MATERIALS

Friends Wool

2 skeins of col. 09
4 skeins of col. 52
10 skeins of col. 113
1 skein of col. 49
1 skein of col. 57
2 skeins of col. 73

Crochet hook 5 mm (US I/9)
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii
100% Wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

One square after blocking = 13 cm x 13 cm
(5" x 5")

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
tr = treble crochet
blo = back loop only

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 93 cm / 35.10"
Height: 132 cm / 52"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This is a soft and warm blanket in a romantic style, made up of crochet squares joined together.

The pattern uses basic stitches and is perfect for beginners. It is made on a medium crochet hook, making it quick and fun to make.

INFO AND TIPS

Weave in the ends as you go.

Since the yarn used in the project is quite elastic, do not tighten the thread while working so that the squares stay flat.

You can easily change the size of the blanket by adding or reducing the number of squares. Just remember to buy the right amount of yarn. The choice of colors and arrangement of squares is also only up to you!

To make this size you need 70 squares, in the following color combinations:

flower **A** center col. 52, petals col. 73 – 31 squares,

flower **B** center col. 52, petals col. 09 – 15 squares,

flower **C** center col. 52, petals col. 57 – 5 squares,

flower **D** center col. 52, petals col. 49 – 5 squares,

flower **E** center col. 09, petals col. 52 – 14 squares.

Make a magic ring

Round 1: ch 2 (counts as the 1st hdc), hdc 7, sl st to ch 2 to join. (8 hdc)

Round 2: ch 2, (counts as the 1st hdc), 2 hdc in every st, sl st to ch 2 to join. (16 hdc)

Round 3: ch 2, (counts as the 1st hdc), *2 hdc, 1 hdc* around, sl st to ch 2 to join. (24 hdc).

Cut off the yarn.

Petals

Round 4: Join the color of the petals to any st with a sl st, and work as follow:

skip 1 st, 3 tr in every of the next three sts, skip 1 st, sl st in the next st, repeat 3 more times, 4 petals in total. Join with a sl st in the spot where you started. Cut off the yarn.

Round 5: Join col. 113 with a sl st to the back loop of the first tr on any petal, ch 1 (counts as the 1st sc). Work sc in each st on petals and dc in sl st between petals. Sl st to 1st st to join. (36 sc, 4 dc)

Round 6: ch 2 (counts as the 1st dc), 3 dc, (tr, ch 1, tr) in the next st, *9 dc, (tr, ch 1, tr) in the next st* repeat 3 times in total, 5 dc, sl st to 1st st to join.

Round 7: ch 2 (counts as the 1st dc), 4 dc, (tr, ch 1, tr) in the next st, *10 dc, (tr, ch 1, tr) in the next st* repeat 3 times in total, 5 dc, sl st to 1st st to join. Cut off the yarn.

ASSEMBLING

Block each square gently. Arrange the squares according to the chart below, or as you wish, and join them using your favorite method, or as like I did, with a mattress stitch.

Work dc around the entire blanket, working (dc, ch 1, dc) at the corners. Join with sl st in the 1st st, and your blanket is ready!
