MATERIALS

Portobello

- (A) 3 skeins of color 17 Cognac
- (B) 3 skeins of color 10 Cappuccino
- (C) 3 skeins of color 116 Hunter Green
- (D) 3 skeins of color 20 Americano

Crochet hook 6 mm / US J/10

Scissors
Yarn Needle
Blocking Mats

YARN QUALITY

 **Portobello**, Hobbii

60 % Cotton, 28 % Acrylic, 12 % Wool
50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

GAUGE

12 sts x 9.5 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm /
4" x 4" (blocked)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
Chsp = chain space
Fc = forked clusters
Dc = double crochet
Rep = repeat
Sc = single crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)
Yo = yarn over
Fpdc = front post double crochet
Bpdc = back post double crochet

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 254 cm / 100"
Length: 59 cm / 23"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This large and comfy shawl will keep you warm in winter time and is also perfect as a wrap for a chilly spring day. There are no RS or WS, so this shawl can be worn on either side. It has an interesting structure and beautiful stripes.

INFO AND TIPS

There are no right side or wrong side, so this shawl can be worn on either side. When color changing you will cut your yarn and attach the next colour.

Ch1 does not count as a sc.

Ch3 counts as a dc.

Everything in () is completed in 1 st.

All increases are at the beginning and end of your shawl.

Sc rows increase by 7 sts.

Fc rows increase by 4 sts.

Fpdc and Bpdc increase by 6 sts.

When working the FC stitch, you will work in the same stitch you just made and then the next stitch.

Gauge swatch

Ch 18

Row 1: sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 2: Ch3, fc in the same st, fc in each st across, dc in last st, turn.

Row 3: Ch1, sc in same st, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 4-11: repeat rows 2 & 3.

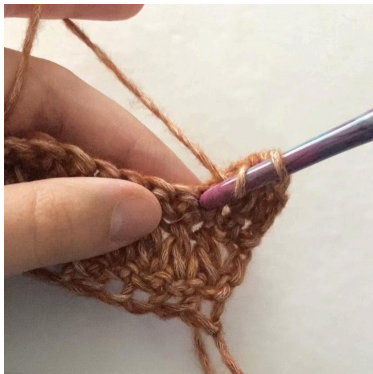
Special stitches

Forked cluster: Yo, insert hook into the same st you just worked, Yo, pull up a loop, now you have 3 loops on your hook, Yo, insert your hook into the next st, Yo, pull up a loop, now you have 5 loops on your hook, yo, pull the yarn through the first 3 loops on your hook, Yo, pull yarn through all 3 loops on your hook. (see photos below)

Front post double crochet: Yo, insert hook from front around the back of the dc, Yo, pull through, (3 loops on your hook), Yo, pull through 2, Yo, pull through 2 again.

Back post double crochet: Yo, insert hook from back around the front of the dc, Yo, pull through, (3 loops on your hook), Yo, pull through 2, Yo, pull through 2 again.

How to make a forked cluster



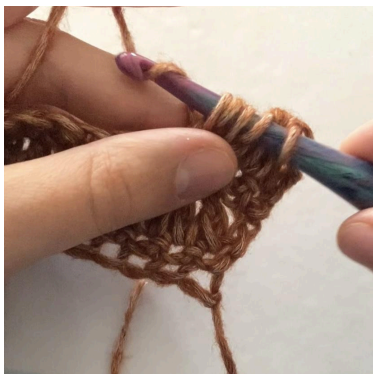
1. Yo, insert hook into the previous stitch you just made



2. (3 loops on your hook), Yo



3. Insert hook into the next stitch



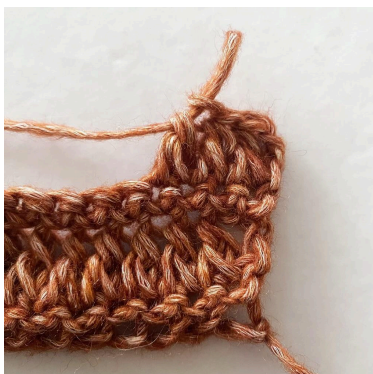
4. (5 loops on your hook), Yo



5. Pull through 3 loops, Yo

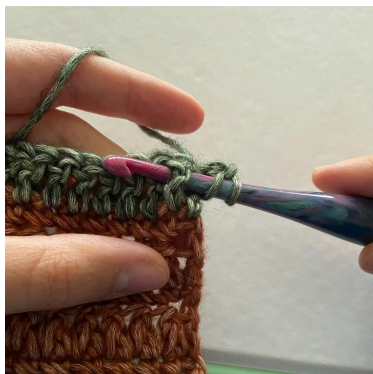


6. Pull through the next 3 loops



7. You finished a forked cluster!

How to make Fpdc stitches



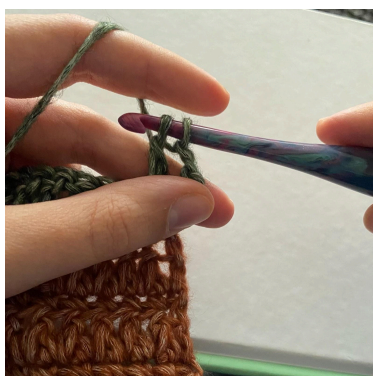
1. Yo, insert hook around the back of the dc



2. Yo, pull through



3. (3 loops on your hook), Yo



4. Pull through 2, Yo, pull through 2 again



5. You made a Fpdc!

How to make Bpdc stitches



1. Yo, insert hook around the front of the dc.

SHAWL

Color A

Ch. 9

Row 1: sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc in each st across, turn. (8)

Row 2: Ch3 (counts as a dc) (3dc, fc) in the same st, fc in each st across, (fc, 4dc) in the last st, turn. (15)

Row 3: Ch1 (does not count as a sc), 3sc in same st, sc in each st across, 3sc in the last st, turn. (19)

Row 4: Repeat row 2 (26)

Row 5: Repeat row 3 (30)

Row 6: Repeat row 2 (37)

Row 7: Repeat row 3 (41)

Row 8: Repeat row 2 (48)

Color B

Row 9: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, dc in each st across, 4dc in the last st, turn. (54)

Row 10: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Fpdc around the next dc, Bpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (60)

Row 11: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Bpdc around the next dc, Fpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last, turn. (66)

Row 12: Repeat row 10 (72)

Row 13: Repeat row 11 (78)

Color C

Row 14: Ch1, 3sc in the same st, sc in each st across, 3sc in the last st, turn. (82)

Row 15: Ch3, (3dc, fc) in the same st, fc in each st across, (fc, 4dc) in the last st, turn. (89)

Row 16: Repeat row 14 (93)

Row 17: Repeat row 15 (100)

Row 18: Repeat row 14 (104)

Row 19: Repeat row 15 (111)

Row 20: Repeat row 14 (115)

Row 21: Repeat row 15 (122)

Color D

Row 22: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, dc in each st across, 4dc in the last st, turn. (128)

Row 23: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Fpdc around the next dc, Bpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (134)

Row 24: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Bpdc around the next dc, Fpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (140)

Row 25: Repeat row 23. (146)

Row 26: Repeat row 24. (152)

Color A

Row 27: Ch1, 3sc in the same st, sc in each st across, 3sc in the last st, turn. (156)

Row 28: Ch3, (3dc, fc) in the same st, fc in each st across, (fc, 4dc) in the last st, turn. (163)

Row 29: Repeat row 27. (167)

Row 30: Repeat row 28. (174)

Row 31: Repeat row 27. (178)

Row 32: Repeat row 28. (185)

Row 33: Repeat row 27. (189)

Row 34: Repeat row 28. (196)

Color B

Row 35: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, dc in each st across, 4dc in the last st, turn. (202)

Row 36: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Fpdc around the next dc, Bpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (208)

Row 37: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Bpdc around the next dc, Fpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (214)

Row 38: Repeat row 36 (220)

Row 39: Repeat row 37 (226)

Color C

Row 40: Ch1, 3sc in the same st, sc in each st across, 3sc in the last st, turn. (230)

Row 41: Ch3, (3dc, fc) in the same st, fc in each st across, (fc, 4dc) in the last st, turn. (237)

Row 42: Repeat row 40 (241)

Row 43: Repeat row 41 (248)

Row 44: Repeat row 40 (252)

Row 45: Repeat row 41 (259)

Row 46: Repeat row 40 (263)

Row 47: Repeat row 41 (270)

Color D

Row 48: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, dc in each st across, 4dc in the last st, turn. (276)

Row 49: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Fpdc around the next dc, Bpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (282)

Row 50: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Bpdc around the next dc, Fpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (288)

Row 51: Repeat row 49. (294)

Row 52: Repeat row 50. (300)

Color A

Row 53: Ch1, 3sc in the same st, sc in each st across, 3sc in the last st, turn. (304)

Row 54: Ch3, (3dc, fc) in the same st, fc in each st across, (fc, 4dc) in the last st, turn. (311)

Color B

Row 55: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, dc in each st across, 4dc in last st, turn. (317)

Row 56: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Bpdc around the next dc, Fpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (323)

Color D

Row 57: Ch3, 3dc in the same st, *Bpdc around the next dc, Fpdc around the next dc; rep from * until the last st remains, 4dc in the last st, turn. (329)

Row 58: Repeat row 56 (335)

Color B

Row 59: Repeat row 57 (341)

Row 60: Repeat row 56 (347)

FINISHING

Weave in your ends.

Wet block your shawl to the final dimensions.
