Poncho

MATERIALS

A: 7/8/9 skeins of Friends Wool color 112

B: 4/5/5 skeins of Sweet Tweed color 10

Circular needle 9 mm (US 13) 80 cm 31.5"

Circular needle 7 mm (US 10.5) 80 cm 31.5"

5 Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii

100% Wool

50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

 **Sweet Tweed**, Hobbii

40% Acrylic, 21% Polyamide, 13% Mohair,

13% Wool, 9% Cotton, 4% Polyester

25 g (0.9 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

GAUGE

On Circular needle 9 mm (US 13)

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 12 sts x 22 rows

Circular needle 7 mm (US 10.5)

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 16 sts x 23 rows

SIZE

S/M/L

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 66.5/70/74 cm / 25.98"/27.56/29.13"

Without the collar

Width: 52/53/55 cm / 20.47/20.87/21.65"

shoulder to shoulder

PATTERN INFORMATION

Fabulous poncho to wear on a colder day,

great for a walk in the woods. Knit in the round

in a combination of stockinette and garter sts.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

Dec c/off = (Decrease cast off) K2tog from the back of the loop then slip the stitch back to the left needle, repeat to the end of the row

PM = Place marker

M = Marker

SM = Slide marker

m1 = Make one stitch using the left needle and pick up the yarn before the next stitch from the front and knit it into the back

INFO AND TIPS

The poncho is knitted in the round all the way with both yarns, from top down.

Use a different marker for the end of the round from the other four.

COLLAR

C/on 84 sts on 7 mm (US 10.5) needles with yarn A and B together
Join in the round make sure you are not twisting your work and PM

Round 1: K round

Round 2: P round

Knit Rounds 1 - 2 a total of 20 times

YOKE

Round 1: K

Round 2: P20, PM, K3, PM, P38, PM, K3, PM, P20

Round 3: K to M, m1, SM, K3, SM, m1, K to M, m1, SM, K3, SM, m1, K to the end of the round

Round 4: (P to M, SM, K3, SM) x 2, P to the end of the round

Knit Rounds 3 - 4 a total of 16/18/21 times (152/160/172 sts)

Change to 9 mm (US 13) needles
K 13/14/15 cm – 5.12"/5.51"/5.91"

Remove all markers except the one for the end of round

Arm Holes

Round 1: K28/30/33, dec c/off 20, K56/60/66, dec c/off 20, K28/30/33

Round 2: K28/30/33, c/on 20, K56/60/66, c/on 20, K28/30/33

BODY

K until the work measures 38/39/40 cm 14.96"/15.35"/15.75" from the arm holes

Hem

Round 1: P

Round 2: K

Knit Rounds 1-2 a total of 3 times

C/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Weave in all ends
