



KNITTING PATTERN

Universal

Cloth and towel

MATERIALS

4 skeins Friends Cotton 8/4, color Dusty Mauve (58)

Circular needles 3.5 mm 60 cm

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100% cotton

50 g = 160 m

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm = 21 sts x 26 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

st(s) = stitch(es)

rnd = round

inc = increase(s)

dec = decrease(s)

tog = together

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Dishcloth/washcloth = 22 x 22 cm after wash

Kitchen towel/guest towel = 40 x 40 cm after wash

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Universal-set consists of a cloth and a towel, worked back and forth on circular needles in garter stitch and with i-cord edges, consisting of two sts on each side. The finished cloths can be used as dishcloth and/or washcloth and a kitchen towel and/or guest towel.

The gauge is guiding and not very important. The pattern is well suited for beginners.

INFO AND TIPS

Friends Cotton 8/4 is a quite stretchy yarn, but you have to anticipate it shrinking approx. 5% after wash at 60 degrees celsius.

If your tension is high, it can be a good idea to go half a needle size up, and if your tension is loose, it is a good idea to go have a needle size up. This makes the work glide easier.

When you have leftover yarn, you can make your dishcloths/washcloths striped. That way, you avoid wasting yarn.

Increases and decreases

Inc: K 1 in front and back loop of a st

Dec: Slip 1 st knitwise, k 1, pull slipped st over the k st

DISHCLOTH/WASHCLOTH

Cast on 4 sts on 3.5 mm, 60 cm circular needles and work 1. row like this:

K 2, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

The first 2 sts and the last 2 sts are the i-cord edge all through the work.

2. row: K 1 st, in next st will make an inc, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

3. row: K 1 st, in next st will make an inc, k 1, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

4. row: K 1 st, in next st will make an inc, k 2, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

5. row: K 1 st, in next st will make an inc, k 3, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

You will continue like this, until you have 75 sts on the needle.

This is also the middle of the work.

Now starts dec on every row, until there are 4 sts on the needle again.

Decrease like this:

1. row: K 1. st, slip 1 st knitwise, k 1, pull slipped st over the k st, k 70, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

2. row: K 1. st, slip 1 st knitwise, k 1, pull slipped st over the k st, k 69, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

Continue like this until 4 sts remain and bind them off.

KITCHEN TOWEL/GUEST TOWEL

Cast on 4 sts on 3.5 mm, 60 cm circular needles and work 1. row like this:

K 2, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

The first 2 sts and the last 2 sts are the i-cord edge all through the work.

2. row: K 1 st, in next st will make an inc, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.
3. row: K 1 st, in next st will make an inc, k 1, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.
4. row: K 1 st, in next st will make an inc, k 2, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.
5. row: K 1 st, in next st will make an inc, k 3, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.
You will continue like this, until you have 120 sts on the needle.

This is also the middle of the work.

Now starts dec on every row, until there are 4 sts on the needle again.

Decrease like this:

1. row: K 1. st, slip 1 st knitwise, k 1, pull slipped st over the k st, k 115, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

2. row: K 1. st, slip 1 st knitwise, k 1, pull slipped st over the k st, k 114, slip 2 sts with yarn in front.

Continue like this until 4 sts remain and bind them off.

JOINING AND WASH

Weave all your tails discreetly.

Wash your finished work in the washing machine at 60 degrees celsius.

Stretch the cloths into shape on a towel, and optionally steam the cloth when they are dry, so they become even and nice.

On the kitchen towel/guest towel you can attach a towel clip or a leather strop, or you can crochet a loop of chains that you sew on at the end.
