

## CROCHET PATTERN

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\underset{\text { Applique }}{\text { BoUQUEt }}
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## MATERIALS

1 ball of Rainbow Lace in each color:
61, 67, 53, 75, 58
Crochet hooks 1.5 mm (US 8)
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

(0) Rainbow Lace, Hobbii

100 \% Mercerised Cotton $50 \mathrm{~g}(1.75 \mathrm{oz})=280 \mathrm{~m}$ (306 yds)

## ABBREVIATIONS

SI st = slip stitch
ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
Puff st = (yo, insert into st, pull up a loop)
$5 x$ yo, pull through all loops on hook

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx. measurements
Flower A: $2 \times 2 \mathrm{~cm} / 0.75^{\prime \prime} \times 0.75^{\prime \prime}$
Flower B: $2.5 \times 2.5 \mathrm{~cm} / 1^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{\prime \prime}$
Flower C: $4.5 \times 4.5 \mathrm{~cm} / 1.75^{\prime \prime} \times 1.75^{\prime \prime}$
Flower D: $5 \times 5 \mathrm{~cm} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
Flower E: $7.5 \times 7.5 \mathrm{~cm} / 3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern contains 5 small crochet flowers. Use the flowers to spice up garments by simply sewing them on wherever you think they fit, e.g a childrens sweater or a suit jacket. Use them as they are or make small bouquets by placing them on top of each other. There are many possibilities to play around.

## FLOWER A



Make as many as you like in your preferred colors.
Using a 1.5 mm /US 8 hook, ch 5 , join in a loop with a sl st in the 5 th ch from hook.
Round 1: *(ch 3, 2 dc , ch 3 sl st into loop)REPEAT from * 4 more times
(5 petals)
Cut yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing on.

## FLOWER B



Make as many as you like in your preferred colors.
Using a 1.5 mm / US 8 hook, ch 6 , join in a loop with a sl st in the 6 th ch from hook

Round 1: ch 1, work 12 sc into loop, sl st in ch 1.
(12 sc)
Round 2: *[ch 3, in next st work a puff st, ch 3, sl st in next st]REPEAT from * 5 more times to end.
(6 petals)
Cut yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing

## FLOWER C



Make as many as you like in your preferred colors.
Using a $1.5 \mathrm{~mm} /$ US 8 hook, ch 5 , join in a loop with a sl st in the 5th ch from the hook.
Ch 1(does not count as st), work 10 sc in loop, sl st into 1st sc.
(5 petals)
Round 1: ch 1, sc is same st,*ch 10, sl st in next st**, sc in next st, REPEAT from * ending last repeat at ** then, sl st in ch 1.
(5 petals)
Round 2: sl st, ch 1, *in ch 10 space in it work, (sc, $13 \mathrm{hdc}, \mathrm{sc}$ ), sl st into space between the 2 petals, REPEAT from * to end (5 petals)
Cut yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing

## FLOWER D



Make as many as you like in your preferred colors.
With $1.5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} 8$ hook ch 6, join in a loop with a sl st in the 6th ch from hook.

Round 1: ch 4(counts as sc and ch 3), sc in loop, (ch 3, sc in loop)6 times total, ch 3, sl st in top of ch 1.
(8 ch 3 spaces)
Round 2: sl st into 1 st ch 3 space in it work (ch 3, dc, ch 3, sl st), *sl st into next ch 3 space in it work (ch 3, dc, ch 3, sl st)**, REPEAT from * around ending last repeat at**
(8 petals)
For Round 3 you will be working in front of Round 2 petals and sl st into center space of 2 petals.
Round 3: *(ch 3, move across next petal, sl st in space between), REPEAT from *around to end then, sl st in ch 1 of ch 3
Round 4: sl st into 1 st ch 3 space, *in it work (ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3 , sl st**), sl st into next ch 3 space, REPEAT from * around ending last repeat at **
(8 petals)
For Round 5 you will be working in front of Round 4 petals and sl st into center space of 2 petals.
Round 5: *(ch 5, move across next petal, sl st into space between), REPEAT from *around to end then, sl st in ch 1 of ch 5
Round 6: sl st in ch 5 space, *in it work (ch 3, in ch 5 space work 5 dc, ch 3) sl st into next ch 5 space**, REPEAT from * around ending last repeat at **
(8 petals)
Cut yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing

## FLOWER E



Make as many as you like in your preferred colors.

Using a $1.5 \mathrm{~mm} /$ US 8 hook, ch 5 , join in a loop with a sl st in the 5th ch from hook.
Round 1: ch 4(counts as dc and ch 1), [dc, ch 1] 11x into the loop, ch 1 sl st into 3rd ch in bor.
( 12 ch 1 spaces)
Round 2: sl st into the 1st ch 1 space, ch 5(counts as dc and ch 2), skip over dc, dc into next ch 1 space, [ch 2, skip over dc, dc into next ch 1 space]10x, ch 2 sl st into 3rd ch in bor.
Round 3: [ch 3, puff into ch 2 space, ch 3, sl st on top of next dc] 12 x , sl st into ch 1 of bor. (12 puffs)
Round 4: [ch 9, skip over puff, sl st into st between petals of previous round]12x, sl st into ch 1 of bor
Round 5: sl st into ch 9 space, ch 1, *(work 2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc), REPEAT from * in each st to end, sl st in bor.
(12 petals)
Cut yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing
