Fusing Cardigan

Open Cardi with Tie Belt

Materials

Hobbii Happy Place Solid

Yarn A: 36 Foggy, 6 (7, 9, 9, 10, 11, 11, 13, 13,

15) skeins

Yarn B: 06 Ochre; 1 skein Yarn C: 12 Blossom; 1 skein

Yarn D: 20 Blueberry; 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 2)

skeins

Yarn E: 22 Petrol; 1 skein

4mm / US 6 circular needles, 80-100cm / 32-40" length

3.5mm / US E / UK 9 crochet hook
Always use a needle size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

Stitch markers (10), scrap yarn, tapestry needle

Yarn Quality

Happy Place Solid, Hobbii Light Worsted, DK 50% Cotton, 50% Wool 100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

Gauge

25 sts & 30 rows = 10cm / 4" over 2x2 Rib on 4mm / US 6 needles after blocking

Measurements

Finished Chest (Fullest Point)

Circumference:

93.5 (108, 124, 127, 132, 146.5, 151, 164, 169, 180)cm / 36¾ (42½, 48¾, 50, 52, 57¾, 59½, 64½, 66½, 70¾)"

– to be worn with up to 15cm / 6" positive ease

Model's height is 170 cm / 5'7" with a chest (fullest point) circumference of 86.5 cm / 38" and is wearing a size 1.

Pattern Information

Colourwork is worked using the Mosaic technique. The Mosaic technique uses 1 strand of yarn on each row, with alternate sts slipped. Each row is worked twice by sliding the sts across the circular needle to work a second row in the same direction.

Note: The yarn to be used for each row is indicated in the row label, e.g. "Row 1 (WS)

indicated in the row label, e.g. "Row 1 (WS, B)" is a WS row worked with yarn B.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg: beginning

dec(s): decrease/s/d/ing
inc(s): increase/s/d/ing

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

M1L: Make 1 Left; pick up strand between the two needles from the front to back with the tip of left needle, knit into the back of this stitch

M1R: Make 1 Right; pick up strand between the two needles from back to front with the tip of left needle, knit into the front of this stitch

M1LP: Make 1 Left Purlwise; pick up strand between the two needles from the front to back with the tip of left needle, purl into the back of this stitch

M1RP: Make 1 Right Purlwise; pick up strand between the two needles from back to front with the tip of left needle, purl into the front of this stitch

LH: left-hand (eg. LH needle) **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

patt: pattern

PM: place marker

p: purl

rep: repeat

RH: right-hand (eg. RH needle)

RS: right side of fabric

sl: slip

SM: slip marker

ssk: Slip 2 stitches knitwise one at a time, knit them together through back loop

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side of fabricwyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front



CO: Cast onch: chain

STITCH GLOSSARY

TSK (twin stitches knitwise): Wyib, insert RH needle from back to front through the right leg of the stitch below the next stitch on the LH needle and lift it onto the LH needle. Knit this new stitch and slip it back to the LH needle. 2 loops from 1 st = Twin stitch = TS

TSP (twin stitches purlwise): Wyif, sl1 purlwise to RH needle, with LH needle, pick up the purl bump of the stitch below the slipped stitch. Purl this lifted stitch and slip both stitches from RH needle back to LH needle. 2 loops from 1 st = Twin stitch = TS

2x2 Rib (worked flat, multiple of 4 + 2 sts)

Row 1 (RS): [P2, k2] rep to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 2 (WS): [K2, p2] rep to last 2 sts, k2.

Rep rows 1-2 for patt.

2x2 Rib (worked in the round, multiple of 4 sts)

Round 1: [P2, k2] to end.

Rep round 1 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

YOKE

With one strand of Yarn A, 4mm / US 6 circular needles and using the Knitted CO method, CO 98 (110, 126, 134, 146, 158, 170, 178, 190, 194) sts.

Set-up row (RS): P2, PM, [k2, p2] twice, PM, k2, PM, [p2, k2] 4 times, p2, PM, k2, PM, [p2, k2] 8 (11, 15, 17, 20, 23, 26, 28, 31, 32) times, p2, PM, k2, PM, [p2, k2] 4 times, p2, PM, k2, PM, [p2, k2] twice, PM, p2.

Next row (WS): Work sts as they appear in 2x2 Rib.

SHORT ROW SHAPING

Note: While working short rows, work TSK for knit sts and TSP for purl sts.

Set-up row (RS): P2, SM, [work in patt to next marker, SM, k2, SM] twice, work to 6 (8, 10, 10, 10, 10, 10, 10, 10, 10) sts before next marker, TS, turn.

Next row (WS): Work in patt to 6 (8, 10, 10, 10, 10, 10, 10, 10) sts before next marker, TS, turn.

Short row 1 (RS): Work in patt to 5 sts before previous TS, TS, turn.

Short row 2 (WS): Work in patt to 5 sts before previous TS, TS, turn.

Rep Short rows 1-2 a further 1 (2, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5] times.

Row 1 (RS): Work in patt to end, resolve all TS by k2tog or p2tog.

Row 2 (WS): Work in patt to end, resolve all TS by k2tog or p2tog.



RAGLAN INCREASES

Row 1 (RS)(inc): P2, SM, M1LP, k2, [work in patt to next marker, M1R, SM, k2, SM, M1L] 4 times, work in patt to last 2 sts, M1RP, SM, p2. *10 sts inc*

Row 2 (WS and all even rows): Work sts as they appear.

Row 3 (RS)(inc): P2, SM, M1LP, p1, k2, [work in patt to 1 st before next marker, k1, M1R, SM, k2, SM, M1L, k1] 4 times, work in patt to last 3 sts, p1, M1RP, SM, p2. 10 sts inc

Row 5 (inc): P2, SM, M1L, [work in patt to next marker, M1RP, SM, k2, SM, M1LP, k2] 4 times, work in patt to last 4 sts, p2, M1R, SM, p2. *10 sts inc*

Row 7 (inc): P2, SM, M1L, k1, [work in patt to 1 st before next marker, p1, M1RP, SM, k2, SM, M1LP, p1] 4 times, work in patt to last 3 sts, k1, M1R, SM, p2. 10 sts inc

Row 8 (WS): Work sts as they appear.

138 (150, 166, 174, 186, 198, 210, 218, 230, 234) total sts: 18 sts on each Front, 26 sts on each Sleeve, 42 (54, 70, 78, 90, 102, 114, 122, 134, 138) Back sts, 8 raglan sts

Rep rows 1-8 a further 6 (7, 8, 8, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11) times.

378 (430, 486, 494, 506, 558, 570, 618, 630, 674) total sts: 66 (74, 82, 82, 82, 90, 90, 98, 98, 106) sts on each Front, 74 (82, 90, 90, 90, 98, 98, 106, 106, 114) sts on each Sleeve, 90 (110, 134, 142, 154, 174, 186, 202, 214, 226) Back sts, 8 raglan sts

DIVIDE BODY AND SLEEVES

Next row (RS): P2, remove marker, work in patt to next marker, remove marker, k2, **remove marker, place next 76 (84, 92, 92, 92, 100, 100, 108, 108, 116) sts on hold for sleeve, PM, using the Backwards loop method, CO 4 sts for underarm, PM**, work in patt over 90 (110, 134, 142, 154, 174, 186, 202, 214, 226) sts Back sts, rep from ** to ** once, work in patt to last 2 sts removing markers, p2. 234 (270, 310, 318, 330, 366, 378, 410, 422, 450) sts

BODY

Next row (WS): Work in patt to end, working underarm sts as k2, p2.

Continue in ribbing patt until Body measures 15cm / 6" from underarm, ending with a WS row.

Colorwork Section

Note: The yarn to be used for each row is indicated in the row label, e.g. "Row 1 (WS, B)" is a WS row worked with yarn B.

Section 1

Join Yarn B.

Row 1 (RS, B): [P2, sl2 wyib] to last 2 sts, p2. Do not turn; slide sts to other end of needle.

Row 2 (RS, A): [SI2 wyib, k2] to last 2 sts, sI2 wyib. Turn.



Row 3 (WS, B): [K2, sl2 wyif] to last 2 sts, k2. Slide sts.

Row 4 (WS, A): [SI2 wyif, p2] to last 2 sts, sI2 wyif. Turn.

Rep rows 1-4 a further 4 times or until Section 1 measures 4cm / $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", ending on a WS row. Break yarn B and work 4 rows in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 2

Join Yarn C.

Row 1 (RS, C): [SI2 wyib, k2] to last 2 sts, sI2 wyib. Slide sts.

Row 2 (RS, A): [P2, sl2 wyib] to last 2 sts, p2. Turn.

Row 3 (WS, C): [SI2 wyif, p2] to last 2 sts, sI2 wyif. Slide sts.

Row 4 (WS, A): [K2, sl2 wyif] to last 2 sts, k2. Turn.

Rep rows 1-4 a further 2 times or until Section 2 measures 2.5cm / 1", ending on a WS row. Break Yarn C and work 4 rows in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 3

Join Yarn D.

Row 1 (RS, D): [P2, sl2 wyib] to last 2 sts, p2. Slide sts.

Row 2 (RS, A): [SI2 wyib, k2] to last 2 sts, sI2 wyib. Turn.

Row 3 (WS, D): [K2, sl2 wyif] to last 2 sts, k2. Slide sts.

Row 4 (WS, A): [SI2 wyif, p2] to last 2 sts, sI2 wyif. Turn.

Rep rows 1-4 a further 6 times or until Section 3 measures 5cm / 2", ending on a WS row.

Break Yarn D and work 4 rows in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 4

Join Yarn E.

Row 1 (RS, E): [SI2 wyib, k2] to last 2 sts, sI2 wyib. Slide sts.

Row 2 (RS, A): [P2, sl2 wyib] to last 2 sts, p2. Turn.

Row 3 (WS, E): [SI2 wyif, p2] to last 2 sts, sI2 wyif. Slide sts.

Row 4 (WS, A): [K2, sl2 wyif] to last 2 sts, k2. Turn.

Rep rows 1-4 a further 2 times or until Section 4 measures 2.5cm / 1", ending on a WS row.

Break Yarn E and work 4 rows in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Cast off using the Italian BO method.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Place 76 (84, 92, 92, 92, 100, 100, 108, 108, 116) held sleeve sts back on needles. Join Yarn A with RS facing, pick up and knit 4 sts from underarm cast-on, PM to indicate beg of round. 80 (88, 96, 96, 104, 104, 112, 112, 120) sts

Round 1: [K2, p2] to end.

Rep round 1 until Sleeve measures 12cm / 4¾".



Colorwork Section

Note: The yarn to be used for each row is indicated in the row label, e.g. "Row 1 (WS, B)" is a WS row worked with yarn B.

Section 1

Join Yarn B.

Round 1 (B): [Sl2 wyib, p2] to end.

Round 2 (A): [K2, sl2 wyib] to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 a further 9 times or until Section 1 measures 4cm / $1\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Break Yarn B and work 4 rounds in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 2

Join Yarn C.

Round 1 (C): [K2, sl2 wyib] to end.

Round 2 (A): [SI2 wyib, p2] to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 a further 3 times or until Section 2 measures 1.5cm / $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Break Yarn C and work 4 rounds in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 3

Join Yarn D.

Round 1 (D): [Sl2 wyib, p2] to end.

Round 2 (A): [K2, sl2 wyib] to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 a further 13 times or until Section 3 measures 5cm / 2".

Break Yarn D and work 4 rounds in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 4

Round 1 (E): [K2, sl2 wyib] to end.

Round 2 (A): [SI2 wyib, p2] to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 a further 5 times or until Section 4 measures 2.5cm / 1".

Break Yarn E and work 4 rounds in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Cast off using the Italian BO technique.

LEFT SLEEVE

Place 76 (84, 92, 92, 92, 100, 100, 108, 108, 116) held sleeve sts back on needles. Join Yarn A, pick up and knit 4 sts from underarm cast-on, PM to indicate beg of round. 80 (88, 96, 96, 96, 104, 104, 112, 112, 120) sts

Round 1: [P2, k2] to end.

Rep round 1 until sleeve measures 12cm / 4¾".



Colorwork Section

Note: The yarn to be used for each row is indicated in the row label, e.g. "Row 1 (WS, B)" is a WS row worked with yarn B.

Section 1

Join Yarn B.

Round 1 (B): [P2, sl2 wyib] to end.

Round 2 (A): [SI2 wyib, k2] to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 a further 9 times or until Section 1 measures 4cm / 11/2".

Break Yarn B and work 4 rounds in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 2

Join Yarn C.

Round 1 (C): [SI2 wyib, k2] to end.

Round 2 (A): [P2, sl2 wyib] to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 a further 3 times or until Section 2 measures 1.5cm / $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Break Yarn C and work 4 rounds in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 3

Join Yarn D.

Round 1 (D): [P2, sl2 wyib] to end.

Round 2 (A): [SI2 wyib, k2] to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 a further 13 times or until Section 3 measures 5cm / 2".

Break Yarn D and work 4 rounds in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Section 4

Join Yarn E.

Round 1 (E): [SI2 wyib, k2] to end.

Round 1 (A): [P2, sl2 wyib] to end.

Rep round 1 a further 5 times or until Section 4 measures 2.5cm / 1".

Break Yarn E and work 4 rounds in 2x2 rib using Yarn A only.

Cast off using the Italian BO technique.

NECKBAND

Note: Neckband is worked with the double-knitting technique to create a double thickness fabric.

Using 4mm / US 6 needles, Yarn A, and with RS facing, pick up and knit 1 st for each row around entire front opening of cardigan, ending with an even number of sts.



Row 1: [K1, sl1 wyif] to end.

Rep row 1 until the neckband measures 4.5cm / 1%", ending on a WS row. Cast off using the Italian BO technique.

BELT LOOP (both alike)

Using Yarn A and a 3.5mm / US E / UK 9 crochet hook, insert the crochet hook at side body, just above Colourwork Section 1. With the yarn secured, ch15 and fasten off, leaving a tail. Use the long tail to attach other end of belt loop at the WS of the cardigan. Rep for the second side.

BELT

Using 4mm / US 6 needles, Yarn A and the Knitted CO method, CO 14 sts.

Row 1: [K1, sl1 wyif] to end.

Rep row 1 until belt measures 96 (111, 128, 131.5, 136.5, 151.5, 157, 170.5, 175.5, 187.5)cm / 37% (43%, 50.5, 51%, 53%, 59%, 61%, 67, 69, 73%)" or desired length.

Cast off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to measurements.

- a. **Chest circumference:** 93.5 (108, 124, 127, 132, 146.5, 151, 164, 169, 180)cm / 36³/₄ (42½, 48¾, 50, 52, 57¾, 59½, 64½, 66½, 70¾)"
- b. **Yoke depth:** 18.5 (21.5, 24, 24, 24, 26.5, 26.5, 29.5, 29.5, 32)cm / 7¹/₄ (8¹/₂, 9¹/₂, 9¹/₂, 10¹/₂, 11¹/₂, 11¹/₂, 12¹/₂)"
- c. **Upper arm circumference:** 32 (35, 38.5, 38.5, 38.5, 41.5, 41.5, 45, 45, 48)cm / 12½ (13¾, 15¼, 15¼, 16¼, 16¼, 16¼, 17¾, 17¾, 19)"
- d. Sleeve length from the underarm: 29cm / 11½"
- e. Body length from the underarm: $32cm / 12\frac{1}{2}$ "
