MATERIALS

Buttons 5 pcs Marker Stitch holder

Circular Needles: 3,0 mm and 3,5 mm

60 and 80 cm

Gauge: 19 stitch x 33 rows in Stockinette Stitch on needle 3,5 mm = 10 x 10 cm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only

FINAL MEASUREMENTS

Size XS (S) M (L) XL (XXL) XXXL

Chest 90 (96) 108 (112) 122 (136) 146 cm.
Length 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 (60) 62 cm.
Arm Length 44 (45) 46 (47) 47 (48) 48 cm.

DEFINITIONS

Decrease At the beginning of the row; knit

2 stitches together through the back

loop.

At the end of the row; knit 2 stitches

together.

Increase Make an increase in the loop between

the stitches, knit it on the right side and

purl on the wrong side.

Buttenhole Bind off 2 stitches. On the next row,

cast on 2 stitches over the bound-off

stitches.

Teddy

Soft like a dream and a yarn many have been longing for, to be used for

longing for, to be used for knitting and crocheting baby ware, teddies and blankets. Perfect for knitted teddy jackets and sweaters that are wonderful to wear. A "fluffy" yarn, that doesn't require any special techniques or stitches to get a nice and chunky result.

100% Polyester, 50 g/65 m.

Cosy

The thread is quite lightspun, soft and with a very special elasticity, which preserves the knit beautiful. The Cosy yarn is a bit vintage in its expression – warm, strong and even breathable.

60% Cotton/40% Acrylic, 50 g/100 m.

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GUIDE:

- Knit on a circular needle up to the armhole, where the work is divided
- The outer side of the pocket is knit back and forth and then sewn together with the front piece.
- The sleeves are knit back and forth and then sewn in.
- Stitches are picked up at the neckline

SWEATER LOUIE

XS (S) M (L) XI (XXL) XXXL

BACK PIECE AND FRONT PIECE

Cast on 172 (184) 196 (212) 232 (260) 280 stitches using a 3.0mm (80cm) needle in Teddy yarn.

Knit in the round in rib stitch, alternating *knit 1, purl 1*.

Knit 3 rounds...

Place a marker at the beginning of the round and place another marker after 86 (92) 98 (106) 116 (130) 140 stitches.

The first marker is the left side of the work.
The second marker is the right side of the work.

Switch to a 3.5mm (80cm) needle.
Continue knitting in stockinette stitch for the remainder of the work.

When the work measures $10\ \mathrm{cm}$, begin the pocket.

POCKET

Knit 19 (22) 24 (26) 28 (33) 37 stitches, place a marker, knit 48 (48) 50 (54) 60 (64) 66 stitches, place a marker, knit the rest of the round. The stitches between the markers are the pocket stitches

Continue with the pocket. Work back and forth in stockinette stitch.

Purl across the pocket stitches from the wrong side. At the same time, cast on 1 new stitch on each side; these are the edge stitches.

There are a total of **50 (50) 52 (56) 62 (66) 68** stitches on the needle.

On the next row, from the right side, make 1 decrease just inside the edge stitch on each side.

Repeat the decrease on every 2nd row an additional 0 (0) 0 (0) 3 (2) times.

Then, on every 4th row, work the decrease 9 (8) 10 (12) 10 (11) times.

After that, on every 6th row, work the decrease 1 (2) 1 (0) 0 (0) times.

After the final decrease, from the right side, knit 5 (5) 5 (5) 5 (5) rows in stockinette stitch.

On the last row, from the wrong side, bind off the

edge stitch on both sides.

There are a total of **26 (26) 26 (28) 32 (36) 38**

Place the stitches on a stitch holder..

stitches on the needle.

THE POCKET'S INNER SIDE

On the wrong side, pick up **48** (**48**) **50** (**54**) **60** (**64**) **66** stitches using a 3.5mm needle for the inside of the pocket.

Pick up the stitches **7** cm from the cast-on edge at the bottom.

Knit 9 rows back and forth.

The inside of the pocket is knitted together with the front and back pieces.

Knit the first 19 (22) 24 (26) 28 (33) 37 stitches of the front piece, knit 48 (48) 50 (54) 60 (64) stitches from the pocket's inside, knit the remaining stitches from the front piece, and then knit the stitches from the back piece.

Continue knitting in the round in stockinette stitch until reaching the same measurement as the pocket.

On the next round, knit the front of the pocket together with the front piece.

Knit 30 (33) 36 (39) 42 (47) 51 stitches from the front piece. Place the pocket's 26 (26) 26 (28) 32 (36) 38 stitches on a 3.5mm needle.

Hold the needle parallel to the circular needle and knit the stitches from the pocket's outer side together with the stitches from the pocket's inner side. Knit the rest of the round.

BACK AND FRONT PIECES - CONTINUED

Continue knitting in the round in stockinette stitch.

Knit until the work measures **29.5** (**30.5**) **32.5** (**33.5**) **34.5** (**36.5**) **37.5** cm.

Divide the work at the armhole.

Knit 86 (92) 98 (106) 116 (130) 140 stitches.

Place them on a stitch holder; this is the front piece.

BACK PIECE

Continue with the remaining 86 (92) 98 (106) 116 (130) 140 stitches for the back piece.

Cast on 1 new stitch on each side; these are the edge stitches.

There are a total of **88** (**94**) **100** (**108**) **118** (**132**) **142** stitches on the needle.

The first row is the right side.

Knit in stockinette stitch back and forth.

Knit until the back piece measures **48.5** (**50.5**) **52.5** (**54.5**) **56.5** (**58.5**) **60.5** cm.

Neck and Shoulder:

On the right side, bind off 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (16) 17 stitches at the beginning of the row for the right shoulder, knit 22 (24) 26 (28) 31 (35) 38 stitches, bind off 24 (24) 24 (26) 28 (30) 32 stitches at the center for the neck, and knit to the end of the row. Each side is worked separately from this point..

Left side:

Wrong side: Bind off 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (16) 17 stitches for the shoulder, purl to the end of the row. Right side: Bind off 2 stitches for the neck, knit to the end of the row.

Wrong side: Bind off 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (16) 18 stitches for the shoulder, purl to the end of the row.

Right side:

Wrong side: Knit across the row.

Right side: Bind off 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (16) 18 stitches for the shoulder, knit across the row. Wrong side: Bind off 2 stitches for the neck, knit across the row.

Right side: Bind off 10 (11) 12 (13) 15 (17) 18 stitches for the shoulder, knit across the row.

FRONT PIECE

Place the stitches from the front piece on a 3.5mm (60cm) needle.

The first row is the right side.

Cast on 1 new stitch on each side for the edge stitches

There are a total of 88 (94) 100 (108) 118 (132) 142 stitches on the needle.

Knit in stockinette stitch back and forth.

Slit:

On the first row from the right side, bind off the center **4** stitches.

Each side is worked separately from this point. There are a total of **42** (**45**) **48** (**52**) **57** (**64**) **69** stitches on each side.

Right side:

When the work measures 43 (45) 47 (49) 51 (53) 55 cm, begin the neck decreases. Bind off from the right side on every 2nd row as follows: 6-2-2-1-1 (6-2-2-1-1) 6-2-2-1-1 (7-2-2-1-1) 8-2-2-1-1 (8-2-2-1-1) 9-2-2-1 stitches.

When the work measures **48.5** (50.5) **52.5** (54.5) **56.5** (58.5) **60.5** cm, begin the shoulder decreases. Bind off from the wrong side on every **2**nd row for **10-10-10** (**11-11-11**) **12-12-12** (**13-13-13**) **14-14-**

15 (16-16-17) 17-18-18 stitches.

Left side:

When the work measures 43 (45) 47 (49) 51 (53) 55 cm, begin the neck decreases. Bind off from the wrong side on every 2nd row as follows: 6-2-2-1-1 (6-2-2-1-1) 6-2-2-1-1 (7-2-2-1-1) 8-2-2-1-1 (8-2-2-1) 9-2-2-2-1 stitches.

When the work measures **48.5** (50.5) **52.5** (54.5) **56.5** (58.5) **60.5** cm, begin the shoulder decreases. Bind off from the right side on every **2**nd row for **10-10-10** (11-11-11) **12-12-12** (13-13-13) **14-14-15** (16-16-17) **17-18-18** stitches.

Sew the shoulder seams together.

NECKLINE

From the right side, using a 3.5mm (60cm) needle and Teddy yarn, pick up stitches evenly around the neckline.

Pick up **73** (**75**) **75** (**79**) **81** (**85**) **89** stitches. Knit rib stitch.*knit 1, purl 1* Within the edge stitch on each side, continue in the rib pattern, knit 1, purl 1.

Knit for **7.5** cm, ending with a right-side row. Place the stitches on a stitch holder.

Left neckline:

Using a 3.0mm needle and Teddy yarn, pick up stitches evenly along the edge of the neckline. Begin on the right side at the top of the neckline. Knit rib stitch *knit 1, purl 1 * within the edge stitch on each side.

Knit for **2** cm, ending with a wrong-side row. Bind off in rib stitch from the right side..

Right neckline:

Using a 3.0mm needle and Teddy yarn, pick up stitches evenly along the edge of the neckline. Begin on the right side at the bottom of the neckline. Knit rib stitch *knit 1, purl 1* within the edge stitch on each side.

Knit for 1 cm.

Knit 5 buttonholes.

The bottom buttonhole is placed approximately **2** cm from the bind-off at the bottom of the neckline.

The top buttonhole is placed about 1 cm below the neckline.

The others are evenly spaced.

Knit a total of **2** cm, ending with a wrong-side row. Bind off in rib stitch from the right side.

Continue the neckline edging:

From the right side, using a 3.0mm (60cm) needle and Cosy yarn, pick up stitches at the top of the neckline.

Start on the upper side of the right neckline.

Next, transfer the stitches from the stitch holder onto a 3.0mm needle and knit in stockinette stitch.

Finally, pick up stitches at the top of the left neckline.

The total number of stitches should be odd.

Knit 3 rows in rib stitch *knit 1, purl 1 * within the edge stitch on each side.

Bind off in rib stitch

Sew the edges together at the bottom. Sew buttons onto the left front edge.

SLEEVES X 2

Knit 3 rows.

Cast on **41 (41) 43 (43) 45 (45) 45** stitches using a 3.0mm needle in Cosy yarn.

Knit rib stitch *knit 1, purl 1* within the edge stitch on each side. The first and last rows are the wrong side

Switch to a 3.5mm needle and Teddy yarn. Continue in stockinette stitch within the edge stitch on each side.

On the first row, evenly increase by 7 stitches. There are a total of 48 (48) 50 (50) 52 (52) 52 stitches on the needle.

When the work measures 3 cm, start the increases..

XS: Increase 1 stitch within the edge stitch on every 10th row, 4 times.

Then, increase on every 12th row, 6 times. There are a total of 68 stitches on the needle.

S: Increase **1** stitch within the edge stitch on every **10**th row, **12** times.

There are a total of **72** stitches on the needle.

M: Increase 1 stitch within the edge stitch on every 10th row, 8 times.

Then, increase on every 12th row, 3 times. There are a total of 72 stitches on the needle.

L: Increase 1 stitch within the edge stitch on every 10th row, 12 times.

There are a total of **74** stitches on the needle.

XL: Increase 1 stitch within the edge stitch on every 8th row, 3 times.

Then, increase on every 10th row, 10 times. There are a total of 78 stitches on the needle.

XXL: Increase 1 stitch within the edge stitch on every 8th row, 2 times.

Then, increase on every 10th row, 11 times. There are a total of 78 stitches on the needle.

XXXL: Increase 1 stitch within the edge stitch on every 8th row, 11 times.

Then, increase on every 10th row, 4 times.

There are a total of 82 stitches on the needle...

When the work measures **44 (45) 46 (47) 47 (48) 48** cm, bind off from the right side.

RIBBED EDGE ON THE POCKET

Right side:Starting from the top, pick up stitches evenly along the edge using a 3.0mm needle and Cosy yarn.

The stitch count should be odd.

Knit rib stitch * knit 1, purl 1 * within the edge stitch on each side.

Knit 3 rows.

Bind off in rib stitch.

Left side:Starting from the bottom, pick up stitches as done on the right side.

Knit rib as on the right side.

The ribbed edges are sewn onto the front piece. Sew the sleeves in and seam them together.

Good to know

Needle size and gauge

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us. The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/skills, rather than the size of needles. Therefore, we will recommend a range of needle sizes.
