# Riley

## Scarf

Design: Hobbii Design




## MATERIALS

7 skeins Diablo Wild Print col Soft Pastels (11)

Crochet hook 6 mm

Wool needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Diablo Wild Print**, Hobbii  
40% acrylic, 30% mohair 30% polyamide  
25 g (0.9 oz) = 225 m (246 yds)

## GAUGE

1 repeat in pattern = approx. 6 cm / 2.4 inches in width.

10 cm / 4 inches = approx. 21 sc

## ABBREVIATIONS

sc = single crochet

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

tr = triple crochet

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

26 cm x 195 cm / 10.25 x 76.75 inches

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Riley is a lovely, soft scarf worked in a beautiful pattern. The pattern of the entire scarf is made by repeating the same six rows.

The entire work is made with two strands together.

# Pattern



## SCARF

2 strands are used.

Ch 55 (loosely). Turn and continue:

**1. row:** 1 sc in 7. ch from hook, 2 x (ch 3, skip ch 2, 1 sc in next ch), \*ch 4, skip ch 3, 1 sc in next ch, 2 x (ch 3, skip ch 2, 1 sc in next ch)\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, and finish with ch 2, 1 dc in last ch, turn.

**2. row:** ch 4, 4 tr around the 2 first ch, 1 sc around first ch-3-space, ch 3, 1 sc around next ch-3-space, \*9 tr around ch-4-space, 1 sc around first ch-3-space, ch 3, 1 sc around next ch-3-space\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, and finish with 5 tr in last ch-space, turn.

**3. row:** ch 1, 1 sc in 1. and 2. tr, \*ch 5, 1 sc in ch-3-space, ch 3, 1 sc in same ch-3-space, ch 5, 1 sc in 4., 5. and 6. tr\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, and finish with ch 5, 1 sc in ch-3-space, ch 3, 1 sc in same ch-3-space, ch 5, 1 sc in 4. tr and in the top of the ch 4, turn.

**4. row:** ch 1, 1 sc in first sc, \*ch 3, 1 sc around first ch-5-space, ch 4, 1 sc around next ch-5-space, ch 3, 1 sc in the middle of the 3 sc\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, while the last sc is worked in the sc that ends the row, turn.

**5. row:** ch 3, 1 sc around first ch-3-space, 9 tr around next ch-4-space, \*1 sc around first ch-3-space, ch 3, 1 sc around next ch-3-space, 9 tr around next ch-4-space\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, and finish with 1 sc in last ch-3-space, ch 1, 1 dc in sc that ends row, turn.

**6. row:** ch 1, 1 sc in dc, 1 sc around ch, \*ch 5, 1 sc in 4., 5. and 6. tr, ch 5, 1 sc around ch-3-space, ch 3, 1 sc around same ch-3-space\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, and finish with ch 5, 1 sc in 4., 5. and 6. tr, ch 5, 1 sc around last ch-3-space, turn.

**7. row:** ch 5, 1 sc around first ch-5-space, ch 3, 1 sc in the middle of the 3 sc, ch 3, 1 sc around next ch-5-space, \*ch 4, 1 sc around next ch-5-space, ch 3, 1 sc in the middle of the 3 sc, ch 3, 1 sc around next ch-5-space\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, and finish with ch 2, 1 dc in sc that ends row, turn.

Repeat 2.-7. row until work measures 186 cm / 73.25 inches – finish after 4. or 7. row.

Work 4 rows sc along each of the short ends of the scarf, while working 1 sc in each ch.



## **JOINING**

Weave the ends. Make work slightly damp, and let it dry flat according to the measurements.
