## **MATERIALS**

# **Amigo**

1 skein of colour A02 - Yarn A 2 skeins of colour A16 - Yarn B

Circular needle 5 mm (US 8) DPN needle 5 mm (US 8) Stitch marker Darning needle

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Amigo**, Hobbii 100% HB Acrylic 50 g (1.75 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

## **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 20 sts x 28 rows

## **SIZE**

Child size

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Head circumference: 50 cm - 19.75"

Adorable cloud summer hat to wear on a sunny day. Check out the cloud tank top to go with it.

# **Pattern**







## **ABBREVIATIONS**

K = knit

P = purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

SKP = (slip, knit, pass) Slip the first stitch knit wise, knit the second stitch then pass the first stitch over the second one – you have decrease 1 stitch

Kf&b = Knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

## **INFO AND TIPS**

This hat has positive ease and is not supposed to be too tight on the head. It is knitted in the round, from rim to crown and with two strands of yarn all the way (but not the clouds). The clouds are knitted flat individually and are sewn separately in the end.

## **HAT**

## **Brim**

C/on 140 sts with 2 strands of yarn A

(as you have only one ball of yarn A, make a separate small ball to knit the rim)

The hat is knitted in the round, place your st marker at the end and be careful not to twist when working your first round

Round 1 – P round

Round 2 - K round

Change to yarn B and continue working with 2 strands of yarn

Round 3 - P round

Rounds 4 & 5 - K 2 rounds

Round 6 – (K18, SKP) repeat to the end of the round (133 sts)

Rounds 7 to 9 – K 3 rounds

Round 10 – (K17, SKP) repeat to the end of the round (126 sts)



Rounds 11 to 13 - K3 rounds

Round 14 – (K16, SKP) repeat to the end of the round (119 sts)

Rounds 15 to 17 – K 3 rounds

Round 18 – (K15, SKP) repeat to the end of the round (112 sts)

Rounds 19 to 21 - K 3 rounds

Round 22 – (K14, SKP) repeat to the end of the round (105 sts)

Rounds 23 to 25 - K 3 rounds

Round 26 – (K13, SKP) repeat to the end of the round (98 sts)

Rounds 27 to 29 - K 3 rounds

Round 30 – (K12, SKP) repeat to the end of the round (91 sts)

Rounds 31 to 33 - K 3 rounds

### Middle part

Rounds 34 to 43 - K 10 rounds

### Crown

Round 44 – (K11, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (84 sts)

Round 45 - K round

Round 46 – (K10, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (77 sts)

Round 47 – K round

You might start feeling the squeeze on your circular needle, you can now start working on your DPN to finish the crown

Round 48 – (K9, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (70 sts)

Round 49 - K round

Round 50 – (K8, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (63 sts)

Round 51 - K round

Round 52 – (K7, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (56 sts)

Round 53 - K round

Round 54 – (K6, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (49 sts)

Round 55 - K round

Round 56 – (K5, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (42 sts)

Round 57 – K round

Round 58 – (K4, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (35 sts)

Round 59 – K round

Round 60 – (K3, K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (28 sts)

Round 61 - K round

Round 62 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the round (14 sts)

Thread through all 14 sts, cut the yarn and make secure



# CLOUD (make 6)

C/on 20 with yarn A – these are worked flat and with only 1 strand of yarn

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 – C/on 1, K until the last st, Kf&b (22 sts)

Rows 3 & 4 – K 2 rows

Row 5 - SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (20 sts)

Rows 6 & 7 - K 2 rows

Row 8 - SKP, K13 TURN YOUR WORK

Row 9 - K10

Continue on those 10 sts only

Row 10 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (8 sts)

Rows 11 to 14 - K 4 rows

Row 15 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (6 sts)

Rows 16 & 17 - K 2 rows

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the group of 5 sts

Next row - K3, K2tog (4 sts)

Next row – SKP, K2 (3 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the group of 4 sts

Next row - SKP, K2tog (2 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## **FINISHING UP**

Add each cloud to the hat as per the pictures or wherever you feel like it.

Weave in all ends
