10, 10, 10, (10), 12, 12, 18, 18, 18, 18, 18 skeins of color Nougat, 09
4, 4, 4, (4), 5, 5, 7, 7, 7, 7 skeins of color Cognac, 17
2, 2, 4, (4), 5, 5, 4, 4, 7, 7 skeins of color Mustard, 28
1, 1, 1, (1), 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2 skein(s) of color French Blue 84

Crochet hook 3.5 mm / US E/4
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii,
100 % Wool,
50 g / 1.75 oz = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

Flower square (4 rounds) = 8.5 cm x 8.5 cm
/ 3.3" x 3.3"
Cuffs (7 rounds) = 10 cm (4")

ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
dc3tog = 3 dc crochet together
fpdc = front post double crochet
bpdc = back post double crochet

PATTERN INFORMATION

This cardigan is crocheted using classic floral granny squares, creating a timeless and eye-catching design. Throughout the pattern, you'll use front post double crochet (fpdc) and back post double crochet (bpdc) stitches to create a lovely elastic tape (band) around the edges of the cardigan. As you work on each granny square, the pattern provides clear instructions on joining them together. The pattern allows you to add your personal touch to the cardigan. You can easily adjust the length of the sleeves by adding additional squares or crocheting more rows of the cuff pattern.

INFO AND TIPS

If you are between sizes please size down.

SQUARE PATTERN

With col. 28 or 07 ch 4, join with sl st to the first ch

Round 1 (col. 28 or 07): Ch 4 (counts as the first dc plus ch-1 space), * dc into the circle, ch 1 ** rep 6 times, join with sl st to top of ch 3, cut the yarn. (8 dc and 8 ch-1 spaces)

Round 2 (col. 17 or 84 or 28): Sl st in any ch-1 space, ch 2, dc2tog in same space, ch 2, * dc3tog in next ch-1 space, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of the first st, cut the yarn. (8 petals)

Round 3 (col. 09): Sl st in any ch-2 space, ch 3 (counts as the first dc), 2 dc in same space, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space ** rep twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3, cut the yarn.

NOTE: you only need one 4-rounds square. The squares are joined together while crocheting the last round of each square.

Round 4 (col. 09): Sl st in any ch-2 space (corner), ch 3 (counts as the first dc), 2 dc in same space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, 3 dc in next 2 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, 3 dc in next 2 spaces ** rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3

JOINING

How to join 2 squares:

Crochet a 4-rounds square. Connect the yarn in any corner of a 3-rounds square, ch 3 (counts as the first dc), 2 dc in same space, ch 1 (turning chain), sc in any corner of the 4-rounds square (photo 1 below),



3 dc in the same corner of the 3-rounds square, sc in next space of the 4-rounds square, (3 dc in next space of the 3-rounds square, sc in next space of the 4-rounds square) twice (photo 2 above),

3 dc in next corner of the 3-rounds square, sc in next corner of the 4-rounds square, ch 1 (turning chain), 3 dc in same corner of the 3-rounds square. (photo 3 above).

Finish the fourth round (photo 1 below). The third square join in the same way (photo 2 below).



How to join 4 squares:

Connect the yarn in any corner of the "blue flower" square, ch 3 (counts as the first dc), 2 dc in same space, ch 1 (turning chain), sc in the first corner of the "orange flower" square (photo 1 below),

3 dc in the same corner of the "blue flower", sc in next space of the "orange flower" square, (3 dc in next space of the "blue flower", sc in next space of the "orange flower" square) twice (photo 2 below),

3 dc in next corner of the "blue flower", sc in next corner of the "orange flower" square, sc in next corner of the "yellow flower" square, ch 1 (turning chain),

3 dc in the same corner of the "blue flower", sc in next space of the "yellow flower" square (photo 3 below),

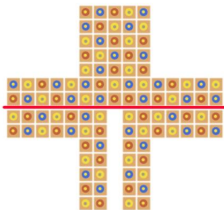
(3 dc in next space of the "blue flower", sc in next space of the "yellow flower" square) twice (photo 4 below),

3 dc in next corner of the "blue flower", sc in next corner of the "yellow flower" square, ch 1 (turning chain), 3 dc in same corner of the "blue flower". (photo 5 below) Finish the fourth round (photo 6 below).

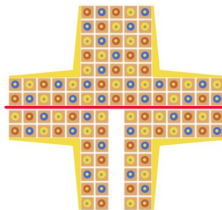


Join all the squares according to the scheme:

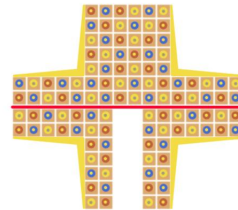
2XS-XS



S-M



L-XL



2XL-3XL



4XL-5XL



How many flowers you will need:

Size	Mustard (28) flower, Dune (07) center	Cognac (17) flower, Mustard (28) center	French Blue (84) flower, Mustard (28) center
2XS-XS	33 squares	35 squares	33 squares
S-M	33 squares	35 squares	33 squares
L-XL	37 squares	37 squares	36 squares
2XL-3XL	60 squares	57 squares	55 squares
4XL-5XL	60 squares	57 squares	55 squares

NOTE: don't crochet side rows in 2XS, XS, 2XL, 3XL sizes.

SIDE ROWS

(across sleeves and sides)

Connect the yarn to the bottom (ch-2 space) of the right side of the back part (when wearing the cardigan - see the first photo below), or/and

Connect the yarn to the bottom (ch-2 space) of the left side of the front part (when wearing the cardigan - see the first photo below).

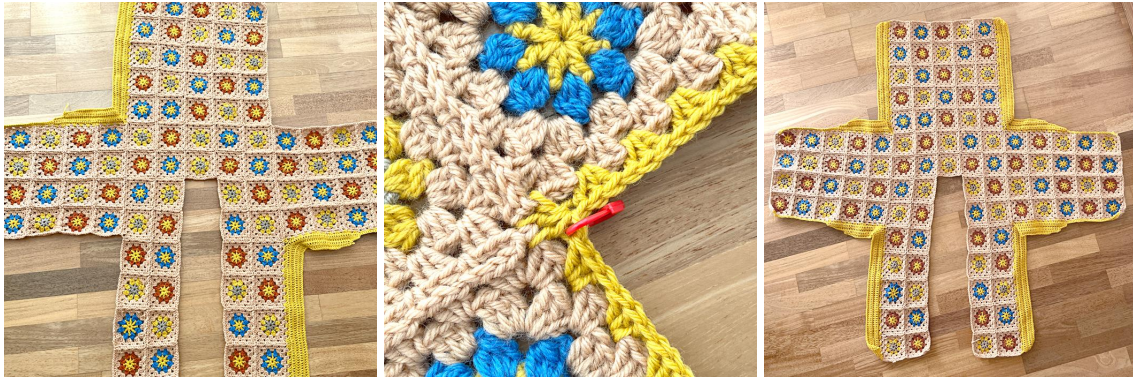
Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), 3 dc in each space and each ch-2 space to the armhole, dc3tog in the corner (through 3 corners of 3 squares - see the second photo below), 3 dc in each space to the half of the sleeve (in next 11 spaces), 3 sc in each space to the last ch-2 space, sc in the last ch-2 space.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc, dc in each dc to the end of the row.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), turn, dc in each dc to the last 5 dc, sc in next 4 dc, sl st in the last dc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sl st in next 4 sts, sc in next st, dc in each st to the end of the row.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), turn, dc in each dc to the last 5 dc, sc in next 4 dc, sl st in the last dc.



Connect the yarn to the bottom (ch-2 space) of the right sleeve of the front part (when wearing the cardigan - see the third photo above), or/and
 Connect the yarn to the bottom (ch-2 space) of the left sleeve of the back part (when wearing the cardigan - see the third photo above).

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same space, 3 sc in next 11 spaces (in each space and ch-2 space), 3 dc in each space and each ch-2 space to the armhole, dc3tog in the corner (through 3 corners of 3 squares), 3 dc in each space to the last ch-2 space, dc in the last ch-2 space.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), turn, dc in each dc to the last dc, sl st in the last dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 dc, dc in each dc to the end of the row.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), turn, dc in each dc to the last 5 dc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 5 dc, dc in each dc to the end of the row.

Fold the cardi as you can see on the photo below and make sleeves and side seams from the wrong side with sl st.



CUFFS

Round 1: Connect the yarn to any cuff, ch 3 (counts as the first dc), dc in each dc around, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 2: Ch 2 (counts as the first stitch), * fpdc in next dc, bpdC in next dc ** rep from * to ** around, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

Round 3-4: Ch 2 (counts as the first stitch), * fpdc in next fpdc, bpdC in next bpdC ** rep from * to ** around, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

Round 5: Ch 2 (counts as the first stitch), * fpdc2tog in next 2 fpdc, (bpdC in next bpdC, fpdc in next fpdc) 3 times, bpdC in next bpdC ** rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

Round 6: Ch 2 (counts as the first stitch), * fpdc in next fpdc, bpdC in next bpdC ** rep from * to ** around, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

Round 7: Ch 1, sl st in each st around, join with sl st to the first ch

FRONT PART

Row 1: Connect the yarn to the bottom corner of the front part (right corner when wearing the cardigan), ch 3 (counts as the first dc), dc in each dc to the left bottom corner.

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, * fpdc in next dc, bpdC in next dc ** rep from * to ** to the end of the row

Row 3-6: Ch 2 (counts as the first stitch), * fpdc in next fpdc, bpdC in next bpdC ** rep from * to ** to the end of the row.

BOTTOM

Row 1: Connect the yarn to the left corner of the bottom (left corner when wearing the cardigan), ch 3 (counts as the first dc), dc in each dc to the end of the row.

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, * fpdc in next dc, bpdC in next dc ** rep from * to ** to the end of the row

Row 3-6: Ch 2 (counts as the first stitch), * fpdc in next fpdc, bpdC in next bpdC ** rep from * to ** to the end of the row.
