# Filled Chocolates

## MATERIAL

Friends Cotton 8/4 - one skein of each:

10 g in Caramel (14) **(A)**

20 g in Chestnut (11) **(B)**

10 g in Chocolate (12) **(C)**

15 g in Oatmilk (03) **(D)**

5 g in Nougat (09) **(E)**

A remainder in Eucalyptus (98) **(F)**

A remainder in Mulberry (55) **(G)**

Rainbow Lace - one skein of each:

10 g in Beige (04) **(H)**

A remainder in Light Brown (06) **(I)**

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 and 1 mm /

US 12

Filling

Pin needles

Wool needle

An empty chocolate box (optional)

## YARN

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100% Cotton

50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

 **Rainbow Lace**, Hobbii

100 % Cotton

50 g / 1.75 oz = 280 m / 308 yds

## MEASUREMENTS

4 cm / 1.6 " width per filled chocolate

## PATTERN INFORMATION

If you want to crochet a low-calorie version of filled chocolates, you've come to the right place. The pattern is suitable for beginners who have mastered the basics of crocheting. You should be able to crochet in spiral rounds using single crochet stitches. Stuff the chocolates enough with filling so that they don't end up too soft.

In the pattern you will find photos of the most important steps for better orientation.

## ABBREVIATIONS

- sc = single crochet
- st = stitch
- ch = chain
- sl st = slip stitch
- inc = increase
- dec = decrease
- Rnd = Round
- BLO = Back loop only
- FLO = Front loop only
- MR = Magic Ring

## INFO AND TIPS

Stuff the chocolates continuously with filling as you work.  
All chocolates are made using crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2. Some of the chocolate decorations are made with crochet hook 1 mm / US 12.

## 1. FILLED CHOCOLATE



### Caramel Chocolate (col. A)

1. Rnd: crochet 7 sc in a MR (7).
2. Rnd: (1 sc inc) x7 (14).
3. Rnd: (1 sc, 1 st inc) x7 (21).
4. - 8. Rnds: 21 sc (5 Rnds) (21).
9. Rnd: (1 sc, 1 st dec) x7 (14).

10. Rnd: (1 st dec) x7 (7).

Cut the thread and sew through the front loops of the last round, pull tight and weave in the ends.

### White Chocolate Decor (col. H)

With a 1 mm /US 12 crochet hook, ch 40, cut the thread long and sew the chain of ch-sts onto the chocolate as shown in the picture below.



## 2. FILLED CHOCOLATE



### Chestnut Cube (col. B)

1. Rnd: crochet 8 sc in a MR (8).

2. Rnd: (1 sc, 3 sc in one st) x4 (16).

3. Rnd: (3 sc, 3 sc in one st) x4 (24).

4. Rnd: 24 sc in BLO (24).

5. - 9. Rnds: 24 sc (5 Rnds) (24).

10. Rnd: (3 sc, dec 3 sc together) x4 (16).

11. Rnd: (1 st dec) x8 (8).

Cut the thread and sew through the front loops of the last round, pull tight and weave in the ends.

### Chocolate Decoration (col. H and col. I)

The individual colors are embroidered one after the other in a checked pattern. Start with beige. Embroider the individual stripes over 12 sc in length with 2 sc between them. Once all the stripes are in beige, repeat the process again in light brown and embroider the stripes across them (see picture).



### 3. FILLED CHOCOLATE



#### White Chocolate Nougat Swirl (col. D)

Start with the chocolate.

1. Rnd: crochet 7 sc in a MR (7).
2. Rnd: (1 st inc) x7 (14).
3. Rnd: (1 sc, 1 st inc) x7 (21).
4. Rnd: 21 sc in BLO (21).
5. - 8. Rnds: 21 sc (4 Rnds) (21).
9. Rnd: (1 sc BLO, 1 st dec BLO) x7 (14).
10. Rnd: (1 st dec) x7 (7).

Cut the thread and sew through the front loops of the last round, pull tight and weave in the ends.

#### Nougat Swirl Topping (col. E)

Pick up the thread in the FLO from round 4 of the chocolate, insert from bottom to top and crochet 21 sc all the way around. Finish with a sl st in the first st. Without casting off, crochet 37 ch, insert into the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook and crochet 36 sc along the ch-sts. Finish the next st with a sl st in the BLO. Cut the thread long, wrap the nougat topping in the middle of the chocolate and sew it in place with a few stitches. For better orientation: see the photo guide below.



#### **Almond (col. H)**

Crochet the almond decoration with a 1 mm / US 12 crochet hook. yarn in beige. Crochet 4 ch, insert into the 2nd ch from hook and work around the ch-sts as follows:

1. Rnd: 2 sc, 4 sc in one st, further on the other side of the ch-sts, 2 sc (8).

Cut the thread long and sew the almond onto the nougat swirl topping.

## **4. FILLED CHOCOLATE**



#### **Pistachio Milk Chocolate (in col. D and col. C)**

Start with col. D.

1. Rnd: crochet 8 sc in a MR (8).

2. Rnd: (1 sc, 3 sc in one st) x4 (16).

3. Rnd: (3 sc, 3 sc in one st) x4 (24).

4. Rnd: 24 sc in BLO (24).

5. Rnd: 24 sc (24).

Change to col. C.

6. Rnd: 24 sc in BLO (24).

7. - 10. Rnds: 24 sc (4 Rnds) (24).

11. Rnd: (3 sc BLO, dec 3 sc together BLO) x4 (16).

12. Rnd (1 st dec) x8 (8).

Cut the thread and sew through the front loops of the last round, pull tight and weave in the ends.

Pick up the thread in col. D in the FLO from round 4. Insert from top to bottom and continue crocheting as follows:

13. Rnd: (5 sc, 3 ch, stitch in the 2nd ch from needle, 2 sc along the ch-sts, 1 st inc in the next st) x4 (36).

Finish with a sl st, cut the thread long and sew the edge from round 13 to the chocolate with a few stitches. See photoguide below



### **Pistachio (col. F)**

1. Rnd: crochet 4 sc in a MR (4).

2. Rnd: 3 sc in one st, 1 st inc, 2 sc (7).

Finish with a sl st, cut the thread long and sew the pistachio onto the filled chocolate.

## 5. FILLED CHOCOLATE



### Strawberry Chocolate (col. C)

1. Rnd: crochet 7 sc in a MR (7).
2. Rnd: (1 st inc) x7 (14).
3. Rnd: (1 sc, 1 st inc) x7 (21).
4. - 8. Rnds: 21 sc (5 Rnds) (21).
9. Rnd: (1 sc in BLO, 1 st dec in BLO) x7 (14).
10. Rnd: (1 st dec) x7 (7).

Cut the thread and sew through the front loops of the last round, pull tight and weave in the ends.

### Strawberry (col. G)

Stuff the strawberry lightly with filling.

1. Rnd: crochet 8 sc in a MR (8).
2. Rnd: (2 sc, 1 st dec) x2 (6).
3. Rnd: 6 sc (6).

Cut the thread and sew through the front loops of the last round, pull tight and weave in the ends.

### Leafs (col. F)

Pick up the thread on the last round of the strawberry, secure it with a sl st.

Ch2, 1 inc in the 2nd st from the hook, 1 sc in the strawberry. Repeat three more times. In the end you should end up with four sheets (see pictureguide below.) Embroider the cores in Rainbow Lace col. H. The cores are embroidered over 1 st high each.





## 6. FILLED CHOCOLATE

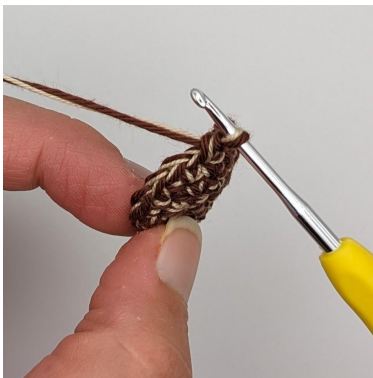


### Truffle Fudge Ball (in col. B and col. H)

Hold the two colors together and work with both threads at the same time.

1. Rnd: crochet 6 sc in a MR (6).
2. Rnd: (1 st inc) x6 (12).
3. Rnd: (1 sc, 1 st inc) x6 (18).
4. - 8. Rnds: 18 sc (5 Rnds) (18).
9. Rnd: (1 sc, 1 st dec) x6 (12).
10. Rnd: (1 st dec) x6 (6).

Cut the threads and sew through the front loops of the last round, pull tight and weave in the ends.
