MATERIALS

5 (5, 6, 6, 7) skeins of Friends Kid Silk color 05
3 (3, 3, 3, 4) skeins of Friends Wool color 09

Needles 12 mm (US17)
Needles 10 mm (US15)

Stitch markers
Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii
72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool
25 g / 0.9 oz = 200 m / 218 yds

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii
100% Wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

7 sts x 12 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"
with 12 mm (US17) needles

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit
P = purl
St(s) = stitch(es)
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
SKPO = slip - knit - pass over
M1 = make one sts
M2 = make two sts
PO = pass over
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

SIZE

XS (S, M, L, XL)

PATTERN INFORMATION

Limone Cardigan is knitted from the bottom-up where the body is worked flat, with two strands of Friends Kid Silk and one strand of Friends Wool. It's cropped.

The sleeves are knitted flat too separately and to be sewn together, with the same strands of yarn. Perfect for intermediate knitters.

If you are in between two sizes, I recommend choosing the bigger one if you would like a more oversized fit or choosing the smaller one for a more fitted look.

Please refer to the size information with the widths and lengths noted to double check the measurements will be to your liking.

INFO AND TIPS

Follow the instructions for the size fitting your chest circumference; keep in mind the first number refers to size 1, the second to size 2 and so forth.

When there is only one number given, it means it applies to all sizes. When there is a " 0 " on your size, it means that instruction doesn't apply to your size.

A comma separates each size indication. A dash separates instructions for the same size. The word '*indications*' - repeat '**' means you have to repeat indications between asterisks across the row, if not differently subsequent specifications.

I recommend circling the number in the pattern which corresponds to the size you are making before starting to knit to prevent any confusion.

Remember a knitted garment will never be exactly the same as another. Each one is unique. It's absolutely normal measurements will be a little bit different from the ones indicated in the pattern.

When the type of needle is not specified, knit with the 12 mm / US17 needles or needles used to obtain gauge.

Remember that if you change the number of needles or stitches to match the measurements specified in the pattern or to achieve a different fit, you will need to recalculate and adjust the other pattern instructions accordingly. If you don't feel confident in performing this calculation due to your level of experience, I advise you to avoid making such modifications.

BACK

Work with 2 strands of Friends Kid Silk and 1 strand of Friends Wool.

Cast on 35 (37, 41, 45, 49) sts. Two are edge sts.

Row 1 (RS), Row 3 and Row 4: knit all sts.

Row 2 (WS): purl all sts.

Row 5 to row 40 (42, 44, 46, 48): repeat Row 1 to Row 4, ending with a Row 1 (3, 1, 3, 1), paying attention to the following decreases.

Shaping the sleeve hole:

- A. Row 15 (15, 15, 15, 17) or when the piece measures approx. 13 (13, 13, 13, 14) cm/5 (5, 5, 5, 6) in and Row 17 (17, 17, 17, 19): k2 - SKPO - knit sts until there are 4 sts remaining: k2tog - k2.

Shaping the shoulders:

- B. Row 39 (41, 43, 45, 47) or when the piece measures approx. 32.5 (34, 36, 37.5, 39) cm/ 13 (13.5, 14, 15, 15.5) in and Row 40 (42, 44, 46, 48): work 2 sts as required - 2 decreases (2 k2tog or 2 p2tog) - *work st as required* - repeat ** until there are 6 sts remaining: 2 decreases - work 2 sts as required.

Row 41 (43, 45, 47, 49): Bind off all the sts.

FRONT RIGHT

Work with 2 strands of Friends Kid Silk and 1 strand of Friends Wool.

Cast on 12 (12, 14, 16, 18) sts. One is edge st.

Row 1 (RS), Row 3 and Row 4: knit all sts.

Row 2 (WS): *purl st* - repeat ** until there is 1 st remaining: k1.

Row 5 to Row 34 (36, 38, 40, 42): repeat Row 1 to Row 4, ending with a Row 2 (3, 2, 4, 2), paying attention to the following rows.

Be sure to read all the points below before start knitting. Rows are categorized according to the purpose of the decreases, which may not always align with the numerical order.

Shaping the edge:

- C. Row 3 (5, 7, 9, 11) and Row 7 (9, 11, 13, 15) and Row 11 (13, 15, 17, 19) and Row 15 (17, 19, 21, 23) and Row 19 (21, 23, 25, 27): k2 - m1 - *knit st* - repeat **.
- D. Row 21 (23, 25, 27, 29) and Row 23 (25, 27, 29, 31): k2 - 2 SKPO - *knit st* - repeat **.
- E. Row 27 (29, 31, 33, 35) and Row 29 (31, 33, 35, 37): k2 - m2 - *knit st* - repeat **.
- F. Row 31 (33, 35, 37, 39) and Row 35 (37, 39, 41, 43): instructions as in point D.
- G. Row 32 (34, 36, 38, 40): *work st as required* - repeat ** until there are 6 sts remaining: 2 decreases (2 k2tog or 2 p2tog) - work 2 sts as required.

Shaping the sleeve hole:

- H. Row 15 (15, 15, 15, 17) and Row 17 (17, 17, 17, 19): *knit st* - repeat ** until there are 4 sts remaining: k2tog - k2.

Shaping the shoulders:

- I. Row 33 (35, 37, 39, 41): *knit st* - repeat ** until there are 6 sts remaining: 2 k2tog - k2.
- J. Row 34 (36, 38, 40, 42): work 2 sts as required - 2 decreases (2 k2tog or 2 p2tog) - *work st as required* - repeat **.

You have 5 (5, 7, 9, 11) sts on your needle.

Row 35 (37, 39, 41, 43): Bind off all the sts of the front right.

Remember that sts you have to join with the back are 9 (9, 11, 13, 15).

FRONT LEFT

Work with 2 strands of Friends Kid Silk and 1 strand of Friends Wool.

Cast on 12 (12, 14, 16, 18) sts. One is edge st.

Row 1 (RS), Row 3 and Row 4: knit all sts.

Row 2 (WS): k1- *purl st* - repeat **.

Row 5 to Row 34 (36, 38, 40, 42): repeat Row 1 to Row 4, ending with a Row 2 (3, 2, 4, 2), paying attention to the following rows.

Be sure to read all the points below before start knitting. Rows are categorized according to the purpose of the decreases, which may not always align with the numerical order.

Shaping the edge:

- K. Row 3 (5, 7, 9, 11) and Row 7 (9, 11, 13, 15) and Row 11 (13, 15, 17, 19) and Row 15 (17, 19, 21, 23) and Row 19 (21, 23, 25, 27): *knit st* - repeat ** until there are 2 sts remaining: m1 - k2.
- L. Row 21 (23, 25, 27, 29) and Row 23 (25, 27, 29, 31): * knit st* - repeat ** until there are 6 sts remaining: 2 SKPO - k2.
- M. Row 27 (29, 31, 33, 35) and Row 29 (31, 33, 35, 37): * knit st* - repeat ** until there are 2 sts remaining: m2 - k2.
- N. Row 31 (33, 35, 37, 39) and Row 35 (37, 39, 41, 43): instructions as in point L.
- O. Row 32 (34, 36, 38, 40): work 2 sts as required - 2 decreases (2 k2tog or 2 p2tog) - *work st as required* - repeat **.

Shaping the sleeve hole:

- P. Row 15 (15, 15, 15, 17) and Row 17 (17, 17, 17, 19): k2 - k2tog - *knit st* - repeat **.

Shaping the shoulders:

- Q. Row 33 (35, 37, 39, 41): k2 - 2 k2tog - *knit st* - repeat **.
- R. Row 34 (36, 38, 40, 42): *work st as required* - repeat ** until there are 6 sts remaining: 2 decreases (2 k2tog or 2 p2tog) - work 2 sts as required.

You have 5 (5, 7, 9, 11) sts on your needle.

Row 35 (37, 39, 41, 43): Bind off all the sts of the front left.

Remember that sts you have to join with the back are 9 (9, 11, 13, 15).

SLEEVES

Work with 2 strands of Friends Kid Silk and 1 strand of Friends Wool.

Cast on 36 (38, 40, 44, 44) sts. Two are edge sts.

Row 1 (RS), Row 3 and Row 4: knit all sts.

Row 2 (WS): purl all sts.

Row 5 to Row 52 (52, 52, 56, 56): repeat Row 1 to Row 4.

Change from 12 mm (US17) to 10 mm(US15) needles.

Row 53 (53, 53, 57, 57) or when the piece measures approx. 44 (44, 44, 48, 48) cm/17 (17, 17, 19, 19) in to Row 56 (56, 56, 60, 60): work in 1x1 rib stitch (*k1-p1* - repeat**).

Row 57 (57, 57, 61, 61): Bind off all the sts.
Repeat for the second sleeve.

JOIN

Join the neck by sewing the bound off edges of the fronts to the bound off edge of the back.

Join the sleeve hole by sewing 14 (14, 14, 14, 16) sts of the front left lateral side with 14 (14, 14, 14, 16) sts of the back left lateral side; do the same with the right side, as well.

Sew the side sleeve seams by stitching through the first and last stitch of each row of the sleeve.

Sew the sleeve to the body by aligning and joining all stitches of the sleeve with approximately 3/4 of the body stitches, in this way:

- SIZE 1: *sew 1 st - skip 1 st - sew 2* - repeat ** until you have 2 sts remaining: sew 2 sts.
- SIZE 2: *sew 1 st - skip 1 st - sew 2* - repeat **.
- SIZE 3: *sew 1 st - skip 1 st* - repeat ** until you have 5 sts remaining: sew 3 sts.
- SIZE 4 and SIZE 5: *sew 1 st - skip 1 st - sew 2* - repeat ** until you have 2 sts remaining: sew 1 st.

Place a length of leftover yarn (cm/in) between the first and second stitches of Row 21 (23, 25, 27, 29), and repeat the same process for Row 31 (33, 35, 37, 39). Additionally, insert another length of new leftover yarn between the last and second-to-last stitches of the same Rows. Now you'll have two loops to work with!
You can also make an [i-cord](#) string instead of using a thread of leftover yarn.
