# **Jumbo Tweed**

**Stocking**

#### **MATERIALS**

### **Tweed Delight**

2 skeins of color 08 – Yarn A 2 skeins of color 03 – Yarn B 2 skeins of color 16 – Yarn C

Circular needle 10 mm (US 15) – 40 cm long Straight needle 6 mm (US 10) Wave Pompon Maker Tapestry needle 3 stitch markers

#### YARN QUALITY

**Tweed Delight**, Hobbii 85% Wool, 10% Acrylic, 5% Viscose 50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 11 sts x 16 rows

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

PM = Place marker

SM = Slide marker

RM = Remove marker

M1 = Make one stitch using the left needle and pick up the yarn before the next stitch from the front and knit it into the back

#### SIZE

One size

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Height: 44 cm / 17.32"

Width: 40 cm / 15.75" Heel to toes

#### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

The Jumbo tweed - stocking is a giant, unique and very special Christmas stocking you can keep for years to come.

The stocking is knitted in the round all the way with 2 strands of the same yarn. The loop, string and both pompoms are added at the end using the rest of the yarn.

#### **STOCKING**

You are going to start working in the round with your 10mm (US 15) needle until the end of the stocking, PM at the end of the first round and make sure not to twist when joining

C/on 60 sts with 2 strands of yarn A and 10mm (US 15) needle

Round 1 – K round Round 2 – P round

Repeat the first 2 rounds 11 times more

#### Change to 2 strands of yarn B

Round 25 - K round

Repeat the last round 9 times

Round 35 - P round

Round 36 – K round

## Change to 2 strands of yarn C

Round 37 - K round

Round 38 - P round

Repeat the last 2 rounds once

Round 41 – (K2, P2) repeat to the end of the row

Repeat the last round 6 times

Change to 2 strands of yarn A

Round 48 – K round

Round 49 - P round

Repeat the last 2 rounds once

Round 52 - K round

Repeat the last round 4 times

#### Change to 2 strands of yarn C

Round 57 - K round

Round 58 - (K1, P1) repeat to the end of the row



Round 59 – (P1, K1) repeat to the end of the row Repeat the last 2 rounds twice

#### Change to 2 strands of yarn B

Round 64 – K round

Round 65 - P round

Repeat the last 2 rounds twice

Round 70 - K20, PM, (K2, M1) x 10, PM, K20 (70 sts)

Round 71 - P round and SM

Round 72 – K20, SM, (K1, M1) x 30, SM, K20 (100 sts)

Round 73 – P round and RM

#### Change to 2 strands of yarn A

Round 74 - (K1, P1) repeat to the end of the row

Round 75 - (P1, K1) repeat to the end of the row

Round 76 – (K1, P1) repeat to the end of the row

#### Change to 2 strands of yarn C

Round 77 – K round

Repeat the last round twice

# Change to 2 strands of yarn B

Round 80 - K round

Repeat the last round twice

#### Change to 2 strands of yarn C

Round 83 - K round

Repeat the last round twice

C/off all sts with yarn C very loosely, cut the yarn and make secure. Sew the bottom of the stocking.

#### LOOP

C/on 5 sts with 2 strands of yarn C and your 6mm (US 10) needle Work an Icord as follow:

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 – Slip all your sts back on your left needle and K row

Repeat the last 2 rows until your Icord measure 18 cm / 7.09" long

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

#### **STRING**

C/on 3 sts with 2 strands of yarn B and your 6mm (US 10) needle, leave a long tail Work an Icord as follow:

Row 1 - K row



Row 2 – Slip all your sts back on your left needle and K row Repeat the last 2 rows until your lcord measure 50 cm / 19.69" long

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and leave a long tail, make secure You will use the 2 long tails to attach your pompoms

# **POMPOM (MAKE 2)**

Use all of your left-over yarn and split them into 2 equal balls by mixing up the colours

Make 2 pompoms, the ones in the pictures are 8 cm / 3.15" diameter

#### **FINISHING**

Fold down the top of the stocking and fix it in place by sewing your loop folded in two at the side.

Pass and attach the string through the loop, then fix both pompoms at each end of the strings with the long tails.

Weave in all ends
