## **T-shirt**

## MATERIALS

(7 7) 8 8 9 9 12 12 skeins of Metallico col. 04

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6

Buttons - Mother-of-pearl - Black 12 mm

Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Metallico**, Hobbii

70% Polyamide, 21% Acrylic, 9% Wool

50 g / 1.75 oz = 115 m / 126 yds

## GAUGE

Grid = 11 dc x 8 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

Square = 11 cm x 11 cm / 4.3" x 4.3"

1 skein of yarn = 11 squares

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

dc2tog = 2 dc crochet together

## SIZE

(S M) L XL 2XL 3XL 4XL 5XL

## MEASUREMENTS

## INFO AND TIPS

If you are between sizes, please size down

## FLOWER SQUARE PATTERN

Ch 5, join with sl st to the first ch

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), dc into the ch-circle, \* ch 3, dc2tog into the ch-circle \*\*, rep from \* to \*\* 6 times (7 times in total), join the round this way, when you finish the "8th petal" ch 1, dc in the top of ch 3. The next round will start from the centre of ch-3 space.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), dc in the same ch-space, ch 3, sc in the top of next petal, \* ch 3, dc2tog in next ch-3 space, ch 3, sc in the top of next petal \*\*, rep from \* to \*\* 6 times, ch 3, join with sl st to top of the first petal. 8 petals

Round 3: Ch 5 (counts as the first hdc plus ch 3), \* 3 dc in next top of next petal, ch 3, 3 dc in the same place, ch 3, hdc in next top of next petal, ch 3 \*\*, rep from \* to \*\* twice, 3 dc in the next top of the next petal, ch 3, 3 dc in the same place, ch 3, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

## JOINING

Lay 2 squares with right sides facing each other and start joining with sl sts through back loops only. Join 4 (S-M), 5 (L-XL), 6 (2XL-3XL), 7 (4XL-5XL) squares



## GRID

Connect the yarn to the first corner of the first square and start crocheting across the joined squares:

Row 1 (right side): Ch 3 (counts as the first dc), dc in the same space, dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next ch-3 space, dc in next hdc, 3 dc in next ch-3 space, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next ch-space (corner of the square), \* dc in the space between the squares, 2 dc in next ch-space (corner of the square), dc in next 3 dc, 3 dc in next ch-3 space, dc in next hdc, 3 dc in next ch-3 space, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next ch-space (corner of the square) \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to the end of the row.

Please NOTE: the number of sts in this row must be a multiple of 2. For example I crocheted only one dc in the last ch-space to get 70 dc in the row.



Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as the first dc plus ch-1 space), turn, skip next dc, dc in next dc, \* ch 1, skip next st, dc in next dc \*\*, rep from \* to \*\* to the end of the row

Row 3-4: Ch 4 (counts as the first dc plus ch-1 space), turn, dc in next dc, \* ch-1, dc in next dc \*\*, rep from \* to \*\* to the end of the row



Repeat Rows 1-4 for the opposite side. You will get this panel.



You will need two "two-sides grid panels" plus "one-side grid panel" (bottom) - front part, and the same panels - back part.



Lay two panels with the right sides facing each other and join them by sl sts. Connect the third panel in the same way.



Make a row of dc across the right and the left sides. The front part is done. Make the back part in the same way.

## SLEEVES

Crochet 4 (S-M), 5 (L-3XL), 6 (4XL-5XL) squares, connect them together. Make a row of dc across one side and 8 rows of the grid pattern. Make the second sleeve in the same way.



## JOINING

Make the seams in the same way as we joined the panels (from the wrong side by sl sts). I leave 24 cm for the neckline. Make the shoulders seams (red markers), sleeve seams (yellow markers) and side seams (blue markers). Connect the sleeves to the body part.



## BORDER

Make two dc rows around the neckline, bottom and sleeves.

## FAKE BUTTONS PANEL (optional)

Crochet a dc foundation row. The length of this row depends on the length of the cardigan. After that, make the second dc row across the foundation dc row. Sew buttons on it and sew the panel on the cardigan.
