

Instructions SCANDINAVIA Ribbed Hat

Difficulty:



Quality: Scandinavia from Gründl 70 % polyacrylic, 30 % virgin wool 100 g / 160 m

Size: Head circumference approx. 54 cm – 57 cm Usage: approx. 100 g

Tension:

26 sts and 28 rnds to 10 cm meas over ribbing patt 1 and 2

Stitch Pattern:

<u>Ribbing pattern 1 in rnds:</u> (for cuff) (amount of sts multiple of 4 and multiple of 5) Alt k1, p3 throughout. <u>Ribbing pattern 2 in rnds:</u> (amount of sts multiple of 4 and multiple of 5) Alt p1, k3 throughout.

Instructions:

Cast on 100 sts and divide evenly amongst 4 dpns (= 4 × 25 sts). Close the rnd being careful not to twist the sts. Work 9 cm (= 25 rnds) in ribbing pattern 1. Then knit 1 rnd (turning ridge). Then cont in ribbing pattern 2 over next 16 cm (= 45 rnds) then work decs for the top of the cap. Place markers at the 2nd, 3rd and 4th sts and then 4 times at each of the foll 18th, 19th and 20th sts (= 5 decs with each 3 stockinette knit sts). Work both sts before and after the markings p2tog (= 90 sts). Work the decs in this manner 2 times more in every foll 3rd rnd and then 4 times in every foll 2nd rnd (= 30 sts). Work the sts over the decs in the foll rnd as p1 and rem sts in patt as established. In the last rnd k2tog to end of rnd (= 15 sts). Cut yarn with tail and thread yarn through these last 15 sts. Pull yarn firmly to close hole. Weave in ends. Fold cuff up along the folding line.
