Crossbody Bag

MATERIALS

2 skeins of Portobello color 79 (Color A)
2 skeins of Portobello color 120 (Color B)

Crochet Hook 5.5 mm / US I
Magnetic button - 20 mm color silver
Handbag Shoulder Strap Adjustable - 25 mm x 130 cm color black/silver
Sewing needle
Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Portobello**, Hobbii
60% Cotton, 28% Acrylic, 12% Wool
50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

GAUGE

12 sts x 12 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm/4 in x 4 in
Single Crochet

ABBREVIATIONS

CH - Chain
INC - Increase
[JS - Jasmine Stitch](#)
JS INC - Jasmine Stitch Increase
PS - Puff Stitch
REP - Repeat
SC - Single Crochet
SCBLO - Single Crochet Back Loop Only
SL ST - Slip Stitch
ST - Stitch

INFO AND TIPS

This pattern is written in US Terminology.

This pattern is written in crochet shorthand. Example: "SC 1" means to single crochet in the next stitch and "SC 30" means to single crochet into the next 30 stitches.

The entire pattern is worked using two strands of yarn held together.

After round 1, the pattern is worked in continuous rounds without joining.

Place stitch marker in the first stitch of round to indicate the beginning of the round, making sure to move stitch marker up each round.

I highly recommend watching the [video tutorial](#) for the jasmine stitch and puff stitch before starting the flap

When working the jasmine stitch, the PS acts as a CH & turning CH

When crocheting foundation CH for flap, you will work PS on top of previous PS.

JS INC are a particular stitch NOT multiple JS in one space (see video tutorial for more details)

BODY

Using color A, CH 25

Round 1:

SC in 2nd CH from hook

SC 22

SC 4 in last CH

SC 22 working on opposite side of CH

SC 3 in same SP as 1st SC

SL ST to 1st SC to join

(52 SC)

Rounds 2-17: (see Notes)

SC 52

(52 SC)

Round 18:

SC 4 around D ring (See photo 1)

SC 22

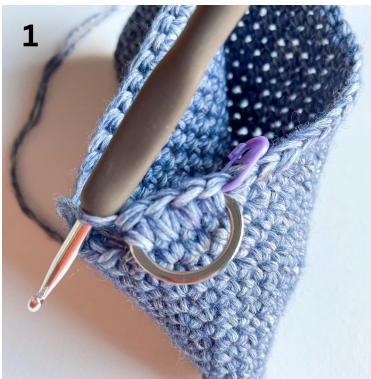
SC 4 around 2nd D ring

SC 22

SL ST to 1st SC to join

(52 SC)

Tie off & weave in ends



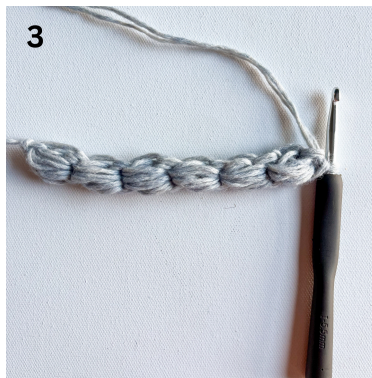
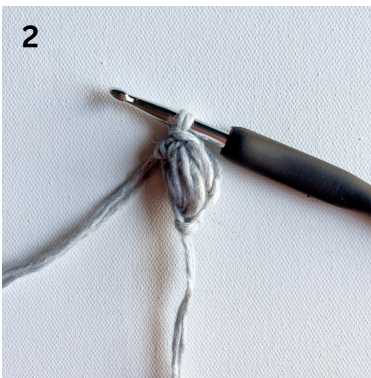
FLAP

Using color B, CH 2

PS in 2nd CH from hook (See photo 2)

PS 5 (See photo 3)

(6 PS)

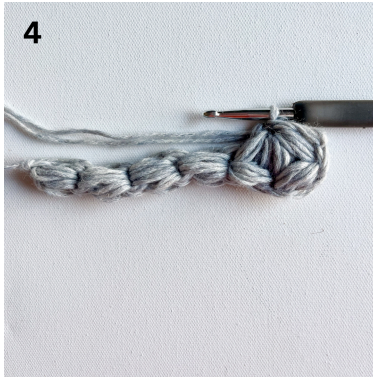


Row 1: (See photos 4 & 5)

JS 5

turn

(5 JS)

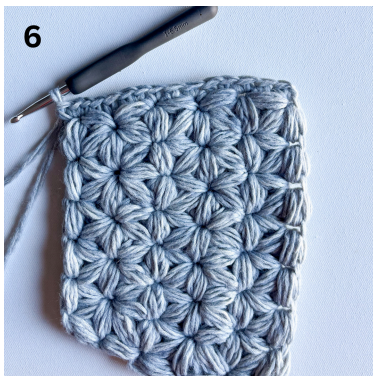


Row 2:
 PS 1
 JS 1
 JS INC
 JS 3
 JS INC
 JS 1
 turn
 (1 PS, 7 JS, 2 JS INC)

Rows 3-5:
 PS 1
 JS 7
 turn
 (1 PS, 7 JS)

BORDER

CH 1 & turn flap to work on the side
 SC 12 evenly to corner (approximately 2 stitches per petal, spacing stitches evenly helps flap to lay flat. Add more stitches, if necessary.)
 SC 3 in the 1st corner (See photo 6)
 SC 10 to corner
 SC 3 in 2nd corner
 SC 12 on opposite side
 (40 SC)



Tie off leaving a 30 cm (12 in) tail for sewing

ASSEMBLY

With right sides facing, lay last row of flap and last round of body together. (See Photo 7)
Attach each end of the flap to the body with ST markers (Between D rings).

Using a whip stitch, sew the flap to the body of the bag. Make sure to sew through only one side of the bag.

Line magnetic snap up with row 10 of body. With color B, sew magnetic snap to center of the body and flap. (See photo 8)



TASSEL

Cut (2) 30 cm (12 in) pieces of yarn & set aside

Using a 10 cm x 10 cm (4 in x 4 in) piece of cardboard, wrap yarn around 15 times (See photo 9)

Cut yarn and pull the loops off of the cardboard carefully in one piece

Use 30 cm (12 in) piece of yarn and tie a knot around the center of loops (See photo 10)

Fold loops in half. Use 30 cm (12 in) piece of yarn and wrap it around the top of all the loops (See photo 11)

Secure by using a sewing needle to weave in the end

Trim ends to desired length

Attach tassel to center of flap with a sewing needle

Tie off & weave in ends

Attach shoulder straps to D rings
