# **Dandy**

**Dog Bandana**

## MATERIALS

1 skein each of Kind Feather in colors:

11 (Pink)

12 (Lavender)

17 (Turquoise)

21 (Light Green)

05 (Yellow)

06 (Orange)

07 (Red)

You will need a total of 4 (7, 9) colours, or one skein of your chosen colour.

Crochet hook 5 mm (US K/10.5)

Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Kind Feather**, Hobbii

100 % Acrylic

100 g / 3.5 oz. = 235 m / 257 yds

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 12 sts x 4 rounds

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

sc = single crochet

ss = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

FO = fasten off

## SIZE

S (M, L)

## MEASUREMENTS

Bandana Depth: 10 (18, 22) cm / 4" (7", 9")

Easily customisable to any size dog!

Show your best pal you love them with a snazzy granny stitch bandana. Make it in rainbow brights for those confident pups, or muted tones for a chilled out canine.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Starting ch counts as your first st throughout. Work your chains really loosely to make sure your triangle edge stays flat.

You can easily alter the size of your bandana to make it perfect for your pet, simply work as many rounds as you like before adding your neck tie.

Wally is wearing a size M bandana.

## BANDANA

**Round 1:** ch5, (3dc, ch2, 4dc) all in fifth ch from hook, FO.

**Round 2:** Join next colour in the top of your final st from the previous round, ch4, 3dc in sp between final 2 sts from previous round, (3dc, ch2, 3dc) all in ch2 sp, 4dc between first 2 sts from previous round, FO.

**Round 3:** Join next colour in the top of your final st from the previous round, ch4, 3dc between final 2 sts from previous round, 3dc in next sp, (3dc, ch2, 3dc) all in ch2 sp, 3dc in next sp, 4dc between first 2 sts from previous round, FO.

**Round 4:** Join next colour in the top of your final st from the previous round, ch4, 3dc between final 2 sts from the previous round, 3dc in each sp to ch2 sp, (3dc, ch2, 3dc) all in ch2 sp, 3dc in each sp to last 4 sts, 4dc between first 2 sts from previous round, FO.

**Repeat Round 4 until you have a total of 4 (7, 9) rounds or until you reach your desired size, do not FO, work Neck Tie.**





### NECK TIE

**Row 1:** ch 19 (25, 31) (or to your chosen length for the tie), sc in second ch from hook and each ch along, work 2sc in each row edge and 1sc in your starting ch along the flat side of your triangle, when you reach the other side of your triangle ch 19 (25, 31) (or the same as you did before), turn and sc in second ch from hook and each ch along, ss to final st on your bandana edge, FO and weave in your ends.
