MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein of color 4

1 skein of color 41

1 skein of color 66

1 skein of color 72

1 skein of color 90

1 skein of color 104

Crochet hook 3.0 mm (US D/3) Filling 100 g - Hobbii Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

22 sts x 10 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

st = stitch

sp = space

ss = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

cc = change color

blo = back loop only

[] denote that the stitches are worked into

the same stitch

{} denote that the stitches are repeated

later in the round

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 7.6 cm / 3" Length: 10 cm / 4"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is inspired by striped candies, and includes three ornaments: a striped one, a peppermint, and a small peppermint. The front and back sides of the ornaments are identical, so they are simple to join. A small amount of filling is placed inside the ornaments. The pattern includes pictures to explain how to change color and join the ornaments.

INFO AND TIPS

These ornaments use tapestry crochet to change color within the round to create a striped candy, a peppermint, and a small peppermint. The front and back sides of the ornaments are identical, so it is simple to join them. They are joined with a single crochet stitch, and a small amount of filling is placed inside.









How to Change Color

When the pattern says, "cc to", use the new color to complete the final "yarn over, pull through" of the st that comes before it (pictures 1 and 2). Then, hold the previous color against the back of the work while crocheting with the new color (picture 3). When it is time to change color again, use the previous color to complete the final "yarn over, pull through" of the st that comes before the color change, and then, hold the other color against the back of the work (picture 4).



STRIPED ORNAMENT

A refers to the background color, and B refers to the color of the stripes. I made two ornaments: one with color 72 (purple) for the stripes and one with color 90 (blue). I used color 4 (cream) for the background color for both.

Front side

With yarn A, begin with the magic circle.

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc throughout), 11 hdc into the magic circle. Close the magic circle, and ss into the top of the ch 2. (12).

Round 2: [Ch 3 (counts as the first dc throughout), dc], [dc, cc to B, dc, cc to A]. { [2 dc], [dc, cc to B, dc, cc to A] }. Repeat {} 4 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 3. (24).

Round 3: [Ch 3, dc], cc to B, dc, cc to A. { [2 dc], cc to B, dc, cc to A}. Repeat {} 10 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 3. (36).

Round 4: [Ch 3, dc], dc, cc to B, dc, cc to A. { [2 dc], dc, cc to B, dc, cc to A}. Repeat {} 10 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 3 and fasten off. (48).

Back side

Follow the same instructions as the front side.

Joining

See below for the joining instructions.

PEPPERMINT ORNAMENT

A refers to the background color, and B refers to the peppermint color. I made two ornaments. I used color 4 (cream) for A and colors 41 and 104 (red and green) for B. You could also use different colors to create lollipop inspired ornaments with this pattern.

Front side

With yarn A, begin with a magic circle.

Round 1: 6 sc into the magic circle. Close the magic circle. Ss into the first sc, and fasten off. (6).

Round 2: Join yarn B into any st of the previous round. [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), 2 sc]. [2 sc] into each of the following sts. Then, ss into the first sc. (12).

Round 3: [Ch 2 (counts as first hdc throughout), hdc]. {Cc to A. [2 hdc]. Cc to B. [2 hdc] }.

Repeat {} 4 more times. Cc to A. [2 hdc]. Cc to B. Ss into the top of the ch 2. (24).

Round 4: [Ch 2, hdc], hdc. {Cc to A. [2 hdc], hdc. Cc to B. [2 hdc], hdc}. Repeat {} 4 more times. Cc to A. [2 hdc], hdc. Cc to B, and ss into the top of the ch 2. (36).

Round 5: [Ch 2, hdc], 2 hdc. {Cc to A. [2 hdc], 2 hdc. Cc to B. [2 hdc], 2 hdc}. Repeat {} 4 more times. Cc to A. [2 hdc], 2 hdc. Ss into the top of the ch 2 (with yarn A and fasten yarn B off). (48).

Round 6: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc]. Sc into each of the following sts of the previous round. Then, ss into the first sc, and fasten off. (48).

Back side

Follow the same instructions as the front side.

Joining

SMALL PEPPERMINT ORNAMENT

A refers to the cream (color 4), B refers to the color of the peppermint, and C refers to the background color. I made two ornaments. I used colors 41 and 90 (red and blue) for B, and color 66 (faint purple) for C.

Front side

With yarn A, begin with a magic circle.

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as the first hdc), 11 hdc into the magic circle. Close the magic circle. Ss into the top of the ch 2. (12).

Round 2: [Ch 3 (does NOT count as a st), dc, cc to B, dc]. { [Cc to A, dc. Cc to B, dc] }. Repeat {} 10 more times. Cc to A, and ss into the top of the first dc. Fasten yarn A and B off. (24). Round 3: Join C into the blo of any st of the previous round. [Ch 3 (counts as first dc), blo dc], blo dc. { [2 blo dc], blo dc}. Repeat {} 10 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 3. (36). Round 4: [Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), dc], 2 dc. { [2 dc], 2 dc}. Repeat {} 10 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 3 and fasten off. (48).

Back side

Follow the same instructions as the front side.





Joining

See below for the joining instructions.

JOINING

The striped ornament is joined with yarn A, and the peppermint ornaments are joined with yarn B.

To join the ornaments, hold the front and back pieces together with the right sides facing out (try to align the stripes of the two sides). Insert the hook through a st of the front side and the back side and pull the yarn through. Then, work one sc st into each set of corresponding sts of the front and back sides. However, into one set of corresponding sts, [sc, ch 20, ss into the first ch of the ch 20, sc] to add the hanging loop.

When about half of the ornament is joined, insert a small amount of filling inside, and continue joining. At the end of the round, ss into the first sc st, and fasten off.
