# Baby Elf

## Decoration Mittens

Design: Au Bout du Pré | Hobbii Design




## MATERIALS

1 skein of Amigo color A28 – Yarn A  
1 skein of Amigo color A01 – Yarn B  
1 skein of Amigo color A42 – Yarn C

Straight needle 4 mm (US 6)  
Stitch holder  
2 Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Amigo**, Hobbii  
100% HB acrylic  
50 g (1.8 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 25 sts x 36 rows

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Height: 11 cm – 4.33"  
Width: 9 cm – 3.54" with the thumb

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Adorable little elf mittens. Make them with a string and use them as an adorable decoration for the tree. Or leave out the string and use the mittens for your little one. The lovely mittens are knitted flat all the way, the fringe and the string are knitted separately and sewn to the mittens at the end.

# Pattern



## ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

M = Marker

PM = Place marker

SM = Slide marker

RM = Remove marker

M1 = Make one stitch using the left needle and pick up the yarn before the next stitch from the front and knit it into the back

Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

## LEFT MITTEN

C/on 24 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat to the end of the row

Repeat the first row 9 more times

Row 11 – K3, (M1, K2) x 10, K1 (34 sts)

Row 12 – P row

Change to yarn B

Row 13 – K13, PM, K5, PM, K16

Row 14 – P row and SM

Change to yarn A

Row 15 – K to the M, SM, M1, K to the next M, M1, SM, K to the end of the row (36 sts)

Row 16 – P row and SM

Change to yarn B

Row 17 – Kf&b, K to the last st and SM, Kf&b (38 sts)

Row 18 – P row and SM

Repeat the last 4 rows 2 more times (46 sts)

Change to yarn A

Row 27 – K to the M, SM, M1, K to the next M, M1, SM, K to the end of the row (48 sts)

Row 28 – P row and SM

Change to yarn B

Row 29 – K to the M, pick up 2 sts, RM, move the sts between the two M on the stitch holder (that will be the thumb), RM, c/on 2 (tighten together the sts at this point to avoid a gap), K to the end of the row (39 sts)

Row 30 – P row

Change to yarn A

Row 31 – K row

Row 32 – P row

Change to yarn B

Row 33 – K2tog, K16, K2tog, K17, K2tog (36 sts)

Row 34 – P row

Change to yarn A

Row 35 – K2tog, K14, (K2tog) x 2, K14, K2tog (32 sts)

Row 36 – P row

Change to yarn B

Row 37 – K2tog, K12, (K2tog) x 2, K12, K2tog (28 sts)

Row 38 – P row

Change to yarn A

Row 39 – (K2tog) x 14 (14 sts)

Row 40 – P row

Change to yarn B

Row 41 – (K2tog) x 7 (7 sts)

C/off all 7 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

### **Thumb**

Rejoin the 13 sts from the stitch holder with yarn B

Next row – K row

Next row – P row

Change to yarn A

Next row – (K2tog, K2) x 3, K1 (10 sts)

Next row – P row

Change to yarn B

Next row – (K2tog, K1) x 3, K1 (7 sts)

Next row – P row

Change to yarn A

Next row – (K2tog) x 2, K1, K2tog (4 sts)

Thread through the last 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## **RIGHT MITTEN**

C/on 24 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat to the end of the row

Repeat the first row 9 times

Row 11 – K3, (M1, K2) x 10, K1 (34 sts)

Row 12 – P row

Change to yarn B

Row 13 – K16, PM, K5, PM, K13

Row 14 – P row and SM

Change to yarn A

Row 15 – K to the M, SM, M1, K to the next M, M1, SM, K to the end of the row (36 sts)

Row 16 – P row and SM

Change to yarn B

Row 17 – Kf&b, K to the last st and SM, Kf&b (38 sts)

Row 18 – P row and SM

Repeat the last 4 rows 2 more times (46 sts)

Change to yarn A

Row 27 – K to the M, SM, M1, K to the next M, M1, SM, K to the end of the row (48 sts)

Row 28 – P row and SM

Change to yarn B

Row 29 – K to the M, pick up 2 sts, RM, move the sts between the two M on the stitch holder (that will be the thumb), RM, c/on 2 (tighten together the sts at this point to avoid a gap), K to the end of the row (39 sts)

Row 30 – P row

Change to yarn A

Row 31 – K row

Row 32 – P row

Change to yarn B

Row 33 – K2tog, K16, K2tog, K17, K2tog (36 sts)

Row 34 – P row

Change to yarn A

Row 35 – K2tog, K14, (K2tog) x 2, K14, K2tog (32 sts)

Row 36 – P row

Change to yarn B

Row 37 – K2tog, K12, (K2tog) x 2, K12, K2tog (28 sts)

Row 38 – P row

Change to yarn A

Row 39 – (K2tog) x 14 (14 sts)

Row 40 – P row

Change to yarn B

Row 41 – (K2tog) x 7 (7 sts)

C/off all 7 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

### **Thumb**

Rejoin the 13 sts from the stitch holder with yarn B

Next row – K row

Next row – P row

Change to yarn A

Next row – (K2tog, K2) x 3, K1 (10 sts)

Next row – P row

Change to yarn B

Next row – (K2tog, K1) x 3, K1 (7 sts)

Next row – P row

Change to yarn A

Next row – (K2tog) x 2, K1, K2tog (4 sts)

Thread through the last 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## FRINGE (MAKE 2)

C/on 3 sts with yarn C

Row 1 – K2, Kf&b (4 sts)

Row 2 – Kf&b, K3 (5 sts)

Row 3 – K4, Kf&b (6 sts)

Row 4 – K2tog, K4 (5 sts)

Row 5 – K3, K2tog (4 sts)

Row 6 – K2tog, K2 (3 sts)

Repeat these 6 rows 10 times

C/off the remaining 3 st, cut the yarn and make secure

## STRING

C/on 4 sts with yarn C

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – Slip all the sts back on the left needle and K the row

Repeat those 2 rows until your lcord measure 70 cm / 27.56"

C/off all 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## FINISHING UP

Sew the two sides of the mittens together as well as the thumb side edges.

Place the fringe at the wrist level and sew it into place.

Attach both ends of the string on the outside of the mittens at the side under the fringe.

Weave in all ends

Note! Don't add the string if you are planning to use the mittens for your baby!
