



KNITTING PATTERN

Audrey Tunic

Design: Au Bout du Pré | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

6/6/7/7/7/8/8 skeins of Pearly Haze color 10

Straight needle 6 mm (US 10) Stitch holder Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Pearly Haze, Hobbii 73% Viscose, 27% Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 110 m (120 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 13 sts x 25 rows

SIZE

S/M/L/XL/XXL/3XL/4XL

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 66/68/70/72/72/72/73 cm / 26"/26.75"/27.50"/28.25"/28.25"/28.25"/28.75" Chest: 104/106/116/126/136/144/154 cm - 41"/41.75"/45.75"/49.50"/53.50"/56.75"/60.50"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Fabulous little tunic with a collar detail.

The tunic is knitted flat in two identical parts, front and back, the two collar pieces are then knitted separately and sewn to the dress.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

Dec c/off = (Decrease cast off) K2tog from the back of the loop then slip the stitch back to the left needle, repeat to the end of the row

YO = Place your yarn over the front of your work

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

P2tog = Purl the next two stitches together

K3tog = Knit the next three stitches together

INFO AND TIPS

The tunic is knitted flat in two identical parts, front and back, the two collar pieces are then knitted separately and sewn to the dress.

BODY (make 2)

The tunic sides are knitted from the bottom to the top.

C/on 68/70/76/82/88/94/100 sts

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - Prow

Row 3 - K1, (YO K2tog) repeat to the last stitch, K1

Row 4 - P row

Row 5 - K2, (YO K2tog) repeat to the last 2 sts, K2

Row 6 - P row

Repeat from row 3 to 6 until your piece measure 66/68/70/72/72/72/73 cm / 26"/26.75"/27.50"/28.25"/28.25"/28.25"/28.75" finishing on row 6



NECK

Next row – K1, (YO K2tog) x 10/10/10/11/11/12/12, dec c/off 26/28/34/36/42/44/50, (YO K2tog) x 10/10/11/11/12/12, K1

Work on the last 21/21/23/23/25/25 sts and slide the others on a stitch holder

Next row - P row

Next row - K1, (YO K2tog) x 10/10/10/11/11/12/12

Next row - P row

Next row - K2, (YO K2tog) x 9/9/9/10/10/11/11, K1

Repeat the last 4 rows 3 times

Dec c/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the other sts from the stitch holder

Next row - P row

Next row - K2, (YO K2tog) x 9/9/9/10/10/11/11, K1

Next row - P row

Next row - K1, (YO K2tog) x 10/10/10/11/11/12/12

Repeat the last 4 rows 3 times

Dec c/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

COLLAR (make 2)

C/on 40 sts

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - Prow

Repeat these 2 rows 7 times

Row 17 - K1, (YO K2tog) repeat to the last stitch, K1

Row 18 - Prow

Row 19 - K2, (YO K2tog) repeat to the last 2 sts, K2

Row 20 - P row

Row 21 - (K2, K2tog) x 10 (30 sts)

Row 22 – (P2tog) x 15 (15 sts)

Row 23 – (K3tog) x 5 (5 sts)

C/off all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure



FINISHING UP

Sew the front and back together at the side seam leaving a 25/25/26/26/27/27 cm -9.75''/9.75''/10.25''/10.25''/10.50''/10.50'' gap for the arm holes.

Sew the c/off edges on each side at the shoulder.

Finish by adding both pieces of the collar in the front centre at the c/off neck edge.

Weave in all ends
