# Elf Sock

Ornament

Design: Libère tes mailles | Hobbii Design



## MATERIALS

### Friends Cotton 8/4:

1 skein color Malachite (106)

1 skein color Tomato (40)

A sock takes approx. 0.20 oz (5g) of yarn

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2

Scissors

Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100 % cotton

50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

## GAUGE

30 sc x 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

## ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

inc = increase

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Height (without loop): 2,2" (5,5 cm)

Length: 2,2" (5,5 cm)

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Decorating a Christmas tree is a nice and joyful moment. But it will be even more if the crocheter hangs his art, right?

Elf Sock will decorate your tree wonderfully. You can also make several socks in different colorways without the hanging loop and simply place them on your table to create pretty decorations, or crochet other patterns ornaments from Hobbii to create the prettiest garland.

The pattern is beginner-friendly.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Ch1 doesn't count as a st.

The sock is worked in one piece. You'll work in rounds from toe to heel, then in rows for the heel. Finally the leg is worked in rounds again and a chain is worked to create the hanging loop. To finish you sew to close the heel.

**How to change color:** change to the next color when crocheting the last st of the row. Insert hook in the last st, yarn over with the current color, pass through the st, yarn over with the new color, pass through the 2 loops on the hook.

## SOCK

### Toe and feet

With yarns A and B and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

Start with yarn A and make a magic circle.

**Round 1:** ch1, work 6 sc in the ring. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (6 sts)

**Round 2:** ch1, inc in each st. Change to yarn B in the last st of the round. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (12 sts)

**Round 3:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (12 sts)

**Round 4:** ch1, work \*1 sc in next st, inc\*. Repeat from \* to \* all around. Change to yarn A in the last st of the round. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

**Rounds 5 and 6:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Change to yarn B at the end of round 6. (18 sts)

**Rounds 7 and 8:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Change to yarn A at the end of round 8. (18 sts)

**Rounds 9 and 10:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Change to yarn B at the end of round 10. (18 sts)

## Heel

**Rows 1 and 2:** ch1, 1 sc in the next 10 sts. Change to yarn A in the last st of Row 2. (10 sts) Turn.

**Rows 3 and 4:** ch1, 1 sc in the next 10 sts. Change to yarn B in the last st of Row 4. (10 sts) Turn.

**Rows 5 and 6:** ch1, 1 sc in the next 10 sts. (10 sts) .

Fold the heel in half and work a sl st in the first st of row 6.

## Leg

With the right side facing.

**Round 1:** work 5 sc in the side of the rows from the heel part.

Work 1 dec: the first part of the decrease is worked in the side of the row from the heel and the second part in the first st of the feet.

Work 1 sc in the next 6 sts.

Work 1 dec: the first part of the decrease is worked in the last st of the feet and the second part in the side of the first row from the heel.

Work 5 sc in the side of the rows. Join with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

**Round 2:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Change to yarn A in the last st. Join with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

**Rounds 3 and 4:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Change to yarn B in the last st of Round 4. Join with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

**Rounds 5 and 6:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Change to yarn A in the last st of Round 6. Join with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

**Rounds 7 and 8:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Change to yarn B in the last st of Round 8. Join with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

**Rounds 9 and 10:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Join with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

Do not cut the yarn and ch 20, sl st in the same st to create the hanging loop. Fasten off and weave in ends
