# **Christmas Trees Trio**

## **Ornament**

## MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4, as **yarn A:**

1 x Oatmilk [03]

1 x Pink [47]

1 x Baby Blue [75]

1 x Capri Blue [90]

Glitter Deluxe 30g, as **yarn B:**

1 x Cobalt Blue [18130]

1 x Pink [18132]

Cocktail Deluxe, as **yarn C:**

1 x Jeans Blue [17543]

1 x Hot Pink [17549]

Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E/4)

Scissor

Yarn needle

Hobbii Colored bells:

4 x 14 mm

2 x 10 mm

### Optional - for stiffening:

White PVA glue and soft brush

Pins and blocking board or foam tiles

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100% cotton

50 g / 1.7 oz = 160 m / 175 yds

**Glitter Deluxe**, Go Handmade

100 % polyester

30 g / 1.1 oz = 1800-2100 m /1950-2300 yds

 **Cocktail Deluxe**, Go Handmade

100% polyester

25 g / 0.9 oz. = 90 m / 98 yds

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 5.5 cm / 2.2 "

Length: 12.5 cm / 4.9" (without loop)

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

I made two sets of these trees: a pink one and a blue one.

In the pink set, yarn A are: Oatmilk, Pink and Baby Blue, while yarn B is Pink and yarn C is Hot Pink.

In the Blue set, yarn A are: Oatmilk, Capri Blue and Baby Blue, while yarn B is Cobalt Blue and yarn C is Jeans Blue.

When working the triangle for the tree, you are using two threads together: yarn A and yarn B.

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sl st (s) = slip stitch (es)

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

dc2tog = double crochet two together

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

## TREE

Using a 3.5mm hook and both **yarn A** and **yarn B**, chain 12.

**Row 1 (RS):** 2ch (doesn't count as a st here and throughout), 12dc, turn. [12 sts]

**Row 2 (WS):** 2ch, 10dc, dc2tog, turn. [11 sts]

**Row 3:** 2ch, 9dc, dc2tog, turn. [10 sts]

**Row 4:** 2ch, 8dc, dc2tog, turn. [9 sts]

**Row 5:** 2ch, 7dc, dc2tog, turn. [8 sts]

**Row 6:** 2ch, 6dc, dc2tog, turn. [7 sts]

**Row 7:** 2ch, 5dc, dc2tog, turn. [6 sts]

**Row 8:** 2ch, 4dc, dc2tog, turn. [5 sts]

**Row 9:** 2ch, 3dc, dc2tog, turn. [4 sts]

**Row 10:** 2ch, 2dc, dc2tog, turn. [3 sts]

**Row 11:** 2ch, 1dc, dc2tog, turn. [2 sts]

**Row 12:** 2ch, dc2tog, turn. [1 st]

When on the RS, chain 26 to make the hanging loop, sl st in top of the last dc2tog and fasten off.

If your intention is to make a bunting of trees, you may avoid the hanging loop.

### Trunk

Turn the tree upside-down, RS facing you.

Use **yarn C**.

**Row 1 (RS):** 4sl st along tree bottom, 1ch (doesn't count as a st here and throughout), 4sc, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** 1ch, 4sc, turn.

**Rows 3-4:** as row 2

**Row 5:** 1ch, 4sc, rotate and work 4 sl sts along trunk side, 4 sl st along tree bottom, fasten off.

Weave ends in.

Knot a 14 mm bell to the tree top, using a matching yarn A.

Knot a 10 mm bell to the top of the tree with tinsel, still using yarn A.

Trim the excess of yarn in the back.





## TINSEL

Even this time, keep the tree upside-down and RS facing you.

You are still using **yarn C**, but the colour you didn't choose for the trunk!

We are working five bands of tinsel in between rows.

**Between rows 2 and 3:** sl st in top of first st, 13ch, sl st around top of middle st, 13ch, sl st in top of last st, fasten off.

**Between rows 4 and 5:** sl st in top of first st, 11ch, sl st around top of middle st, 11ch, sl st in top of last st, fasten off.

**Between rows 6 and 7:** sl st in top of first st, 9ch, sl st around top of middle st, 9ch, sl st in top of last st, fasten off.

**Between rows 8 and 9:** sl st in top of first st, 7ch, sl st around top of middle st, 7ch, sl st in top of last st, fasten off.

**Between rows 10 and 11:** sl st in top of first st, 5ch, sl st around top of middle st, 5ch, sl st in top of last st, fasten off.

Weave in all ends.



### STIFFENING - OPTIONAL

Prepare a solution made 50% of water and 50% of white PVA glue.

Pin the ornament (WS facing you) on a blocking board or foam blocks.

With the help of a soft brush spread the solution on the ornament and let it dry completely before decorating the halls or the Christmas tree.
