Size:

Hat: Head Circumference approx.
54 - 58 cm

Scarf: Width: approx. 30 cm,
Length: approx. 200 cm

Usage:

Hat: approx. 100 g in col. 16
(orange)

Scarf: approx. 500 g in col. 15
(mustard), for the fringe: approx.
50 g each in col. 17 (leaf green)
and col. 09 (fuchsia)

Tension:

30 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm over ribbing
22 sts and 48 rows to 10 cm over brioche patt
for the hat
20 sts and 46 rows to 10 cm over brioche patt
for the scarf

Stitch Pattern:

Scarf:

Brioche with double selvedge sts: (amount of sts
multiple of 2 + 1 M + 4 selvedge sts)

Row 1 (= WS row): 2 selvedge sts, *k1, sl1yo, rep
from * and end row with k1, 2 selvedge sts.

Row 2: (= RS row): 2 selvedge sts, * sl1yo, brk1, rep
from * and end row with sl1yo, 2 selvedge sts.

Row 3: 2 selvedge sts, * brk1, sl1yo, rep from *
and end row with brk1, 2 selvedge sts.

These rows establish the pattern. Rep rows 2 -3
throughout.

Double selvedge sts (= 2 selvedge sts):

k2 at beg of row pulling the yarn snug to make
sure the first st isn't too loose and to create
even sts and sl 2 p-wise wyif at end of row

Hat:

Ribbing: (amount of sts multiple of 2 + 2 selved-
ge sts)

alt k1, p1 between the selvedge sts.

Brioche pattern: (amount of sts multiple of 2 + 2
selvedge sts)

Row 1: 1 selvedge st, *k1, sl1yo, rep from * to end
then 1 selvedge st.

Row 2: 1 selvedge st, * brk1, sl1yo, rep from * to
end then 1 selvedge st.

These rows establish the pattern. Repeat row 2
throughout.

Slipped Selvedge Stitches:

At beg of row work first st k1tbl and end of row
sl1 p-wise wyif.

Instructions:**Hat:**

The hat is worked flat in rows.

Cast on 104 sts (including 2 selvedge sts) and beg with a WS row work 15 cm (= 45 rows) in ribbing patt. Next row (RS): knit all sts and dec 20 st evenly across row (= after the selvedge st work every 4th and 5th st as k2tog) (= 84 sts). Then cont in brioche st patt. When work meas 18 cm (= 86 rows) from beg of brioche st, finish the hat in rib patt and make decs as follows: Place markers at the 8th st (including the selvedge st in the count) and at every foll 14th st. Then work the st before the marker the marked st and the st after the marker as p3tog (= 72 sts). Cont these decs over the markers once after 4 rows and then in every foll alt row 3 times, working the decs into the established patt as either k3tog or p3tog (= 24 sts). Next row (RS): k2tog to end of row (= 12 sts). Cut yarn with tail and thread through the rem 12 sts. Pull gently to close the top of the hat. Use the mattress st for the back seam. To do so, place the edges to be joined together flat next to each other with the right sides facing. Use a blunt needle and alt sts between pieces inserting the needle under the horizontal bar between the selvedge st and the 2nd st. Then into the corresponding bar on the other piece. Cont alt from side to side and after a few cm of work, tug the thread firmly to close the seam but be careful not to make the seam too tight. The selvedge sts disappear to the inside and you will have a clean, almost invisible seam. Make sure to make the seam along the bottom cuff of the hat on the outside. Fold cuff back twice and if needed make a few sts to attach cuff the the back seam. Weave in ends.

Scarf:

Cast on 63 sts (including 4 selvedge sts) and beg with a WS row work for 200 cm in brioche patt with double selvedge sts ending with a WS row. Next row: cast off all sts even working the selvedge sts as k2tog and brk1 the sl1yo and purl the p sts. Knot fringe in fuchsia onto one end of the shawl and in leaf green on the other end. For each bundle of fringe cut 10 lengths of yarn 40 cm long, fold in half and knot onto cast-on (or cast-off) edge.
