## MATERIALS

5 (5, 6, 6) 7, 9 skeins of Friends Kid Silk col.  
2

1 (1, 1, 1) 1, 1 skein of Friends Kid Silk col.  
52

1 (1, 1, 1) 1, 1 skein of Friends Kid Silk col.  
110

Crochet hooks 3.5 mm (US E/4) and 4.0 mm  
(US G/6)

Darning needle

Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii

72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool

25 g / 0.9 oz. = 200 m / 218 yds

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 17.5 sts x 10 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = chain

Sl st = slip stitch

Sc = single crochet

Dc = double crochet

Puff = (yo, insert into st, pull up a loop)5x,  
yarn over and pull through all loops, ch1

V-st = dc, ch 2, dc

Picot = ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook

blo = back loop only

bor = beginning of the round

ss = stitch marker

sc3tog = crochet 3 single crochet together

## SIZE

XS (S, M, L) XL, 2XL

## MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 38 (43, 46, 53) 58, 61cm/15" (17", 18",  
21") 23", 24"

**Length:** 41 (43, 47, 48) 50, 53 cm/16.5" (17",  
18.5", 19") 19.5", 21"

This Christmastide sweater is made with two panels, bottom-up then sewn together.

It is made with an elegant lace pattern on the sleeves and has beautiful color details on the neckline and cuffs

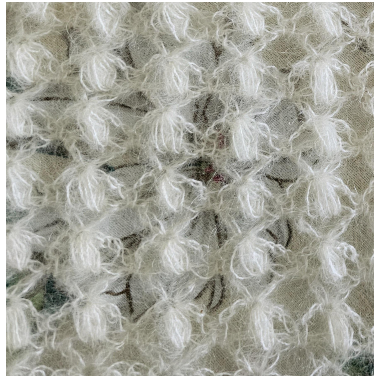

# Pattern



## BODY

### BACK PANEL

#### (Worked Flat)

Using a 4mm(US G/6) hook

Ch 66 (74, 78, 92) 100, 106 sts

**Row 1:** dc in the 3rd ch and in each st across, turn

**Row 2:** ch 2, dc in the same st and in each st across, turn

Repeat Row 2 until the garment measures 25 (25, 28, 28) 28, 30cm/10" (10", 11", 11") 11", 12"

Do not cut yarn, continue to sleeve shaping.

### SLEEVE SHAPING - BACK

Sl st in the next 3 (5, 7, 11) 11, 13 sts, ch 2, dc in same st and across, leaving last 2 (4, 6, 10) 10, 12 sts unworked, turn

**Row 1:** ch 2, dc in same st and each st across, turn

REPEAT round 1 until the sleeve edge measures

17 (18, 19, 21) 22, 23 cm/ 6.5" (7", 7.5", 8") 8.5", 9" from sl st edge.

Do not cut yarn continue below

### SHOULDER SHAPING - BACK

#### 1st Shoulder

**Row 1:** ch 2, dc in the same st and in the next 17 (18, 18, 18) 21, 22 sts, turn

Repeat row 1 until it measures 19 (20, 22, 23) 24, 25 cm/7.5" (8", 8.5", 9") 9.5", 10" from the sl st edge.

Cut a long tail for sewing together.

#### 2nd Shoulder

Attach yarn in the 18 (19, 19, 19) 22, 23 st from the edge, ch 2, and dc in the same st and each st to end, turn

Row 1: ch 2, dc in the same st and in the next 17 (18, 18, 18) 21, 22 sts, turn,

Repeat row 1 until it measures 19 (20, 22, 23) 24, 25cm/7.5" (8", 8.5", 9") 9.5", 10" from the sl st edge.



Cut a long tail for sewing together.

## FRONT PANEL

### (Worked Flat)

Using a 4mm(US G/6) hook

Ch 66 (74, 78, 92) 100, 106 sts

**Row 1:** dc in the 3rd ch and in each st across, turn

**Row 2:** ch 2, dc in the same st and in each st across, turn

Repeat Row 2 until the garment measures 25 (25, 28, 28) 28, 30cm/10" (10", 11", 11") 11", 12"

Do not cut yarn, continue to sleeve shaping.

## SLEEVE SHAPING - FRONT

Sl st in the next 3 (5, 7, 11) 11, 13 sts, ch 2, dc in same st and across, leaving last 2 (4, 6, 10) 10, 12 sts unworked, turn

**Row 1:** ch 2, dc in same st and each st to the end, turn

REPEAT row 1 until the sleeve edge measures 15 (16, 18, 19) 20, 22 cm/6" (6.5", 7", 7.5") 8", 8.5" from sl st edge.

Do not cut yarn continue below

## SHOULDER SHAPING - FRONT

### 1st Shoulder

Row 1: ch 2, dc in the same st and in the next 17 (18, 18, 18) 21, 22 sts, turn

Repeat row 1 until it measures 19 (20, 22, 23) 24,25cm/7.5" (8", 8.5", 9") 9.5", 10" from the sl st edge.

Cut a long tail for sewing together.

### 2nd Shoulder

Attach yarn in the 17 (18, 18, 18) 21, 22 st from the edge, ch 2, and dc in the same st and each st to end, turn

Row 1: ch 2, dc in the same st and in the next 18 (19, 19, 19) 22, 23 sts, turn,

Repeat row 1 until it measures 19 (20, 22, 23) 24, 25cm/7.5" (8", 8.5", 9") 9.5", 10" from the sl st edge.

Cut a long tail for sewing together.

## CONSTRUCTION

**Shoulders:** With right sides facing together and using the long tails from shoulders sc across shoulder edges together.

**Arm Holes:** Attach yarn in 1st row before sleeve shaping and sc down side of the garment. Repeat for the opposite side. Turn your garment right side out.

## SLEEVES

### (Worked Flat)

Using a 3.5 mm (US E/4) hook

Ch 73 (77, 81, 85) 89, 93 sts, sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across to the end, turn

**Row 1:** ch 2, (dc, ch 2, dc) in the same st, \*skip next 3 sts, V-st in the next st, REPEAT from \* to end, dc in last st, turn

**Row 2:** ch 2, dc in the same st, ch 1, in the center of the 1st V-st, work a puff st, ch 3, \*sc between the 2 V-sts, Ch 2, work a puff st in the middle of the next V-st, ch 3, REPEAT to end, ch 1, dc in last st, turn

**Row 3:** ch 2, dc in the same st, V-st on ch on top of next puff, \*skip to next puff & V-st on ch on top, REPEAT from \* to end, dc in last st

REPEAT rows 2-3 until the sleeve measures 30 (33, 33, 36) 36, 38 cm/ 12" (13", 13", 14) 14", 15" from the edge and ending in row 3. DO NOT CUT YARN, sl st in opposite edge connecting sleeve in the round & continue below....

**Round 1(decreasing):** ch 1, sc in same st, \*1 sc in the ch 2 space, 1 sc in between 2 V-st, REPEAT from \* around to last st, sc, sl st in ch 1 of bor.

**Round 2:** ch 1, sc in the same st, sc in each st around, sl st in ch 1 of bor.

\*Try on the sleeve, and if more decreases are wanted, work a Round of sc decreases and decrease until the desired fit.

Don't cut the yarn. Continue below.

## CUFF

**(Worked Back and Forth)**

Ch 25 (25, 25, 31) 31, 31 sts, turn

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in the blo of the next 2 sts, turn.

**Row 2:** sc in blo of each st across to the end, ch 1, turn

**Row 3:** sc in blo of each st across to end, sl st in the blo of the next 2 sts, turn.

Repeat rows 2-3 around the last st around then, sl st both edges together.

Cut yarn and sew in ends.

## SLEEVE CONSTRUCTION

Line up the bottom edges of the sleeve and place a sm connecting each sleeve edge to the body of the sweater. Working with a mattress st, sew panels together creating ruffles as you get closer to the top as you should have about an inch/2.5cm of extra length. Pictured above.

REPEAT for 2nd sleeve.

## HOLLY BORDER

(Worked in the Round)

### Collar

Use a 3.5 mm (US E/4) hook

Attach the green yarn to the collar's center back, ensuring you end with an even number of sts and ch 1 continue below...

**Round 1:** sc in blo same st, \*sc in blo each st to last st before the corner, sc3tog in blo the next 3 sts, REPEAT from \* 3 more times, sc in blo to bor, sl st in top of ch 1.

**Round 2:** sl st into front loop of 1st st, continuing to work in the front loops for the rest of the round, ch 1, sc in same st, \*ch 3, sl st in the 3rd chain from hook, sc in the next 2 sts, REPEAT from \*to end, sc in last st, sl st in top of ch 1, then, sl st into back loop

**Round 3:** working in back loops only for the rest of the round, ch 2, dc in same st, ch 1, skip next st, \*dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, REPEAT from \* to end, sl st in top of ch 2.

Cut green yarn and sew in the ends.

Attach pink yarn in 1st dc of last round, ch 1

**Round 1:** sc in same st, \*ch 2, puff st into 1st ch 1 space, ch 2, sc in next dc, REPEAT from \* to end, sl st in top of ch 1.

Cut pink yarn and sew in the ends.

Now you will reattach green yarn to the flo of round 1 in the center of the back, using a 3.5 mm (US E/4) hook.

**Round 1:** ch 1, sl st in each flo st of Round 1 around, sl st in top of ch 1.

## SLEEVE

Use a 4mm(US G/6) hook.

Attach green yarn to the sleeve's center, ensuring you end with an even number of sts and ch 1 continue below...

**Round 1:** sc in same st, \*sc in each st around, sl st in ch 1 of bor.

**Round 2:** sl st into front loop of 1st st, continuing to work in the front loops for the rest of the round, ch 1, sc in same st, \*ch 3, sl st in the 3rd chain from hook, sc in the next 2 sts, REPEAT from \*to end, sc in last st, sl st in top of ch 1, then, sl st into back loop

Attach pink yarn in the blo of the 1st st of last round, ch 1

**Round 1:** sc in same st, \*, puff st into the next st\*\*, sc in next st, REPEAT from \* to\*\* end, sl st in top of ch 1.

Cut pink yarn and sew in the ends.
