## Ladybug <br> String Bag

Design: Au Bout du Pré | Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Amigo XL colour A56 - Yarn A
2 skeins of Amigo XL colour A04 - Yarn B

Circular needles 5 mm (US 8)
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

## (64) Amigo XL, Hobbii

100\% HB Acrylic
$50 \mathrm{~g}(1.75 \mathrm{oz})=100 \mathrm{~m}(109 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=19$ sts $\times 25$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

$K=K n i t$
P = Purl
St(s) = Stitch(es)
C/on = Cast on
C/off = Cast off
K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together SKP = (Slip, Knit, Pass) Slip the first stitch, knit the second and then pass the first one over the second stitch
M1 = Make one stitch using the left needle and pick up the yarn before the next stitch from the front and knit it into the back $K f \& b=$ knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Height: $29 \mathrm{~cm}-11.50^{\prime \prime}$
Width: $27 \mathrm{~cm}-10.75^{\prime \prime}$

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Adorable string bag, fun and functional. Great project to brighten your day. The main parts of the bag are knitted separately and flat with some intarsia colorwork on the front. The strings are knitted as Icord and added to the bag at the end.

## INFO AND TIPS

The front of the ladybug is knitted flat with intarsia technique from row 27. You will be working with multiple skeins at a time, to create the motif.

The key to working intarsia is to interlock the yarns when it's time to change from one color to the next. At each color change, the old color is brought over the new color. Then, the new color is picked up from under the old color and worked from there. Overlapping the yarns catches the old color as the two strands "link elbows" and prevents a gap at the color change.

## FRONT

C/on 32 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - K row
Row 2 - P row
Repeat the first 2 rows 4 more times

Row 11 - K1, M1, K up to the last st, M1, K1 (34 sts)
Row 12 - P row
Repeat the last 2 rows 7 more times ( 48 sts )

You are now going to add the second colour, you will be told which yarn to use each time.
Start your second skein of yarn B for the last section.

Row 27 - K1A, M1A, K22A, K2B, K22A, M1A, K1A (50 sts)
Row 28 - P24A, P2B, P24A
Row 29 - K1A, M1A, K22A, K4B, K22A, M1A, K1A (52 sts)
Row 30 - P24A, P4B, P24A

Row 31 - K23A, K6B, K23A
Row 32 - P23A, P6B, P23A
Row 33 - K22A, K8B, K22A

Row 34 - P22A, P8B, P22A
Row 35 - K21A, K10B, K21A
Row 36 - P21A, P10B, P21A
Row 37 - K20A, K12B, K20A
Row 38 - P20A, P12B, P20A
Row 39 - K19A, K14B, K19A
Row 40 - P19A, P14B, P19A
Row 41 - K18A, K16B, K18A
Row 42 - P18A, P16B, P18A
Row 43 - K17A, K18B, K17A
Row 44 - P17A, P18B, P17A
Row 45 - K16A, K20B, K16A
Row 46 - P16A, P20B, P16A
Row 47 - K15A, K22B, K15A
Row 48 - P15A, P22B, P15A
Row 49 - K14A, K24B, K14A
Row 50 - P14A, P24B, P14A
Row 51 - K13A, K26B, K13A
Row 52 - P13A, P26B, P13A
Row 53 - K12A, K28B, K12A
Row 54 - P12A, P28B, P12A
Row 55 - K11A, K30B, K11A
Row 56 - P11A, P30B, P11A
Row 57 - K10A, K32B, K10A
Row 58 - P10A, P32B, P10A
Row 59 - K9A, K34B, K9A
Row 60 - P9A, P34B, P9A
Row 61 - K8A, K36B, K8A
Row 62 - P8A, P36B, P8A

Row 63 - SKP A, K5A, K38B, K5A, K2togA (50 sts)
Row 64 - P6A, P38B, P6A
Row 65 - SKP A, K3A, K40B, K3A, K2togA (48 sts)
Row 66 - P4A, P40B, P4A
Row 67 - SKP A, K1A, K42B, K1A, K2togA (46 sts)
Row 68 - P2A, P42B, P2A
Row 69 - SKP A, K42B, K2togA (44 sts)
Row 70 - P1A, P42B, P1A

Continue with yarn B only until the end of the front piece

Row 71 - SKP, K up to the last 2 sts, K2tog (42 sts)
Row 72 - P row
Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times ( 36 sts )

Row 79 - SKP, K up to the last 2 sts, K2tog (34 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## BACK

C/on 32 sts with yarn B

Row 1 - K row
Row 2 - P row
Repeat the first 2 rows 4 more times

Row 11 - K1, M1, K up to the last st, M1, K1 (34 sts)
Row 12 - P row
Repeat the last 2 rows 9 more times ( 52 sts )

Row 31 - K row
Row 32 - P row
Repeat the last 2 rows 15 more times

Row 63 - SKP, K up to the last 2 sts, K2tog ( 50 sts)
Row 64 - P row
Repeat the last 2 rows 7 more times ( 36 sts)

Row 79 - SKP, K up to the last 2 sts, K2tog (34 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## SPOT (make 10)

C/on 3 sts with yarn B

Row 1 - Kf\&b, K1, Kf\&b (5 sts)
Row 2 - Prow
Row 3 - K row
Row 4 - P row
Row 5 - SKP, K1, K2tog (3 sts)
Row 6 - P row

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## STRING (Make 2)

C/on 4 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - K row, slide all your sts back on the left needle
Repeat row 1 until your Icord measure 110 cm - 43.25"

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

If you are working this Icord with DPN just slide the sts on the other side of the same needle

## FINISHING UP

Sew the front and back together but leave the top $4 \mathrm{~cm}-1.50^{\prime \prime}$ on each side.
Now turn the top $4 \mathrm{~cm}-1.50^{\prime \prime}$ on itself on the inside and sew along the edge and repeat on the other side. These create gaps for the strings.

Add the spots and sew them around the front of the bag as per the pictures.

Slide one string through the top gap then back on itself through the second gap. Repeat with the other string but in the opposite direction. Sew both ends of the strings on each side at the bottom of the bag.

Weave in all ends
