Jules

Stole

MATERIALS

4 skeins Friends Kid Silk color 54

Single pointed needles 4.5 mm
Single pointed needles 9 mm
Wool needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii
72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool
25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

GAUGE

20 sts in pattern on 4.5 and 9 mm needles
= 10 cm / 4 inches

ABBREVIATIONS

s1k: slip 1 knit-wise
k1tbl: knit 1 through back loop
Rep: repeat

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

30 x 142 cm / 11.8 x 56 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Jules stole is worked in two strands of Friends Kid Silk and is a light, soft, and lovely project.

The fine structure is made with a rib pattern of purl and knit back loop stitches. Besides that, two different needle sizes are used. Jules stole can be used as a shawl around the shoulders or as an ordinary scarf.

Pattern



STOLE

Cast on 60 sts on 4.5 mm needle with two strands of Friends Kid Silk

1. row: knit 2, purl 2, rep through the row

2. row: s1k, k1tbl, purl 2,* k2tbl, purl 2* rep through the row

Work a total of 6 rows as 2. row

8. row: *knit 2 together through back loop, purl 2 together* rep through the row

9. row: slip 1 st knit-wise, purl 1, * k1tbl, purl 1,* rep through the row

Repeat 9. row until work measures 15 cm.

Turn work. Distribute the stitches on 2 needles in the following way

1. st on 1. needle, 2. st on 2. needle, 3. st on 1. needle, 4. st on 2. needle

Continue in this way alternately on 1. og 2. needle.

Work the stitches on the 1. needle in the following way.

Work 2 stitches in each stitch by working knit 1 in both front and back loop of the same stitch.

Continue as 9. row until work measures 22 cm.

Work knit 2 together through back loop through the row. Let this side rest and work over the stitches on 2. needle in the same way as 1. needle.

Gather the stitches on one needle again - alternately 1 stitch from each needle, so they sit in the same way again.

Work a row like the 9. row. On the next row from the right side work 2 stitches in each stitch by working knit 1 in both front and back loop of the same stitch.

Continue as 9. row again, but on the wrong side of the work you will now use 9 mm needle, and on the right side 4.5 mm needle.

Work with alternately 9 mm and 4.5 mm needles until the work measures 122 cm / 48 inches.

End on a wrong side row.

Continue with only 4.5 mm needle.

On next row work *knit 2 together, purl 2 together* rep through the row.

Work 19 cm as 9. row, then work 2 stitches in each stitch by working knit 1 in both front and back loop of the same stitch.



Work 6 rows * knit 2, purl 2 * rep through the row.
Bind off in knit and purl.
Weave ends.
