

OPEN BOOK - WRAP

— Oversized triangle scarf with popcorn stitches



Indulge in the delicate balance of color and texture found in the Open Book Wrap. Pairing classic granny stripes with structured popcorn stitches, this oversized triangle scarf will be by your side through autumn strolls and marathon reading sessions. Play with your color palette to change the vibe, but be sure your border color has a strong contrast to the overall color scheme. Add or remove sections as you please to customize the size of your shawl.

The Open Book Wrap is part of the Happy Place pattern collection, designed to complement Happy Place Yarn. Find even more patterns and get the yarn needed for this project from Hobbii's website.

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PROJECT SUPPLIES

YARN: Hobbii Happy Place, DK weight (#3); 50% wool, 50% cotton [273 yards (250 m) per 100g skein].

- A – 32 Melange, 210 yards / 192 m, (1 skein)
- B – 06 Melange, 120 yards / 110 m, (1 skein)
- C – 29 Melange, 145 yards / 133 m, (1 skein)
- D – 22 Melange, 160 yards / 147 m, (1 skein)
- E – 01 Melange, 175 yards / 160 m, (1 skein)
- MC – 34 Solid, 500 yards / 458 m, (2 skeins)

HOOK: US I/9 5.5mm crochet hook

NOTIONS & SUPPLIES: Scissors, tapestry needle, steam blocking supplies

FINISHED DIMENSIONS

SIZE: 80" (203 cm) wide x 40" (101.5 cm) deep

GAUGE: 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm) = 4 3dc groups x 8 rows in granny stitch pattern

PATTERN DIRECTIONS

NOTES

- Starting ch-3 counts as double crochet.
- All popcorn stitches are made with the WS (wrong side) of the work facing you.
- Portions of this pattern are written in crochet shorthand. For example, “sc 2” means to single crochet in each of the next 2 stitches, while 3dc means to place 3 double crochet stitches in the next stitch or space.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Popcorn Stitch (pc): Place 5 dc in the indicated st, remove hook from active lp, insert hook under both lps of first dc, place active lp on hook, pull through lps of first dc to close popcorn.

Reverse Single Crochet (rsc): Insert hook into st to right, yo, pull up a lp, yo, pull through both lps on hook.

SETUP ROWS

ROW 1 (RS): With A in MR (ch 3, 3dc, ch 2, 4dc), turn. (8 dc)

ROW 2 (WS): Ch 3, 3dc in sp between first 2 dc, sk 3 dc, (3dc, ch 2, 3dc) in ch-2 sp, sk 3 dc, 3dc in sp after 3rd dc, dc in top of tch, turn. (14 dc)

ROW 3: Ch 3, 3dc in sp between first 2 dc, sk 3 dc, 3dc in sp after 3rd dc, sk 3 dc, (3dc, ch 2, 3dc) in ch-2 sp, (sk 3 dc, 3dc in sp after 3rd dc) 2 times, dc in top of tch, turn. (20 dc)

ROW 4: Ch 3, 3dc in sp between first 2 dc, sk 3 dc, (3dc in sp after 3rd dc, sk 3 dc) to ch-2 sp, (3dc, ch 2, 3dc) in ch-2 sp, (sk 3 dc, 3dc in sp after 3rd dc) to tch, dc in top of tch, turn. (26 dc)

ROWS 5-6: Rep Row 4. Cc to MC at end of Row 6. Fasten off A. (38 dc)

ROW 7 (RS): Ch 3, dc in sp between first 2 dc, dc in each dc to ch-2 sp, (dc 1, ch 2, dc 1) in ch-2 sp, dc in each dc to tch, dc in tch sp, dc in top of tch, turn. (42 dc)

ROW 8 (WS): Ch 1, sc in dc at base of ch, sc in sp between first 2 dc, sc in next st, (pc in next st, sc 3) placing last sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-2 sp, sc 2, (pc, sc 3) to last 3 dc, pc, sc 1, sc in tch sp, sc in top of tch, turn. (10 pc + 36 sc)

ROW 9: Ch 3, dc in st at base of ch, dc in each st to ch-2 sp, (dc 1, ch 2, dc 1) in ch-2 sp, dc in each st to last st, 2dc in last st, turn. Cc to B, fasten off MC. (50 dc)

WEDGES 1-2 & BORDER

Wedge 1

ROW 1 (WS): Ch 3, 3dc in sp between first 2 dc, sk 3 dc, (3dc in sp after 3rd dc, sk 3 dc) to ch-2 sp, 3dc in ch-2 sp, turn.

ROW 2 (RS): Ch 3, (sk 3 dc, 3dc in sp after 3rd dc) to tch, 3dc in sp before tch, dc in top of tch, turn.

ROW 3: Ch 3, 3dc in sp between first 2 dc, sk 3 dc, (3dc in sp after 3rd dc, sk 3 dc) across placing last 3dc in sp before tch, turn.

ROW 4: Rep Row 2.

ROWS 5-6: Rep Rows 3-4. Fasten off.

Wedge 2

ROW 1 (RS): Join C with standing dc [[TUTORIAL](#)] in the top of the tch from previous Border Row 9. Ch 3, 3dc in sp between first 2 dc, sk 3 dc, (3dc in sp after 3rd dc, sk 3 dc) to ch-2 sp, 3dc in ch-2 sp, (sk next row end, 3dc around next tch) 3 times, turn.

ROW 2 (WS): Ch 3, (sk 3 dc, 3dc in sp after 3rd dc) to tch, 3dc in sp before tch, dc in top of tch, turn.

ROW 3: Ch 3, 3dc in sp between first 2 dc, sk 3 dc, (3dc in sp after 3rd dc, sk 3 dc) across placing last 3dc in sp before tch, turn.

ROW 4: Rep Row 2.

ROWS 5-6: Rep Rows 3-4. Cc to MC, fasten off C.

Border

ROW 1 (RS): Ch 3, dc in sp between first 2 dc, dc in each dc to tch, (dc 1, ch 2, dc 1) around tch, (sk next row, 3dc around next tch) 3 times, dc in each dc to tch, dc in tch-sp, dc in top of tch, turn. (90 dc)

ROW 2 (WS): Ch 1, sc in dc at base of ch, sc in sp between first 2 dc, sc in next st, (pc in next st, sc 3) placing last sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-2 sp, sc 2, (pc, sc 3) to last 3 dc, pc, sc 1, sc in tch sp, sc in top of tch, turn. (22 pc + 72 sc)

ROW 3: Ch 3, dc in st at base of ch, dc in each st to ch-2 sp, (dc 1, ch 2, dc 1) in ch-2 sp, dc in each st to last st, 2dc in last st, turn. Cc to D, fasten off MC. (98 dc)

WEDGES 3-4 & BORDER

Rep instructions for Wedges 1-2 & Border, using D for Wedge 3 and E for Wedge 4.

WEDGES 5-6 & BORDER

Rep instructions for Wedges 1-2 & Border, using A for Wedge 5 and B for Wedge 6.

WEDGES 7-8 & BORDER

Rep instructions for Wedges 1-2 & Border, using C for Wedge 7 and D for Wedge 8.

WEDGES 9-10 & BORDER

Rep instructions for Wedges 1-2 & Border, using E for Wedge 9 and A for Wedge 10. DO NOT TURN OR FASTEN OFF after Border Row 3.

FINAL BORDER

ROW 1: With RS facing and continuing with MC, ch 1, rsc in st at base of ch, rsc in each st to ch-2 sp, 2rsc in ch-2 sp, rsc in each st across remainder of row, fasten off.

FINISHING

- Weave in all ends.
- Pin shawl with RS facing. Steam block to final dimensions.



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
