MATERIALS

1 skein of Flash It color 02 – Yarn A 1 skein of Flash It color 01 – Yarn B 1 skein of Flash It color 04 – Yarn C 1 skein of Flash It color 06 – Yarn D

Straight needle 6 mm (US 10) & 5 mm (US 8) Stuffing

YARN QUALITY

Flash It, Hobbii
 80% Viscose, 20% Metallic fiber
 50 g (1.75 oz) = 90 m (98 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 14 sts x 24 rows

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 16 cm / 6.3" with the loop Width: 9 cm / 3.54"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Great Christmas decoration to make your tree look very special. The Christmas pudding is knitted flat in different parts then stuffed and sewn together.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit P = Purl St(s) = Stitch(es) C/on = Cast on C/off = Cast off Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work Pf&b = Purl in the front and then around the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the front of the work K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together P2tog = Purl the next two stitches together K3tog = Knit the next three stitches together SL1 = Slip one stitch to the right needle PSSO = Pass the slip stitch over

PUDDING

C/on 18 sts with yarn A and 6 mm (US 10) needles

Row 1 – P row Row 2 – (K2, Kf&b) x 6 (24 sts) Row 3 – P row Row 4 – (K3, Kf&b) x 6 (30 sts) Row 5 – P row Row 6 – (K4, Kf&b) x 6 (36 sts) Row 7 – P row Row 8 – K row Repeat the last 2 rows 6 times

Row 21 – P row Row 22 – (K4, K2tog) x 6 (30 sts) Row 23 – P row Row 24 – (K3, K2tog) x 6 (24 sts)



Row 25 – P row Row 26 – (K2, K2tog) x 6 (18 sts) Row 27 – P row Row 28 – (K1, K2tog) x 6 (12 sts) Row 29 – (K2tog) x 6 (6 sts)

Thread through all 6 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

ICING

C/on 18 sts with yarn B and 6 mm (US 10) needles

Row 1 – P row Row 2 – (K2, Kf&b) x 6 (24 sts) Row 3 – P row Row 4 – (K3, Kf&b) x 6 (30 sts) Row 5 – P row Row 6 – (K4, Kf&b) x 6 (36 sts) Row 7 – P row

Let's start working each drip of icing one at a time:

Row 8 – K5, TURN, P5, TURN, K2tog, K3, TURN, (P4, TURN, K4, TURN) x 2, P4, TURN, (K2tog) x 2, TURN, P2, TURN, (Kf&b) x 2, TURN, P4 Thread through all 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Row 9 – Re-join the yarn, K4, TURN, P4, TURN, (K2tog) x 2, TURN C/off both sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Row 10 – Re-join the yarn, K8, TURN, P8, TURN, c/off 5, K2, TURN, P1, P2tog, TURN C/off both sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Row 11 – Re-join the yarn, K8, TURN, P8, TURN, K2tog, K4, K2tog, TURN, P6, TURN, K2tog, K4, TURN, P5 Thread through all 5 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Row 12 – Re-join the yarn and c/off the next 5 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Row 13 – Re-join the yarn, K5, TURN, P6 (including the st left on the right needle), TURN, K2tog, K2, K2tog, TURN, P2, P2tog, TURN, K3tog C/off the last st, cut the yarn and make secure

BERRY (MAKE 3)

C/on 4 sts with yarn C and 5 mm (US 8) needles



Row 1 – Kf&b, K2, Kf&b (6 sts) Row 2 – P row Row 3 – Kf&b, K4, Kf&b (8 sts) Row 4 – P row Row 5 – K2tog, K4, K2tog (6 sts) Row 6 – P row Row 7 – K2tog, K2, K2tog (4 sts)

Thread through all 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

LEAF (MAKE 2)

C/on 3 sts with yarn D and 5 mm (US 8) needles

Row 1 – K row Row 2 – P row Row 3 – (Kf&b) x 3 (6 sts) Row 4 – P2, Pf&b, P3 (7 sts) Row 5 – C/off 2 sts and K to the end of the row (5 sts) Row 6 – C/off 2 sts and P to the end of the row (3 sts) Repeat the last 4 rows one more time

Row 11 – K row Row 12 – SL1, P2tog, PSSO

C/off the last st, cut the yarn and make secure

LOOP

C/on 3 sts with yarn B and 5 mm (US 8) needles

Row 1 – K row Row 2 – Move all the sts back on the left needle and K the row

Repeat those 2 rows until your lcord measure 18 cm / 7.09"

C/off all 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Sew the back edge of the pudding and stuff as you go along. Place the icing on the top keeping in mind which bit of the icing you want in the front by having the pudding seam at the back.

Fix the icing in place by sewing it all along the edges on the pudding.



Thread through all around the edge of the berries and pull them in a ball, stuff them very lightly and fix them to the pudding.

Add the two leaves at the back but leave a small space between the berries and the leaves for the loop.

Fold the loop and fix it at the top of the pudding right in the middle.

Weave in all ends
