DESIGN

YARN

PUS 70 % baby alpaca, 17 % acrylic, 13 % polyamide,
50 grams = approx. 100 metres

SIZES

2 (4) 6 (8) 10 (12) years

NOTE! See MEASUREMENTS to find the right size

MEASUREMENTS

Upper body approx. 62 (63) 68 (73) 80 (87) cm

Full length approx. 39 (44) 49 (53) 57 (63) cm

Sleeves approx. 24 (27) 33 (36) 38 (40) cm

YARN REQUIREMENTS

3 (4) 4 (5) 6 (8) balls

COLOUR

Turquoise 4057

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

7 mm and 9 mm long and short circular needles and DPNs

GAUGE

12 sts x 15 R on 9 mm needles = 10 x 10 cm

Check your gauge by working a swatch.

Count the number of sts per 10 cm. If you have more sts than suggested, change to a larger needle size. If you have fewer sts change to a smaller needle size.

FIND THE RIGHT SIZE

1. Measure a knitted garment that fits.
2. Compare your measurements with those in the pattern.
3. Select a size based on the upper body measurements.
4. Body and sleeves may be worked longer or shorter as needed.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit, p = purl, st = stitch, R = round/row,

DPN = double pointed needles, K2tog = knit 2 together,

m = marker, PM = place marker, RS/WS = right/wrong side

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BODY

Cast on 64 (68) 72 (76) 84 (92) sts on 7 mm circular needles. Work rib in the round (K2, P2) for 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) cm. Change to 9 mm needles and work stocking st, **while at the same time** on R 1 increasing 10 (8) 10 (12) 12 (12) sts evenly spaced = 74 (76) 82 (88) 96 (104) sts. PM in each side with 37 (38) 41 (44) 48 (52) sts for both the front and back pieces. Work until the piece measures 24 (27) 30 (33) 36 (39) cm **while at the same time** on the last R, casting off 6 (6) 6 (8) 10 (10) sts on each side for armholes (= 3 (3) 3 (4) 5 (5) sts on each side of each m) = 31 (32) 35 (36) 38 (42) sts on front and back pieces. Leave sts on needle and work the sleeves.

SLEEVES

Cast on 16 (20) 20 (24) 24 (28) sts on 7 mm needles. Work rib in the round (K2, P2) for 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) cm. Change to 9 mm needles and work stocking st **while at the same time** on R 1, increasing 5 (3) 6 (4) 6 (5) sts evenly spaced = 21 (23) 26 (28) 30 (33) sts.



PM around the first and last sts on R (= underarm m sts). When the sleeve measures 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) cm increase 1 st on each side of m sts. Repeat the increases every 4.5 (5.5) 6.5 (7.5) 7.5 8 cm, 3 more times = 29 (31) 34 (36) 38 (41) sts. Work until the piece measures 24 (27) 33 (36) 38 (40) cm **while at the same time** on the last R, casting off 6 (6) 6 (8) 10 (10) underarm sts (= m sts + 2 (2) 2 (3) 4 (4) sts on each side) = 23 (25) 28 (28) 28 (31) sts. Leave sts on the needle and work the other sleeve.

YOKE

Place the left sleeve, front piece, right sleeve, and back piece on 9 mm circular needles = 108 (114) 126 (128) 132 (146) sts. PM around 2 sts in each join (= 1 st from sleeve and 1 st from front or back piece) = m sts. Always P m sts (later when you're working flat, K m sts on WS), and work all other sts in stocking st. Work 1 (2) 2 (2) 2 (2) rounds. Decrease for raglan on next R. After m sts: K2 tog. Before m sts: slip 1 st knitwise, K1, pass slipped st over = 8 sts decreased on R. Repeat the raglan decreases on every 3rd R a further 0 (2) 0 (2) 4 (6) times, then on every 2nd R a further 9 (7) 11 (9) 7 (5) times

= 10 (10) 12 (12) 12 (12) raglan decreases on back piece.

At the same time when working the 6th (6th) 8th (8th) 8th (8th) raglan decrease, cast off the middle 5 (6) 7 (6) 8 (10) sts on the front piece for the neckline. Work to end of R. Cut yarn. You will now work flat. P across 1 R from the WS (R begins by the neck). Continue casting off for the neckline at the beginning of every R: 2,1,4,4 (2,1,5,5) 2,1,5,4 (2,1,5,4) 2,1,8,5 (2,1,8,5) sts on each side. **At the same time**, continue working raglan decreases on every 2nd R.

NOTE! The neckline decreases run across the raglan decreases in front. Leave sts on the needle.

NECKLINE

Using 7 mm short circular needles, pick up approx. 7 sts per 5 cm around the neckline. Place back-piece sts on the same needles. Your st count must be divisible by 4. Work rib in the round (K2, P2) for 6 (6) 7 (7) 8 (8) cm. Cast off loosely. Fold the neck double to the WS and fasten with loose sts.

ASSEMBLY

Join the underarm seams.
