MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein of col. 08 (col. A)

1 skein of col. 58 (col. B)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2

Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100 % Cotton

50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

GAUGE (SC)

21 sts x 26 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

inc = increase

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 6 cm / 2.4"

Length: 5 cm / 2"

INFO AND TIPS

Have fun with colors! You can make your cookie in different flavors by changing the filling or the cookie.

I also suggest adding a safety pin on the back to make your cookie extra fun! You can use a Hot glue gun or sew it securely.

HEART (MAKE 3)

Make two with col. A and one with col. B.

Ch 2. Crochet in rows.

For the next rows inc always with sc.

Row 1: Start with a inc into the second ch from hook (2)

Row 2: ch 1, turn, inc 2 times (4)

Row 3: ch 1, turn, inc, sc 2, inc (6)

Row 4: ch 1, turn, inc, sc 4, inc (8)

Row 5: ch 1, turn, inc, sc 6, inc (10)

Row 6: ch1, turn, inc, sc 8, inc (12)

Row 7: ch1, turn, inc, sc 10, inc (14)

Row 8: ch 1, turn, inc, sc 12, inc (16)

Now we're going to make two shell stitches with the next rows.

Row 9: ch 2, turn, skip 3 stitches, (dc 1, ch 1, dc 1) in the next stitch, ch 2, skip 3 stitches, sc in the next stitch, ch 2, skip 3 stitches, (dc 1, ch 1, dc 1) in the next stitch, ch 2, skip 3 stitches, sl st in the last stitch



Row 10: ch 1, turn, (dc 8 in the ch space between both dc in row 9, skip 2 ch, sc in the next stitch) x 2 times



Do not cut the yarn and make a border of sc around the heart by making sc 7 on the side of the heart, then 3 on the bottom corner and 7 on the other side. For the top of the heart sc 8 in the first shell stitch and sl st in the middle, then sc 8 on the second shell stitch. Fasten off and weave in the end.

Block the piece before assembling.

ASSEMBLING

First place the cream filling in the center of one of the cookie pieces. Sew the cream filling to the cookie with col. A, making sure it's secure.

Now you place the second cookie piece on top, sandwiching the cream filling between them and sew the two cookie pieces together around the edges.

And there you have it, your own sweetheart cookie! Match with your friends by using it as a keychain or pin on a tote bag :)
