# **Christmas Hat**

## **Ornament**

**Design: Libère tes mailles | Hobbii Design**

## MATERIALS

### Friends Cotton 8/4:

- 1 skein color White (01)
- 1 skein color Malachite (106)
- 1 skein color Tomato (40)

A hat takes approx. 0.14 oz (4g) of yarn

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2  
Scissors  
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii  
100 % cotton  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

## GAUGE

30 sc x 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

## ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)  
ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
sl st = slip stitch  
inv dec = invisible decrease  
inc = increase

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Height (without loop): 2.4" (6 cm)  
Length: 2.4" (6 cm)

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Decorating a Christmas tree is a nice and joyful moment. But it will be even more if the crocheter hangs his art, right?

A Christmas Hat will decorate your tree wonderfully. You can also make several hats in different colorways without the hanging loop and simply place them on your table to create pretty decorations, or crochet other patterns ornaments from Hobbii to create the prettiest garland.

The pattern is beginner-friendly.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Ch1 in the beginning of each round doesn't count as a st.

The hat is worked in one piece from bottom to top, no sewing is needed.

**How to change color:** change to the next color when crocheting the last st of the row. Insert hook in the last st, yarn over with the current color, pass through the st, yarn over with the new color, pass through the 2 loops on the hook.

**How to work an invisible decrease:** insert hook in the front loop only of the first stitch, insert hook in the front loop only of the next stitch, yarn over, pull through the three loops on hook.

## HAT

With White and Tomato or Malachite yarns and hook 2.5 mm

Start with White yarn. Ch 30, join in round with a sl st.

**Rounds 1 and 2:** ch1 (doesn't count as a st), work 1 sc in each st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (30 sts) Change to Tomato or Malachite yarn in the last st of Round 2.

**Rounds 3 and 4:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (30 sts)

**Round 5:** ch1, work \*1 sc in next 8 sts, inv dec\*. Repeat from \* to \* all around. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (27 sts)

**Round 6:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (27 sts)

**Round 7:** ch1, work \*inv dec, 1 sc in next 7 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* all around. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (24 sts)

**Round 8:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (24 sts)

**Round 9:** ch1, work \*1 sc in next 6 sts, inv dec\*. Repeat from \* to \* all around. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (21 sts)

**Round 10:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (21 sts)

**Round 11:** ch1, work \*inv dec, 1 sc in next 5 sts\*. Repeat from \* to \* all around. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

**Round 12:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (18 sts)

**Round 13:** ch1, work \*1 sc in next st, inv dec\*. Repeat from \* to \* all around. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (12 sts)

**Round 14:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (12 sts)

**Round 15:** ch1, inv dec in each st. Change to White yarn in the last st. Finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (6 sts) Do not cut the yarn.

#### **HANGING LOOP AND POMPOM**

Ch 20, sl st in the same st.

**Round 16:** ch 1, inc in each st, finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (12 sts)

**Round 17:** ch1, dec in each st, finish with 1 sl st in the first st. (6 sts)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail to close the hole. Thread a needle with the yarn and pass through all the front loops of the last row. Pull to close the hole, secure and pass the yarn through the center to the inside of the work. Pull a little to form the pompom and secure. Weave in ends.
