Polar

Purse


Design: Mil y un hilo | Hobbii Design

MATERIALS

Col. 1: 1 skein of Peacock colour 09
Col. 2: 1 skein of Peacock colour 03

Knitting needles 6mm (US 10)
Handbag clutch strap, 16 cm, Col.
Black/Gold
Metal Zipper, 25 cm, Color Beige Gold
Stitch holders or cables
Stitch markers
Measuring tape
Pair of scissors
Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Peacock**, Hobbii
100 % Polyester
100 g / 3.5 oz = 65 m / 71 yds

GAUGE

9 sts x 15 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 20 cm / 8"
Height: 12 cm / 5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This purse is worked back and forth using garter stitch with 6mm needles. The front and the back are knitted separately and sewed together. An optional handbag clutch strap is sewed on one side of the purse to make it more handy.

The pattern contains a step by step guide with graphics and photos.

INFO AND TIPS

Garter stitch (back and forth)

Knit on the right side as well as on the wrong side.

Sewing

Turn the work over to make invisible seams from the inside of the purse. Also, avoid sewing the pieces too close to the zipper in order to prevent the zipper from getting tumbled.

FRONT PIECE

Cast on 24 stitches using colour 1 with 6mm needles. Then, work back and forth following Graphic A (proceed with the colour changes as per Graphic A).

Once the Graphic A is finished, place stitch markers on each side and knit 2 more rows using colour 2. Then, bind off the 24 stitches.

BACK PIECE

Cast on 24 stitches using colour 2 with 6mm needles. Then, work back and forth following Graphic B (proceed with the colour changes as per Graphic B).

Once the Graphic B is finished, place stitch markers on each side and knit 2 more rows using colour 1. Then, bind off the 24 stitches.

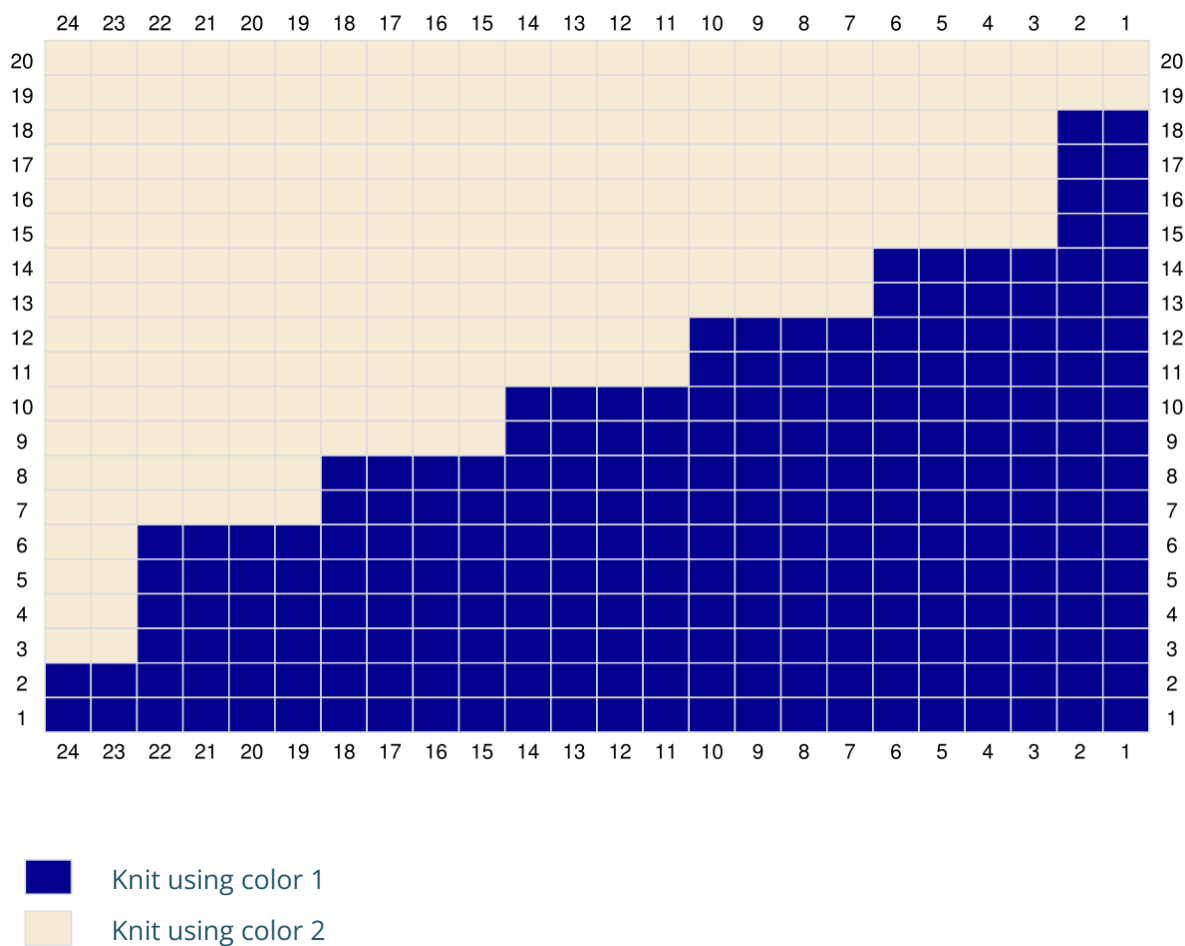
ASSEMBLY

Now, take the front piece and back piece with the wrong side facing out, so that the wrong side will be shown on the inside of the purse. In the area you previously placed the stitch markers, sew the zipper to the upper part of each piece (see photo). Once the zipper is sewed, sew the front piece and back piece together.



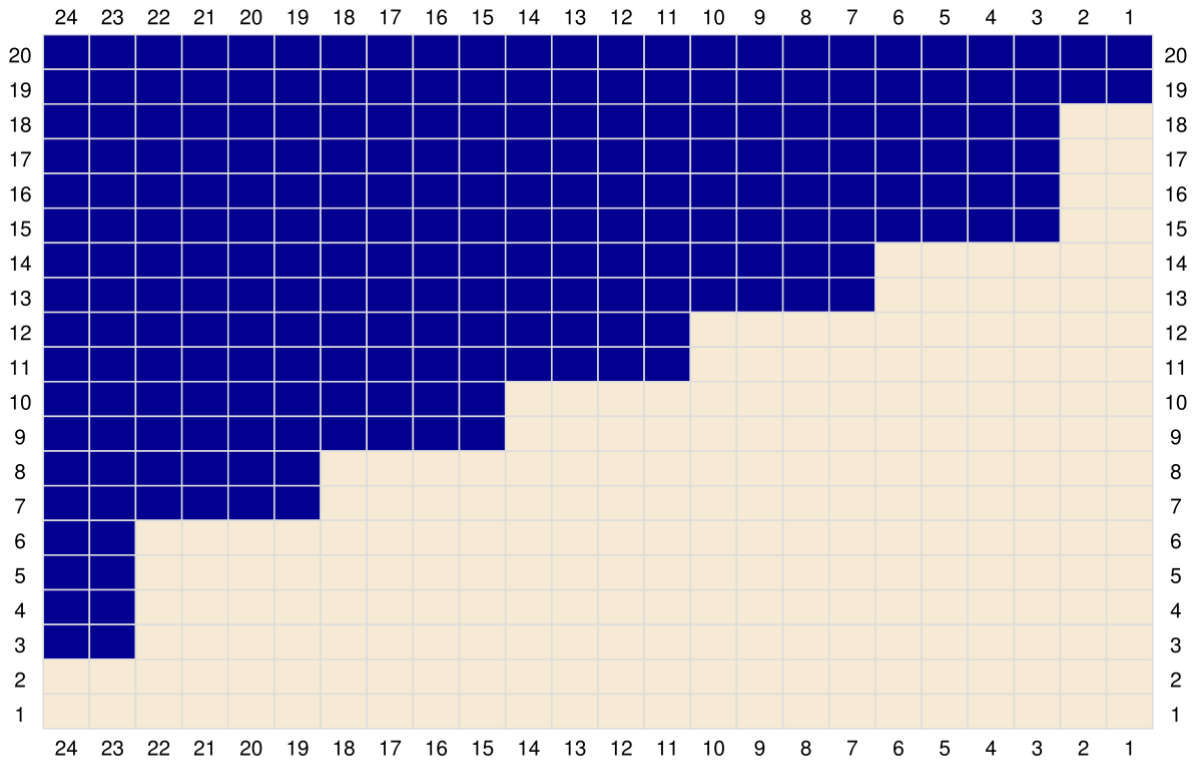
Optional: sew the clutch strap on the right side of the purse to make your Polar Purse more handy.
