# Freddie

Hat

#### **MATERIALS**

1 skein Hobbii Udon col Purple Rain (70)

Circular needles 12 mm, 60 cm Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

**Udon**, Hobbii 20% wool, 80% Acrylic 200 g = 100 m

#### **GAUGE**

 $10 \times 10 \text{ cm} / 4 \times 4 \text{ inches} = 8 \text{ sts} \times 10 \text{ rows}$  in rib (k2, p2)

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit P = purl St = stitch

#### **SIZE**

S (M, L)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 21 (23, 25) cm / 8.25 (9, 9.8) inches Width: 21 (23, 25) cm / 8.25 (9, 9.8) inches

Fits head circumference of approx.: 50-54 cm (54-58 cm, 58-62 cm) / 19.7-21.25 (21.25-22.8, 22.8-24.4) inches

#### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

Nice, chunky beginner friendly hat with a fold worked in rib on circular needles. Can be combined with a Freddie scarf.

#### **INFO AND TIPS**

The hat is worked in rib (k2, p2). Try the hat on as you go, to ensure the length is just right for you. The hat is worked in the round on circular needles. For the first few rounds it can be necessary to use the Magic Loop technique, or alternately circular needles 12 mm, 40 cm.

#### **HAT**

Cast on 32 (36, 40) stitches on circular needles 12 mm, 60 cm. Be careful not to cast on too tightly. Work 7 (8, 9) cm / 2.75 (3.1, 3.5) inches around in rib (k2, p2).

Work 1 round knit (*This is where the edge will be folded, when the hat is finished*).

Continue around in rib until the hat measures 28 (31, 34) cm / 11 (12.2, 13.4) inches *or your desired length*.

Now you will knit 2 stitches together through the round = 16 (18, 20) stitches on the needle. Pull the yarn through all the stitches and pull tight.

Secure the yarn on the inside of your hat.

Weave all ends. Fold the edge. Your hat is now ready for use:)
