1, bpdC 1, fpdc-dec 1, *bpdC 1, fpdc 1, bpdC 1, fpdc-dec 1*, repeat between ** around. Make sure that your last stitch worked is a bpdC, you may need to adjust your sts and add in another fpdc-dec at the end before the final bpdC. Slst to the first st,

Round 4-6: ch 1 (does not count as a st), *fpdc 1, bpdC 1* repeat between ** around, slst to the first st,

Fasten off and weave in ends.
