# Santa Claus

**Coaster**

#### **MATERIALS**

#### Friends Cotton 8/8:

1 skein color White (01)

1 skein color Tomato (40)

1 skein color Cream (04)

This amount allows you to crochet 5 decorations.

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6 Scissors Darning needle A piece of black yarn for the eyes

## YARN QUALITY

**Friends Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii 100 % cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

20 dc x 8 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

st(s) = stitch(es)

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

yo = yarn over

inc = increase = 2 dc in the same st

WS = wrong side

RS = right side

#### SIZE

One size

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Diameter: approx 4.3" (11 cm)

A beautiful decoration in a cute Santa Claus shape that will immediately put you in the Christmas mood.

Create a lovely set with the Snowman and Christmas Bauble coasters patterns and Cosy Christmas cosy mug pattern. Quick and easy to make, it's also a perfect last minute gift for your host on Christmas Eve.

# **Pattern**







#### **INFO AND TIPS**

Ch 3 at the beginning of the round counts as one st. Join in round with 1 sl st in the 3rd ch at the beginning of dc rounds. You will work on the RS and the WS, so turn after each round. Cross the yarns on the WS.

### How to change color in dc:

Work the last dc before to change color like this: yo with the current color, insert hook in the st, yo with current color and pull through the st. Yo with the current color, pass through 2 loops on hook, yo with the new color, pass through 2 last loops on hook.

#### How to make a popcorn st:

\*Yo, insert crochet in the indicated st, yo and pull through the st, yo, pass through 2 loops on hook\*. Repeat 4 times in total. You have 5 loops on the hook. Yo and pull through all the loops on the hook.

# **DECORATION**

With White, Cream and Tomato yarns, and hook 4 mm (G/6)

Start with White yarn, make a magic ring

**Round 1 (RS):** ch 3, 5 dc with the White yarn, change to Cream yarn and work 6 dc. Finish with 1 sl st in top of ch3 and turn (12 sts)

**Round 2 (WS):** work 1 sl st in the first st in Cream, ch 3, 1 dc in the same st. Work 1 inc in the next 5 st.

Change to White and work 1 inc in the next 6 st. Finish with 1 sl st in top of ch3 and turn (24sts)

**Round 3 (RS):** work 1 sl st in the first st in White, ch 3, inc in the next st, \*1 dc in the next st, inc in the next st\* Repeat from \* to \* 5 times in total.

Change to Cream and repeat from \* to \* 6 times in total. Finish with 1 sl st in top of ch3 and turn (36 sts)

**Round 4 (WS):** work 1 sl st in the first st in Cream, ch 3, 1 dc in the following st, inc in the next st. \*1 dc in the next 2 st, inc in the following st\* Repeat from \* to \* 5 times in total.



Change to White and repeat from \* to \* 6 times in total. Finish with 1 sl st in top of ch3 and turn (48 sts)

**Round 5 (RS):** \*work 1 sl st in the next st, skip 1 st, 5 dc in the next st, skip 1 st\*. Repeat from \* to \* 6 times in total.

Work 1 sl st in the next st with Tomato. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 hdc in the next st, 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 2 hdc in the next st, \*1 dc in the next 3 st, inc in the following st\*. Repeat from \* to \* to the end of the round. Change to White in the last st. Do not close the round.

With White yarn, ch 3 and turn, work a popcorn st (see info and tips) in the last st of previous the Round. Ch 3, sl st in the same st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

#### **MUSTACHE**

With White yarn, and hook 4 mm (G/6)

You will work around a foundation chain. The first part is work normally in the chains, then you will turn around the foundation ch to work the second part in the back loops of the foundation ch.

#### Ch 16.

Work 1 sc in the 2nd st from the hook. \*Work 1 hdc in the next st, 1 dc in the next 3 st, 1 hdc in the following st, 1 sc in the next st\*, 1 sl st in the following st, 1 sc in the next st. Repeat from \* to \*. Work 1 sl st in the last st.

Continue around the foundation chain, sl st in next st, sc in the next st, 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in the next 2 sts, 1 sl st in the next st, 1 sc in the next 2 sts, 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in next st, 1 sl st in the last 2 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

#### **ASSEMBLING**

Sew the mustache on with the thinner side toward the top of the face. Embroider the eyes with the black yarn in a V shape. (I used Friends cotton 8/4 Black 124 and I doubled the stitches)

Weave in ends.

Dare and unleash your stitches!
